- · UNCG tied the NCAA record for home runs in an inning, blasting five in the 7th of a 13-3 win over Elon on March 10.
- UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches.

SOCON 100TH ANNIVERSARY

The SoCon is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2021. The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.
