Edwards gave ASU the lead midway through the third quarter with a 15vard touchdown run and tied the game with a 65-yard touchdown pass to William Mayfield to send the game to overtime.



Jordan Sorrells **Furman** Freshman Quarterback Greenville, S.C.

Led the Paladins to a 28-22 overtime win over

Chattanooga. In just his second career start, Sorrells completed 22-of-29 passes for a career-high 335 yards and two TDs. He engineered a 10 play, 69 yard drive with 1:39 left in regulation to set up a Scott Beckler game-tying field goal. He completed the game-winning strike to Cedrick Gipson in the first overtime period. His 335 yards passing tied the Furman passing yardage mark for a freshman and is fifth highest in single game totals in school history.

Game Notes

The contest pits the conference's top rushing attack against the league's eighth-ranked rushing defense. Wofford averages 235.0 yards per game on the ground and the Catamounts yield 190.9 yards per outing. Kevious Johnson leads the Terriers, average yards per outing. Revious Johnson reads the Terriers, averaging 70.3 yards per game on the ground. Josh Collier had 128 yards with two TDs last week in Wofford's win over Elon. Western Carolina's Darius Fudge averages 95.7 of the team's 121.0 yards per game on the ground. The Catamounts' two quarterbacks Bennett Swygert (111.6 yards per game) and Todd Spitzer (99.1 yards per game) combine for 210.7 total yards through the air. The Catamounts averaged 31.0 points in their first two games but just 16.2 points in the last five contests.

The Citadel amassed 466 yards of offense. Darius Fudge rushed for 129 yards including a 50-yard TD in the fourth quarter. The loss extended Western Carolina's losing streak to five.

Game Notes

Both teams forced overtime last week. Georgia Southern fell to No. 1-ranked Appalachian State 27-20 in double overtime while The Citadel topped Western Carolina, 30-27, in one extra period. Defensive back Joshua Lawson (9.3 tackles per game) and linebacker Andrew Rowell (7.9 stops per contest) anchor The Citadel's defense. The Eagles have lost games by three and one points and one in overtime. Georgia Southern boasts the top running back tandem in Chris Covington (86.4 yards per game) and Lamar Lewis (82.3 yards per contest). The game pits the top two teams in the SoCon. Both are tied for first place in the league with 4-0 marks. Both posted overtime wins a week ago. Furman's stubborn defense is ranked second in the league behind the play of linebacker Andrew Jones (10.5 tackles per game and 9.5 tackles for loss). Appalachian State freshman quarterback Armanti Edwards, who has won SoCon Freshman of the Week honors three times, averages 156.0 yards passing and 63.4 yards rushing. He is second in the league with nine TD passes (and just five interceptions).

Chattanooga's Eldra Buckley leads the conference in rushing by a wide margin. He averages 122.2 yards per game 26.5 yards more than any other SoCon running back. Chattanooga won last year's meeting by a 10-7 score at Elon.
