### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Demetrius Nelson The Citadel

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - The Citadel's Demetrius Nelson has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games February 3-9 the league office announced Tuesday (Feb. 10). Nelson led the team in scoring in wins over Appalachian State (74-72) and Western Carolina (75-66). He averaged 25.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and made 63 percent of his field goal attempts last week.

The senior center tallied a career-high 29 points in The Citadel's win at Western Carolina Saturday. Earlier in the week he posted a team-high 22 points at Appalachian State. Nelson was one rebound away from a double-double in both games. He connected on 16-of-27 (.593) field goal attempts and shot 83 percent from the free throw line. Nelson is sixth in the league in scoring (15.8 ppg) and 14th in rebounding (6.1rpg). He ranks second in the league in field goal percentage (.596) and tenth in free throw percentage (.785).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Junior Kellen Brand leads the Mountaineers with 14.7 points per game, the eighth best mark in the conference. Brand ranks fourth in the league in free throw percentage (.842) and eighth in three-point percentage (.405).
- Appalachian State was paired against Winthrop in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBuster. The Mountaineers have participated in the event each of the past two seasons and are 1-1.
- The Mountaineers travel to take on Western Carolina Saturday afternoon. Appalachian State will play host to College of Charleston Monday night.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Chattanooga is 11-2 this season when leading with five minutes to play and just 2-11 when trailing at that juncture. Both wins while trailing came on the last road trip at Wofford and Furman, while one of the two losses when leading happened at Furman last week.
- Senior Stephen McDowell made his 100th three-pointer of the season at Samford. Against Elon he passed Keddrick Mays (2006-07) for the top spot on the school's all-time made three pointers list (209). McDowell is the only Moc to make at least 100 triples in more than one season.
- The Mocs host UNC Greensboro Saturday.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 17th in program history with 1,235 points. He ranks third in the conference in blocked shots (1.5 bpg), fifth in steals (1.7 spg) and 18th in rebounding (5.3 rpg).
- With Elon's 57-54 victory at Georgia Southern last week, the Phoenix won back-to-back road games for the first time since Jan. 4 and 9, 2006 when Elon won at Wofford (64-61) and Chattanooga (92-74).
- The Phoenix visit Samford Saturday.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Junior forward Ben Stywall is averaging 14.3 ppg and 9.3 rpg in 15 league games this season. Stywall is also shooting 58 percent from the floor in league play. He is averaging 11.7 points per game for the season.
- The Spartans have been one of the top teams in the league defensively this season. UNC Greensboro is fourth in the conference in three point field goal defense, allowing its opponents to shoot just 35 percent from beyond the arc. The Spartans are second in the conference in blocked shots, averaging 3.7 blocks per game.
- UNC Greensboro visits Chattanooga Saturday night.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Junior Bryan Friday scored a career-high 23 points in Samford's 73-60 victory over UNC Greensboro Thursday night. Friday leads the Bulldogs with 12.8 points per game this season, the 12th-best average in the conference. He is 13th in the league in field goal percentage (.496).
- Samford has only played in three games this season that were decided by five points or less. The remaining 21 games featured an outcome of at least six points or more.
- Samford hosts Elon Saturday afternoon.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- The Catamounts are 6-1 at home in league play and are 1-6 on the road in the conference. Western Carolina is tied with Davidson for the best home mark in league play this season.
- The Catamounts lead the conference and are 11th in the nation in steals per game (9.3 spg). Junior Brigham Waginger (2.3 spg) and freshman Harouna Mutombo (1.9 spg) rank second and third, respectively, in steals in the league.
- The Catamounts will host rival Appalachian State Saturday.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- College of Charleston has one of the top offenses in the league. The Cougars rank second in scoring (78.4 ppg), second in scoring margin (+4.7), and lead the league in field goal percentage (.482).
- Sophomore Andrew Goudelock is third in the league in scoring (16.9 ppg). He has led the Cougars in scoring 13 times this season. Goudelock also ranks second in the conference in three-point percentage (.455)
- The Cougars host The Citadel Saturday afternoon.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With 2,389 career points, junior Stephen Curry is fifth all-time on the Southern Conference's career scoring list. Curry needs 35 points to move past Gay Elmore (VMI, 1983-87) into fourth place.
- Davidson has been one of the top defensive teams in the league this season. The Wildcats yield just 66.2 points per game to their opponents and have limited the opposition to just 40 percent shooting from the field.
- Davidson travels to face Furman Saturday afternoon in Greenville, S.C.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Connor Nolte scored a career-high 17 points and pulled down seven rebounds in Furman's 70-60 win over Georgia Southern Thursday night. Nolte is averaging 15.0 points and 6.7 rebounds per game over his last three contests.
- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 14th in the conference in scoring. Miller is averaging 13.8 points per game and also ranks seventh in the conference in free throw percentage (.816). He has been Furman's leading scorer in 14 of 24 games this year.
- The Paladins host Davidson Saturday afternoon

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Freshman Ben Drayton is shooting 53.2 percent from the field in league play and leads the conference, shooting 54.2 percent from three-point range against league opponents. He is averaging 12.7 points per game in league play.
- Head coach Jeff Price is just two wins shy of 300 for his career. Price, in his 16th season as a head coach, has captured 164 wins at Georgia Southern, the 13th-highest win total among all coaches to coach at a Southern Conference school.
- The Eagles travel to face Wofford Saturday night for a game that will be televised on SportSouth.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel has won eight straight games for the first time since the 1978-79 season. The Bulldogs have also strung together eight consecutive wins in league play, the first time that has happened in school history.
- The last time the Bulldogs won at least 10 conference games was during the 1984-85 season under head coach Les Robinson, who guided the team to an 11-5 mark. At 11-4 in conference play, the Bulldogs have tied the school record for the most league wins.
- The Citadel visits College of Charleston Saturday.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Sophomore Noah Dahlman scored a team-high 18 points in Wofford's 78-61 loss to Davidson Thursday night. Dahlman is fourth in the conference in scoring (16.7 ppg) and field goal percentage (.583). He has led the Terriers in scoring 14 times this season.
- The Terriers are 6-0 this season when shooting over 50 percent from the field. Conversely, Wofford is 0-7 this year when allowing its opponents to shoot better than 50 percent from the floor. The Terriers are shooting 45 percent from the field this season.
- The Terriers welcome Georgia Southern Saturday night at 8:00 p.m.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### MOVING FORWARD

The Citadel has won 11 conference games this season after going 1-19 in league play during 2007-08. The Bulldogs' ten-game improvement is tied for the second-best mark in league history for biggest turnaround in consecutive seasons.

### TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November 2008 to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

### HALL OF FAME

The Southern Conference announced the inaugural Hall of Fame class for 2009. The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

### EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches returned to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

### PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.
