QUICK HITS

- Despite being picked last in the preseason, Western Carolina holds on to first place in the standings heading into the final weekend of regular-season play.
- UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches and currently sit in second in the standings (11-4), but own the best overall record (28-15).
- The SoCon Championship will be held May 13-15 at the site of the No. 1 seed and will feature the top four teams in the standings. Action this weekend determines the four seeds in the tournament. Western Carolina and UNCG have locked in spots but play each other this weekend to determine seeding and which team will host the four-team tournament.

SOCON 100TH ANNIVERSARY

The SoCon is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2021. The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.
