PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Mercer forward Kadeem Agard and Bears' goalkeeper Trevor McMullen have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition from Sept. 14-20.

Agard was a key component for the Mercer offense this week, scoring the lone goal in the Bears' 1-0 win over Furman on Sept. 18 to collect Mercer's first conference victory of the 2021 campaign. The freshman forward connected with Liam Coxhead and Angel Gonzalez's go-ahead pass that was delivered just outside the six-yard box to net the game-winning goal in the 80th minute and give the Bears the 1-0 advantage over Furman. The goal from Agard, a native of Snellville, Georgia, was his third goal of the season.

In his first collegiate start for the Bears, McMullen tallied six saves and earned the shutout win over the Paladins.

Mercer (3-3, 1-0 SoCon) plays at South Carolina tonight, then will travel to ETSU (2-3-1, 0-1) on Saturday for its second conference match of the season.



Notes

- Six of the seven SoCon men's soccer teams begin their conference play this week, with VMI traveling to Wofford, Mercer hosting Furman, and ETSU traveling to Belmont on Saturday, Sept. 18.
- UNCG had two successful peformances this week, as the Spartans went 2-0 to improve to 5-2-1 following a 5-0 non-conference win over Radford on Sept. 18 and a 3-1 upset over No. 2 Clemson on Sept. 21.
- UNCG extended their unbeaten streak to three matches following their win over Radford, after Angel Bacho netted two goals and Theo Collomb, Micah Albert, and Fernando Garcio each netted one. This match marked Bacho's first career two-goal outing and and the match was Niclas Wild's third consecutive clean sheet. UNCG had not allowed a goal in 290 minutes.
- In their stunning 3-1 victory over No. 2 Clemson, the Spartans outshot the Tigers 17-6 and became the first team in 10 games to score more than one goal against Clemson. Collomb led UNCG to their upset over the Tigers with two goals, while JC Ngando scored one.
- The match marked Collomb's third multi-scoring game of the season, allowing the sophmore forward to clinch a total of 16 career goals. This was the first victory over a ranked opponent for third-year head coach Chris Rich. The Spartans last win over an opponent ranked in the Top 10 at the time of the match was a 2-1 double overtime win at No. 6 West Virginia on Nov. 15, 2006 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- Belmont, Mercer, and Wofford were victorious in their conference opening debuts, with the Terriers grabbing an 8-1 win over the Keydets and the Bruins and Bears clinching 1-0 shutout wins over the Buccaneers and the Paladins.
- In Wofford's match against VMI, the Terriers saw seven different players score goals, which was the first time since Wofford joined the Division I era and Southern Conference in 1997. The eight goals mark the most since a 6-0 victory over the Keydets on Oct. 7, 2017, as the last time Wofford recorded eight goals in a match was in an 8-1 victory at Limestone on Oct. 26, 1994.
- Mercer defeated Furman 1-0 following an 80th minute strike from Offensive Player of the Week recipient Kadeem Agard, which was his third of the young season, allowing the freshmen forward to score in three of the five he's participated in. His three conversions places him second on the squad behind Dylan Gaither, who has four to his name. Defensive Player of the Week recipient, Trevor McMullen, had six saves in his first collegiate start for the Bears.
- Belmont grabbed their fifth consecutive win in their 1-0 victory over ETSU and were led by AJ Chastoney, who netted his second goal of the season in the 72nd minute to claim the Bruins third one-goal shutout of the fall.
