### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Omar Wattad - Chattanooga

Wattad averaged 24.7 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists in victories over The Citadel, Samford and College of Charleston.

The junior scored a career-high 30 points in Chattanooga's 69-68 victory at The Citadel. It was the first 30-point game for a Moc since Stephen McDowell tallied 32 against Samford in the 2009 Southern Conference Tournament. Wattad scored 17 points against Samford and recorded a game-high 27 points as Chattanooga defeated College of Charleston.

In addition to his 24.7 points per game average last week, Wattad shot 46 percent from the field (24-of-52) and connected on 54 percent (19-of-35) of his shots from beyond the arc.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Omar Carter, College of Charleston's Andrew Goude-lock, The Citadel's Cameron Wells, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, UNCG's Aaron Brackett, Western Carolina's Trey Sumler and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



• Following a three-game winning streak, the Mountaineers dropped nail-biters against UNCG, 75-74, and Western Carolina, 79-78. It was the first time since 1994-95 that ASU lost back-to-back one-point decisions. ASU defeated Elon Monday night to improve to 5-1 at home this season.

- Omar Carter continued his strong play with 20.0 points and 8.0 rebounds in last week's three games. He is second on the team with 16.5 points per game and has scored at least 19 points with at least five rebounds in the last five games.
- The Mountaineers visit The Citadel Thursday night.

## ELON PHOENIX



• Senior guard Chris Long had his second career double-double with 15 points and 10 assists at Appalachian State Monday. His 10 assists against the Mountaineers moved him into a tie for second place on Elon's all-time assist list with 433.

• Elon continued its hot shooting from beyond the arc

Monday night against ASU as the Phoenix knocked down 10 shots from three-point range. Elon ranks second in the SoCon and 11th nationally with 9.3 made triples per game.

- Elon will play host to Davidson Thursday night.

## UNCG SPARTANS



• Freshman Trevis Simpson scored a career-high 33 points as UNCG topped Davidson 77-69 Monday night. Simpson's prior career best was 16 points which he scored at Clemson December 19. He finished 12-of-15 from the field Monday against Davidson and made 4-of-6 from three-point range.

• UNCG recorded 10 offensive rebounds against the Wildcats. The Spartans rank second in the SoCon with 12.7 offensive rebounds per game. UNCG is fifth in the league in offensive rebound percentage (.336).

- The Spartans host Georgia Southern Thursday.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



• With Samford's loss to The Citadel on Monday, the Bulldogs have dropped three consecutive games for the first time since concluding the 2009-10 campaign with a four-game losing streak. It is the Bulldogs' only losing streak in 2010-11.

- Samford has made at least five 3-point baskets in each game dating back to its 64-61 season-opening loss at Youngstown State on Nov. 12. The Bulldogs have knocked down five or more 3-point shots in 17-consecutive games, including a season-high total of 18 in road wins at Auburn on Nov. 19 and at UTSA on Dec. 20.
- Samford visits Furman Thursday night.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



• Chattanooga is shooting 66.9 percent from the free throw line for the season. In the first 37 minutes, UTC is shooting 65.1 percent (216-332), but that improves to 73.0 percent (73-100) in the final three minutes of game.

• Chattanooga is 10-0 when holding opponents under 70 points and 1-8 when foes score 70 or more. That lone win came Monday night as the Mocs defeated College of Charleston 91-88.

- Chattanooga travels to face Furman (Thursday) and Wofford (Saturday) this week.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



• Western Carolina stretched its winning streak to four straight with back-to-back home wins over Elon and a buzzer-beating, victory over Appalachian State, 79-78. WCU has won seven straight home games dating back to last year and has claimed victory in 32 of its last 37 home games and 21 of the last 24 home games in SoCon play.

- The Catamounts travel to Charleston for consecutive road games against the College of Charleston and The Citadel. WCU has dropped six of its last seven road games, but snapped a six-game road skid with a Jan. 5 win over Georgia Southern in Statesboro.
- The Catamounts visit College of Charleston Thursday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



• Head Coach Bobby Cremins is one win shy of recording his 100th career victory at CofC with a 99-55 record to date. Should he reach the milestone, Cremins would become one of only 11 coaches in NCAA Division I history to record 100 or more wins at three different Division I schools next to fellow coaching legends Jerry Tarkanian (Long Beach State, UNLV, Fresno State), Bob Knight (Army, Indiana, Texas Tech) and his mentor and former college coach, the late Frank McGuire (St. John's, North Carolina, South Carolina).

- College of Charleston hosts Western Carolina Thursday.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



• A pair of 20-point outings by senior guard Cameron Wells gives him 35 20-plus point games during his career with the Bulldogs, netting 23 against Southern Conference opponents. The most against any one SoCon team is four (vs. Davidson). He has three against Appalachian State, The Citadel's next opponent.

• In the first start of his career, which came against Samford (Jan. 17) junior Bo Holston finished with seven rebounds, including a pair of offensive rebounds, to go along with four points and one block in a career-high 28 minutes.

- After hosting Appalachian State Thursday night, the Bulldogs entertain Western Carolina Saturday evening.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



• Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs 11 three-pointers to move into the top five on the career list. McKillop has knocked down 176 career triples. He is tied for third in the SoCon this season with 2.6 made three-pointers per game.

• With 65 career blocked shots, sophomore Jake Cohen has moved in the top-10 at Davidson. Cohen currently leads the Southern Conference with 1.6 blocked shots per game.

He has recorded multiple blocked shots in eight different games this season.

- The Wildcats travel to Elon Thursday night.

## FURMAN PALADINS



• Senior Amu Saaka is averaging 16.4 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. He is one of just two players (Eric Ferguson, GSU) to rank in the league's top ten for both scoring and rebounding. Saaka has two double-doubles this season.

• The Paladins lead the Southern Conference in scoring margin at +6.9 points per game. Furman is averaging 72.1 points per contest, a four-point improvement over last year. Additionally the Paladins have limited the opposition to just 65.2 points per game this season.

- The Paladins host Samford Thursday.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



• Junior Ben Drayton III ranks as Georgia Southern's top scorer with 15.2 points per game. The guard has posted double-digit scoring performances in eight consecutive games and 18 of the 19 games this season.

• Georgia Southern ranks No. 12 in the country with 9.68 steals per game. Ben Drayton III leads the team with 38 total steals while the freshman duo of Jelani Hewitt and Eric Ferguson have 36 and 35 steals, respectively.

- Georgia Southern visits UNCG Thursday. The Eagles then travel to take on Elon Saturday night.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



• Senior forward Noah Dahlman was 10-of-10 from the field at Georgia Southern (Jan. 12), the first time a Wofford player was perfect with ten or more shots from the field since 1992.

• The Terriers earned a 77-73 victory at Davidson Saturday night (Jan. 15) behind 22 points from senior Cameron Rundles. It was Wofford's third straight win over the Wildcats, marking the first three-game winning streak in the series for the Terriers since 1956-57.

- Wofford hosts Chattanooga Thursday night. The Terriers welcome Samford to the Benjamin Johnson Arena Saturday afternoon.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### COUSY CANDIDATES

The Southern Conference boasts four candidates for the 2011 Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard. The Award is presented through the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The Southern Conference Candidates Include:

- Keegan Bell, Jr., Chattanooga
- Brendan McKillop, Sr., Davidson
- Cameron Wells, Sr., The Citadel
- Mike Williams, Sr., Western Carolina

### RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2010-11.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2011 marks the 91st year of the post-season classic.

### POSTSEASON PLAY

- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
