### NOTES

- Mercer finished the fall slate with a record of 1-4-0, after falling to No. 4 Kentucky with a 3-1 setback. The Bears were the only SoCon men's soccer team to compete during the fall.

- Mercer's redshirt senior Leo Toledo Jr. is currently tied as the NCAA Division I active career leader in assists, and continues to hold his position as the Southern Conference active career leader in the category.

- Redshirt senior JR DeRose made four saves on the night, bringing his fall season total to 16.

- Mercer won the 2019 Southern Conference Men's Soccer Championship with a 1-0 win over No. 2 seed UNCG in the title game after defeating No. 1 seed Furman in the semifinal round 3-2 in 2OT. It was the Bears' third title since joining the league in 2014.

- Last season, the Bears tied their single-season program record with 14 wins.

- The Bears fell in the first round of the 2019 NCAA tournament to Charlotte, 3-1.

- The Southern Conference Council of Presidents announced on Aug. 13 that the league would postpone conference competition for all fall sports to the spring due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, with schools able to participate in nonconference play in the fall at their discretion.

- UNCG and Furman shared the 2019 SoCon regular-season title, but have opted out of participating in fall competition along with Belmont, ETSU, VMI and Wofford.
