## QUICK HITS

In a day that featured tight SoCon battles across the board, Appalachian State and Elon emerged as the only two remaining unbeaten teams in league play ... With 16 catches against Furman, Elon's Terrell Hudgins became the NCAA Division I all-time leader in career receptions, passing Florida A&M's Jacquay Nunnally ... The SoCon Saturday game of the week on SportSouth this week showcases resurgent Chattanooga at Samford ... The game features the league's top two rushers (Bryan Fitzgerald and Chris Evans) as well as defenses that rank among the top 3 in the SoCon stats ... After SoCon games averaged 52.3 points per contest in 2008, teams are combining for just 40.5 points per game in conference tilts so far this season.
