Quick Hits

- Saturday's game between Wofford and College of Charleston will be televised on the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3.
- Georgia Southern won just one league game last season but already has six victories through ten conference games this year.
- After dropping 11 straight games, UNCG has now won five in a row and is a half-game out of first place in the North Division.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

Derrell Armstrong has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 17-23. The junior averaged 28 points and five rebounds in two games last week as the Spartans ran their win streak to four with victories against Chattanooga (81-72) and Samford (61-60).

The junior guard poured in a season-high 29 points Thursday against Chattanooga, going 10-of-16 from the field, 5-of-8 from three-point range and 4-of-5 at the line. He set season highs in both field goals (10) and three-pointers (5) while adding five rebounds, four assists and two steals.

Armstrong led the Spartans again on Sunday afternoon with 27 points in a last-second, one-point victory against Samford. The Mechanicsville, Md., native connected on 10-of-22 field goal attempts, including three triples. He also added five rebounds, two steals and a pair of assists.

Other top performers in the SoCon included Appalachian State's Andre Williamson, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Davidson's Jake Cohen, Elon's Lucas Troutman, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Samford's Tyler Hood, Western Carolina's Trey Sumler, and Wofford's Kevin Giltner.

**MOUNTAINEERS**

Omar Carter came off the bench and scored a team-high 19 points Thursday night but ASU dropped a 77-73 decision in overtime at UNCG. Jamaal Trice, Andre Williamson and Tab Hamilton all scored in double figures for the Mountaineers.

Williamson recorded five blocked shots against the Spartans. He was 5-of-8 from the field Thursday and is second in the SoCon in field goal percentage (.608).

The Mountaineers host Elon Saturday afternoon. ASU faces Samford February 2.

NORTH DIVISION**COUGARS**

Trent Wiedeman posted a double-double with 10 points and 11 rebounds but College of Charleston lost to Furman Thursday, 69-63. Andrew Lawrence paced the Cougars with 15 points while senior Antwaine Wiggins added 12.

The Cougars rank third in the league with 7.1 steals per game. Andrew Lawrence leads the league with 2.0 steals per contest.

CofC welcomes Wofford to TD Arena Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised on the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3.

SOUTH DIVISION**PHOENIX**

Sophomore Jack Isenbarger scored a game-high 26 points as Elon topped Western Carolina Thursday in Cullowhee. Isenbarger was 5-of-8 from three-point range and knocked down 7-of-8 free throw attempts.

The Phoenix rank third in the Southern Conference in three-point percentage (.346) and made triples per game (8.1).

The Phoenix visit Appalachian State Saturday. Elon will host College of Charleston next Thursday.

NORTH DIVISION**BULLDOGS**

Bo Holston scored a season-high 14 points in The Citadel's 62-55 loss to Wofford Thursday. DeVontae Wright grabbed a game-high nine rebounds against the Terriers.

Junior center Mike Groselle has posted 10 double-doubles this season, moving him within two of Patrick Elmore's single-season school record of 12 which was set during the 1989-90 season.

The Citadel hosts Furman Saturday night. The Bulldogs will travel to UNCG February 2.

**SPARTANS**

Trevis Simpson and Derrell Armstrong combined for 51 of UNCG's 77 points Thursday. Simpson scored 24 points in 27 minutes while Armstrong added 27 off the bench. Taylor Hoffer added a double-double for UNCG.

Thursday's victory over ASU extended UNCG's winning streak to five games, their longest streak since the 2007-08 season.

UNCG welcomes Western Carolina to the Greensboro Coliseum Saturday afternoon. The Spartans host The Citadel February 2.

NORTH DIVISION**WILDCATS**

Nik Cochran hit a free throw with 1.2 seconds left to lift Davidson past Chattanooga 64-63 on Thursday. JP Kuhlman paced the Wildcats with 16 points while Jake Cohen added 10. De'Mon Brooks pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds.

The Wildcats have won 17 of their last 18 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season. Davidson is the last unbeaten team in league play this season.

The Wildcats travel to Samford Saturday. Davidson visits Furman February 1.

**BULLDOGS**

Drew Windler scored 18 points for Samford as the Bulldogs downed Georgia Southern 57-55 Thursday. Winder ranks ninth in the league in scoring (13.8 ppg).

Samford forced the Eagles into 17 turnovers and recorded 14 assists on 18 made baskets.

Samford has won three of its last four games after suffering a six-game losing streak.

The Bulldogs host Davidson Saturday afternoon.

NORTH DIVISION**PALADINS**

Brandon Sebirumbi scored 15 points and pulled down nine rebounds as Furman topped College of Charleston 69-63 Thursday. It was Furman's first win at CofC since the 1952-53 season. Bryant Irwin added 14 points off the bench and was 4-of-5 from three-point range.

Richard Brown ranks third in the SoCon in assists-to-turnovers ratio (1.9) and fourth in the conference in free throw percentage (.848).

The Paladins travel to The Citadel Saturday. Furman will host Davidson February 1.

**MOCS**

Ricky Taylor, Dontay Hampton, Jared Bryant and Drazen Zlovaric all scored in double figures Thursday but Chattanooga fell to Davidson, 64-63.

Chattanooga has given up just 66.4 points per game, the third best mark in the league. Chattanooga has limited its opponents to 39.3 percent shooting from the field, the best mark in the conference.

Chattanooga will host Georgia Southern Saturday evening at McKenzie Arena. The Mocs visit Western Carolina February 2.

NORTH DIVISION**EAGLES**

Jelani Hewitt scored a game-high 23 points for the Eagles but Georgia Southern fell at Samford, 57-55. Hewitt made 5-of-10 attempts from three-point range, while teammate Eric Ferguson scored 14 points for the Eagles.

The Eagles made 22 of 45 (.489) field goal attempts against the Bulldogs and lead the SoCon in field goal percentage. GSU is tied for third in the conference in three-point shooting (.346).

Georgia Southern travels to Chattanooga Saturday night.

**CATAMOUNTS**

Sophomore Trey Sumler scored a team-high 18 points for WCU, but the Catamounts fell to Elon 71-63 Thursday. Tawaski King tallied a double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds. King added four steals in 33 minutes.

The Catamounts ranks second in the SoCon with 3.7 blocked shots per game, but do not have a single player ranked among the top 15 for blocks in the league.

Western Carolina visits UNCG Saturday afternoon. The Catamounts then travel to Wofford Monday night.

NORTH DIVISION**TERRIERS**

Karl Cochran's game-high 18 points lifted the Terriers past The Citadel, 62-55, Thursday night. Cochran connected on 4-of-8 three-point attempts in the win.

Wofford's team defense is first at 61.7 ppg, but the scoring offense is last in the SoCon at 63.9 ppg.

Wofford is averaging 72.2 points at home and only 57.8 points on the road. The Terriers are 8-1 at home and 4-6 on the road after Thursday's victory at The Citadel.

SOUTH DIVISION

Conference News and Notes

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 79.2 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Athletes of the Month

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Waginger, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.
