PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ty Patterson - Chattanooga

Patterson averaged 18.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and shot 48 percent from the field last week as the Mocs knocked off Western Carolina (80-67) and Appalachian State (85-80).

Patterson began the week with his second double-double of the season as he recorded 19 points and 10 rebounds against Western Carolina. Saturday against Appalachian State, Patterson poured in 18 points and pulled down eight rebounds as the Mocs led wire-to-wire against the Mountaineers. Patterson hit four three-pointers in each game last week. He connected on 11-of-23 field goal attempts, including 8-of-19 from three-point range. Patterson added four assists and a blocked shot last week.

The Anderson, S.C., native has started in all 15 games he's played in this season. He leads the Mocs with 15.7 points per game and is second on the squad with 5.4 rebounds per contest. Patterson has scored in double figures in each of his last four games, including a season-high 28 points against Elon on January 23.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- The Mountaineers are 4-1 against North Division opponents this season with the lone loss coming at the hands of the Chattanooga Mocs. The squad's four conference losses have come by a combined 15 points.
- Donald Sims continues to lead the team in scoring as he has reached double figures in 21-of-22 games this season. He averages 18.9 points per game, the second-highest mark in the league.
- Appalachian State visits Western Carolina Saturday night.

ELON PHOENIX



- Elon broke a nine-game losing streak with its victory against Chattanooga last Saturday. Both of Elon's league victories this year have come against the Mocs. In two games against Chattanooga this season, Chris Long has netted a total of 45 points and dished out 16 assists.
- Drew Spradlin scored 30 points against the Mocs, the first 30-point game by an Elon player since the 2006-07 season. Spradlin is averaging 13.1 points per game this season, the ninth best mark in the league. Spradlin has made 1.9 three-pointers per game this season, the 11th-best average in the league.
- The Phoenix visit Wofford Wednesday.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Ben Stywall is averaging 16.6 points and 12.0 rebounds per game with eight double-doubles in his last 11 outings. He shot 48.4 percent from the floor in those 11 games. Stywall leads the conference in rebounding with 10.4 rebounds per game, including 4.5 per contest on the offensive glass.
- UNCG earned a 62-55 win over Elon in its last outing on Thursday. The Spartans have now beaten backyard-rival Elon seven straight meetings to pull the all-time series to 14-13.
- The Spartans visit Furman Thursday night.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford head coach Jimmy Tillette returned to the practice floor Monday for the first time since suffering a seizure in the Bulldogs' 70-67 victory at UNC Greensboro on Jan. 23. Tillette was released from UAB Hospital on Tuesday of last week, but was advised to rest at home until Monday's practice. The Bulldogs' all-time winningest coach received good news from the medical staff last week when all initial test results came back with a positive prognosis. Samford associate head coach Paul Kelly assumed the coaching duties in the Bulldogs' games against Furman, Appalachian State and Western Carolina.
- The Bulldogs visit The Citadel Thursday night.

CHATTANOOGA MOCs



- Rebounding was a key to the Mocs' Saturday win over the Mountaineers. Not only did UTC win the battle of the boards, 46-37, but it held a 20-2 advantage in second-chance points.
- Junior Ridge McKeither was a force as the Mocs swept of the North leaders. On Thursday 12 of his 15 points and four of his five boards keying a second-half run to top the Catamounts. He followed that with his third double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds against App State. McKeither shot 68.8 percent from the field for the week.
- Chattanooga visits College of Charleston Thursday night.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina secured win No. 17 on the season, the most under head coach Larry Hunter. At 17-5, the Catamounts have guaranteed themselves a second-consecutive winning season. WCU has not enjoyed back-to-back winning seasons since 1995-96 (17-13) and 1996-97 (14-13).
- Western Carolina remained perfect on the season following a loss, improving to 5-0 in games after losing. Saturday's victory was the first road win following a loss as the previous four victories all came at home.
- Western Carolina hosts Georgia Southern Thursday.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS

- Junior Cameron Wells has hit 45-of-49 free throw attempts since being held without a visit to the charity stripe against College of Charleston (Jan. 9). In that time he has twice finished perfect from the line, including 6-6 at Chattanooga and 8-8 against Furman. Wells also put together a streak of 18 consecutive free throws which ended at Georgia Southern Thursday.
- Wells continues to move up The Citadel's all-time scoring list, sitting six points behind Rodney McKeever (1,358) entering the week.
- The Citadel will host Samford on Thursday.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars are 8-2 in their last 10 games and have averaged 81.2 points per game, while limiting their opposition to 74.6 points per contest. College of Charleston owns a 49.7 shooting percentage during that stretch, compared to 43.4 for its opponents.
- College of Charleston is second in the conference and eighth in the nation in three-point field goals per game at 9.1. The Cougars have made 37.9 percent of their three-point attempts this season.
- College of Charleston hosts Chattanooga Thursday night. The Cougars will entertain Samford Saturday.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With wins last week over College of Charleston and The Citadel, Davidson improved to 5-2 against SoCon South Division opponents. Only two of those seven games have been at home. The Wildcats are now 6-4 in league play and have won three straight league games.
- Senior Will Archambault is 13 points away from becoming the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.6 points per game, the 17th best mark in the league.
- The Wildcats host Georgia Southern Saturday night. Davidson will visit Appalachian State February 11.

FURMAN PALADINS



- The Paladins are second in the league, and rank 42nd nationally, in blocked shots per game (5.0 bpg). Freshman Colin Reddick is fourth in the league with 1.4 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is eighth with 1.1 rejections per contest.
- The Paladins boast two of the top eight scorers in the league in Amuy Saaka and Jordan Miller. Saaka is averaging 15.8 points per game, the fifth best mark in the league. Miller's 14.3 points per contest rank eighth in the Southern Conference. Furman is the only school in the league to have two of the league's top eight scorers.
- Furman hosts UNC Greensboro Thursday. The Paladins welcome Elon to Timmons Arena Saturday night.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Georgia Southern erased a 21-point deficit against the Citadel in claiming a 61-58 win. It was the largest comeback in a regulation game for Georgia Southern.
- Willie Powers III had 12 of his 19 points in the second half and six points in the final 68 seconds to lead the Eagles over The Citadel. Powers has scored in double figures in 11 halves of basketball this year while posting his career-best 27 vs. Valparaiso. He is sixth in the conference in scoring with 14.8 points per game.
- The Eagles visit Western Carolina Thursday.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- The Terriers ended the month of January with a 7-1 overall record. In those eight games, Noah Dahlman led the team in scoring in seven, while Tim Johnson led the team in rebounding in all eight.
- With at least nine games left on the schedule, Wofford needs only two wins to reach 17 victories which would be the most in school history since moving to NCAA Division I.
- The Terriers host Elon Wednesday night in Spartanburg, S.C. Wofford hosts UNC Greensboro Saturday night.

CONFERENCE NOTES

ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

ALL-DECade RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released its All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

SoCon TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
