PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Amu Saaka - Furman

Saaka averaged 22.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and shot 68 percent from the floor as the Paladins earned wins over Samford, Chattanooga and Wofford last week.

After opening the week with 14 points against Samford, the Decatur, Ga., native poured in a season-high 30 points and added eight rebounds in Furman's victory over Chattanooga. Saaka closed the week with 22 points and six rebounds as Furman outlasted Wofford in overtime. He connected on 23-of-34 field goal attempts last week and knocked down 10-of-16 (.625) from three-point range.

Saaka leads the Paladins in scoring (17.2 ppg) and rebounding (6.5 rpg). He is the only player in the Southern Conference to rank in the top ten for both categories.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock, The Citadel's Cameron Wells, Elon's Drew Spradlin, Georgia Southern's Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims was a bright spot for the Mountaineers last week, leading the team in scoring in both contests. Sims scored 19 of ASU's 25 first-half points at The Citadel on his way to 28 on the night. He then added 21 points on 7-of-14 shooting at Charleston on Saturday with four of ASU's eight assists. Sims topped 1,900 points on the week and now stands at 1,940 for his career.
- ASU hosts Wofford in a rematch of last season's Southern Conference final on Thursday before setting out on the team's final Southern Conference road trip of the year, at Furman, UNCG and Elon over the next week.

ELON PHOENIX



- After scoring 77 points in a win over Davidson last Thursday, the Phoenix scored 84 points in a victory over Georgia Southern. Elon is second in the league in scoring (75.1 ppg) and ranks second in made three-pointers per game (9.2).
- Senior Drew Spradlin averaged 24.5 points in last week's wins. The guard currently leads the Phoenix and ranks ninth in the SoCon in scoring (14.7) and is seventh in the league with 2.0 made triples per game.
- Elon visits Samford Thursday night.

UNCG SPARTANS



- UNCG has dramatically increased its offensive output during its three-game winning streak. The Spartans have averaged 67.9 points per game this season, but UNCG averaged 79.6 points per contest during its last three games.
- The Spartans won their third consecutive game with an 87-75 victory over Georgia Southern last Thursday. UNCG had five players score in double figures and the Spartans shot 58 percent from the floor.
- UNCG will visit Chattanooga on Thursday. The Spartans will then visit Samford Saturday afternoon.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford is in the midst of a five-game losing streak, matching its worst slide since dropping five-consecutive contests against Furman, Appalachian State, Western Carolina, The Citadel and College of Charleston from Jan. 25 to Feb. 6 of last season.
- Josh Davis heads into this week's games as the 21st-ranked player on Samford's all-time scoring list. The Bulldogs' senior forward from Lubbock, Texas, is averaging 9.5 points per game this season and has scored 1,025 points in his collegiate career.
- Samford hosts Elon Thursday night. The Bulldogs will entertain UNCG Saturday afternoon.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Coming off a season-best shooting performance last week at home in the win over College of Charleston, UTC's shooting touch turned cold on the upstate South Carolina swing. The Mocs shot 34.9 percent (37-106) from the field, 22.7 percent (10-44) from three-point range and 54.4 percent (31-57) from the free throw line.
- After out-rebounding just one opponent in its first six games, The Mocs have won the battle on the glass in 13 of the 15 contests. UTC owns a rebounding margin of +7.2 (41.5-34.3) during that stretch.
- Chattanooga hosts UNCG Thursday.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina had its four-game winning streak snapped with consecutive road losses in Charleston, falling at CofC and at The Citadel last week. The Catamounts are in the midst of a stretch where four of five will be played on the road.
- The Catamounts return home to host Furman on Thursday night. WCU has won four-straight over the Paladins and three-consecutive meetings in Cullowhee.
- After hosting Furman on Thursday, the Catamounts will travel to take on Wofford Saturday night.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars, who rank No. 32 in the nation in scoring offense (77.5), averaged 83.0 points per game in wins over Western Carolina (93-64) on Jan. 20 and Appalachian State (73-64) on Jan. 22 to improve to 7-1 on the season at home.
- Andrew Goudelock currently ranks among the top five players in the country in points per game (5th, 23.4) and three-pointers made (4th, 3.4 avg). He became the school's all-time leading scorer with a game-high 29 points against Western Carolina on Jan. 20. Goudelock ranks second nationally among active Division I players this season in career points (2,162).
- College of Charleston visits Georgia Southern Wednesday.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior Austin Dahn became the third current member of the team to score 1,000 points. He reached the milestone with 13 points against Western Carolina. Dahn joins Urbanus (1,198), Demetrius Nelson (1,264) and Cameron Wells (1,854) as the 15th set of teammates with 1,000 career points to play alongside each other.
- Sophomore center Mike Groselle wrapped up a solid week in which he shot 16-of-21 (.762) from the floor and finished second on the team in scoring with 33 points. Groselle has improved his field goal percentage on the season to 61.3 percent (92-150) in the process.
- The Citadel visits Davidson Wednesday.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs 10 three-pointers to move into the top five on the school's career list. McKillop has knocked down 177 career triples. He is fourth in the SoCon this season with 2.6 made three-pointers per game.
- With 65 career blocked shots, sophomore Jake Cohen has moved in the top-10 at Davidson. Cohen currently leads the Southern Conference with 1.5 blocked shots per game. He has recorded multiple blocked shots in eight different games this season.
- The Wildcats host The Citadel Wednesday.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman earned an 85-59 victory over the Chattanooga Mocs on Saturday. The Paladins' 26-point triumph marked their largest margin of victory in 25 all-time wins against the Mocs.
- Senior Justin Dehm buried his 200th career three-pointer in a 73-68 overtime win against Wofford to move into second on Furman's career three-point list behind Eric Webb (273). Dehm is averaging 1.7 made triples per game this season and is second in the SoCon in three-point field goal percentage (.472).
- The Paladins travel to Western Carolina Thursday night. Furman returns home to host Appalachian State on Saturday.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Junior Ben Drayton III scored in double-figures for the 20th time this season with 14 points against Elon to move to 955 career points. Drayton leads Georgia Southern and ranks seventh in the league with 15.2 points per game.
- Georgia Southern ranks ninth in the country with 9.6 steals per game. Jelani Hewitt leads the team with 44 steals this season while Ben Drayton III and Eric Ferguson have 41 and 35 steals, respectively.
- Georgia Southern will host College of Charleston on Wednesday. The Eagles will host Davidson on Monday.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Wofford's 30-plus point wins over Samford and Chattanooga are two of only three 30-plus wins in SoCon play for the Terriers. The 38-point win over the Bulldogs was the largest SoCon victory ever for Wofford.
- Wofford is 6-1 when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 10-4 when holding opponents to under 50 percent. However when opponents shoot better than 50 percent the Terriers are just 1-5.
- Wofford visits Appalachian State on Thursday. The game will be televised by SportSouth.

COUSY CANDIDATES

The Southern Conference boasts four candidates for the 2011 Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard. The Award is presented through the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The Southern Conference Candidates Include:

RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.

MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2010-11.

CONFERENCE NOTES

FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

CONFERENCE NOTES

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the post-season for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
