## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

• Western Carolina's contest against Southern Wesleyan on Thursday is the league's final nonconference game of the regular season. SoCon teams are 67-59 against nonconference foes so far this season. A win would put Catamount coach Larry Hunter just two shy of 700 for his career.

• Four SoCon teams appear in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25, which is the most of any conference in the poll. ETSU (5), Furman (12), Wofford (13) and UNCG (18) represent the league in the poll, with the Spartans moving up two spots from last week.

• Wednesday's schedule saw league-leading ETSU down Mercer, the SoCon coaches' preseason favorite, and UNCG top media preseason favorite Furman.

• UNCG coach Wes Miller earned his 100th career win Thursday with the Spartans' 71-61 victory over the Paladins. Wofford coach Mike Young picked up his 150th career SoCon win in Saturday's 71-67 win over Chattanooga.

• Chattanooga picked up its first league win Thursday night, getting 21 points and 19 rebounds off the bench from Makinde London in its 78-71 win over Samford. Coupled with his 18 boards against Marshall on Dec. 5, London now has the top two rebounding games in the league this season.

• Mercer senior forward Stephon Jelks leads the league with six double-doubles on the season and has recorded four in a row in his last five games. Jelks, who leads the league in 3-point field-goal percentage at 49.2 on the season, reached the 1,000-point plateau in Saturday's overtime loss at UNCG.

• VMI's 88-81 win over rival The Citadel on Saturday was its sixth victory of the season, matching last season's total. The Keydets had four double-figure scorers for the first time this season.

• So far this season, SoCon games have either been tight affairs or blowouts, with not much in between. With 38 league games in the books so far, just 17 have been decided by single digits. The other 21 games were decided by an average of 20.0 points per game.

• All 10 SoCon teams are .500 or better at home for the season, and four teams have just one loss at home: ETSU, Mercer, UNCG and Wofford, who are a combined 38-4 on their home courts. Together, home teams are 24-14 so far in league play.

• Furman is 20-2 at home versus SoCon foes since the start of the 2015-16 season. UNCG is 25-5 at home over the last two years, including 11-2 at home in league play.

• Citadel juniors Zane Najdawi and Matt Frierson have caught fire in recent weeks. Najdawi has averaged 27.5 points and 7.3 rebounds per game over the last four games. Frierson has averaged 20.5 points and 5.3 3-pointers per game over the same stretch.

• Samford guard Justin Coleman is on pace to reach 199 assists by the conclusion of the 2017-18 campaign. Coleman's estimated total would rank as the second-highest in school history, trailing only Christen Cunningham's school-record mark of 225 from last year.

## SoCON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### Justin Coleman, Jr., G Samford

Coleman averaged a double-double last week, scoring 20.0 points per game and dishing off 10.0 assists per contest against Wofford and Furman.

Against the Terriers on Thursday, Coleman scored 20 points, 17 of which came in the second half as the Bulldogs rallied from a late nine-point deficit to get within two in the final three seconds of a 93-89 loss. Coleman handed out 12 assists, good for his league-best third game of 10 assists or more this season, and pulled down four rebounds.

Two days later against Furman, Coleman again scored an even 20 points, giving him consecutive 20-point outings for the first time this season. He assisted on eight baskets and had two rebounds.

Coleman went 8-for-14 from the floor (57.1 percent) in both contests and was 5-for-6 (83.3 percent) from the free-throw line for the week. He totaled 20 assists against just eight turnovers and averaged 3.0 rebounds per game.



## CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

### Coaching milestones

Three league coaches are approaching career win milestones. In addition to Mercer coach Bob Hoffman earning his 500th career victory last week and UNCG coach Wes Miller getting win No. 100 on Wednesday, Western Carolina coach Larry Hunter is also closing in history. Already having moved ahead of legendary NC State coach Everett Case on the SoCon's all-time wins list this season, Hunter needs three more to reach 700 overall for his career. He is 697-445 in 38 years on the sidelines.

### 1,000-point scorers

Four league players have hit the 1,000-point milestone for their careers so far this season. UNCG junior Francis Alonso reached the mark on Nov. 20 against Delaware, and Furman senior Daniel Fowler joined the club on Dec. 30 against VMI. ETSU senior Desonta Bradford reached 1,000 points on Jan. 13, also against VMI, and Mercer's Stephon Jelks hit the milestone on Jan. 20 against UNCG. Furman senior Devin Sibley, Samford senior Christen Cunningham and Wofford junior Fletcher Magee entered the season over 1,000 for their careers, giving the SoCon seven active players with at least 1,000 points. Mercer's Jordan Strawberry (974), UNCG's Marvin Smith (966) and The Citadel's Zane Najdawi (962) are also on pace to hit the mark within the next few weeks.

### Magee's double figures streak

Wofford's Fletcher Magee has scored in double figures in 65 consecutive contests, good for the second-longest active streak in NCAA Division I, according to research by STATS.

### One-possession games

This season, nine SoCon games out of 38 have been decided by one possession or gone to overtime (24 percent).

- In 2016, the league had 21 of 90 (23 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2015, the league had 23 of 90 (26 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2014, the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

### Sharpshooting Bulldogs

The Citadel finished second in Division I with 397 made 3-pointers last season, a SoCon record. The Bulldogs are on pace for approximately 362 3-pointers this season, which would be third in SoCon history. If it reaches that mark, The Citadel will have accomplished the top three 3-point totals in league history in the last three seasons, as it previously set the SoCon record with 363 in 2015-16.

### Ten wins before the New Year

For the second consecutive year, three SoCon teams had 10 wins at the turn of the calendar. This season, ETSU, Furman and UNCG were each 10-4 after games of Dec. 31. In 2016-17, it was ETSU, Samford and Chattanooga each with at least 10 wins before the New Year. Prior to last year, the league hadn't had three teams reach double digits in wins prior to January in at least 20 seasons, according to available research.

### The SoCon vs. the ACC

Wofford's 79-75 win over No. 5 North Carolina on Dec. 20 gave the SoCon three wins over Atlantic Coast Conference schools in a season for the first time since 2001-02. Also this year, Wofford has beaten Georgia Tech (63-60 on Dec. 6) and UNCG has beaten NC State (81-76 on Dec. 16). The only leagues to own more wins over the ACC this season are Power 5 conferences the Big 12, Big Ten and SEC, each with six.

### Close encounters

Southern Conference teams are 9-6 this season in nonconference games that have been decided by one possession or have gone into overtime. League teams have gone 42-44 in those games since the start of the 2013-14 season.

### Postseason experience

Four teams reached postseason play last season. ETSU won the SoCon Championship and the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, where it fell in the first round to Florida. UNCG made its first NIT appearance since 2002, falling to Syracuse, while Furman and Samford participated in the Collegians.com Tournament, with the Paladins reaching the semifinals.

### Southern Conference Championship presented by General Shale

The 2018 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Championship presented by General Shale will take place March 2-5 at the U.S. Cellular Center in Asheville, North Carolina.

## TRIPLE THREATS – SoCON 3-POINT PROWESS

• The Citadel is fourth in NCAA Division I in made 3-pointers per game at 11.7, while Wofford is second in 3-point percentage at 43.7.

• Wofford junior guard Fletcher Magee is currently second in DI with 89 made 3-pointers and second with 4.45 per game. UNCG junior guard Francis Alonso's 69 3-pointers are good for 13th, while his 3.45 per game are good for 12th. Citadel junior Matt Frierson is 14th with 68 made 3s and seventh with 3.58 per game.

• Mercer senior forward Stephon Jelks – the league's active leader in career rebounds – leads the league with a 49.2 percentage this season, a mark that would rank 10th in league history.

• Magee is second in SoCon annals with a career 3-point percentage of 45.5, while Samford senior guard Demetrius Denzel-Dyson is fifth all-time at 44.9 percent (see chart on previous page). UNCG's Alonso is 10th in league lore at 43.3 percent.

• Magee has 292 career 3s, good for seventh in SoCon history (see chart on previous page). Alonso (256) is on pace to move into the top 10 later this season.

• If Magee were to continue his current pace of 4.45 made 3s per game this season, he would finish the year with at least 345 for his career, putting him fourth in league annals behind Davidson's Stephen Curry (414), College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock (396) and Appalachian State's Donald Sims (358). At 3.45 per game, Alonso is on pace to finish the season with approximately 297, which would slot him sixth behind Wofford's Ian Chadwick (299).

• Magee is on pace to finish with at least 142 3-pointers this season, a total that would trail only Curry's NCAA-record 162 in 2007-08 in SoCon history. Alonso and Frierson is also flirting with a spot in the top 10, as he's on pace for at nearly 111.

## DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

It was a December to remember for the SoCon, which proved it can be a force on the national stage with a few big wins and several more near upsets. A time line of significant performances:

**Dec. 2:** Mercer takes Memphis to double overtime on the road before succumbing, 83-81. Jordan Strawberry's 3-point attempt at the buzzer goes long for the Bears.

**Dec. 5:** Samford, decimated by injuries this season, also flirts with knocking off the Tigers, falling 65-64 in Memphis. The Bulldogs hold a 64-60 lead with 18 seconds to go but see Memphis get a layup with 11 seconds left and a three-point play with 2.5 ticks left to steal the win.

**Dec. 6:** Wofford's Fletcher Magee hits a step-back 3-pointer with 1.9 seconds left to cap a 36-point effort as the Terriers down Georgia Tech, 63-60, for their first signature win in Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium.

**Dec. 16:** UNCG picks up its first-ever win over NC State and just its third over an ACC opponent as the Spartans get 17 points from Francis Alonso and a double-double from Marvin Smith in an 81-76 win in Raleigh.

**Dec. 16:** That same day, ETSU has No. 10 Xavier on the ropes, leading by 22 early in the second half before seeing the Musketeers rally for the 68-66 win.

**Dec. 19:** Mercer nearly pulls off a miraculous comeback against Alabama, rallying from an eight-point deficit with 27 seconds left to put up what would have been a game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer. Ria'n Holland's attempt is off the mark as the Crimson Tide escape, 80-79.

**Dec. 20:** Wofford picks up what might be the biggest upset of the season nationally, shocking No. 5 North Carolina, 79-75. The Terriers never trail in the second half and get 27 points from Fletcher Magee.

**Dec. 20:** At the same time Wofford is dropping UNC, Furman is putting a scare into No. 21 Tennessee, as the squads are tied at 61 in the final minute before the Vols finish the game on a 5-0 run. Devin Sibley has 22 points but is the only Paladin in double digits.
