Two SoCon teams will be on TV for their first-round playoff games. Furman hosts Nicholls State at 12:30 on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast. Georgia Southern travels to Texas State in the first round of the NCAA I-AA Football Playoffs. The game will be televised on ESPN2 at 3:30 p.m.

Two-Minute Drill

• The Southern Conference had three teams selected to the NCAA Football I-AA Playoffs, the most selections by a conference in this year's field. This is the ninth time in conference history that the SoCon has placed three teams in the playoffs and 19th time in 24 years that the league has had multiple teams in the playoffs.

• Appalachian State is the league's automatic qualifier and is making its first appearance in the playoffs since 2002. Furman and Georgia Southern received at-large bids. ASU also garnered the No. 2 overall seed in the playoffs. Both Appalachian State and Furman will host in the first-round.

• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll, all three in the top 10. Furman is in the No. 3 spot in the poll with Appalachian State checking in at No. 4. Georgia Southern jumps two spots to No. 6 this week. It marks the ninth time in the past two seasons that three SoCon teams have been ranked in the top 10 in the same week.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman climbs to No. 3 with Appalachian State at No. 4. Georgia Southern remains in the top 10 at No. 7.

• ASU's Richie Williams is 137 yards shy of becoming the Southern Conference's all-time career leader in total offense. He currently has 8,575 yards of total offense. Williams is also only the fourth QB to toss for 50-plus touchdowns in a career.

• Georgia Southern comes into the playoffs as the winningest program in I-AA playoff history with 38 playoff victories and an .809 winning percentage (38-9).

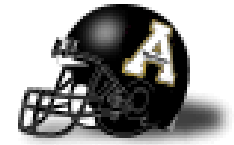
PLAYOFF HISTORY: This is the third trip to the playoffs for Nicholls State, and the school's first since a 48-3 loss at Montana in 1996...The Colonels also played in the 1986 playoffs and lost to Appalachian State, 28-26...For Furman, this is the Paladins' 14th trip to the playoffs and sixth appearance in the last seven years...Furman advanced to the quarterfinals in 2004, defeating Jacksonville State in the first round and losing 14-13 to eventual champion James Madison, 14-13, in the quarterfinals...The Paladins are 15-12 all-time in the NCAA I-AA playoffs and have the sixth-best winning percentage (.556) among active I-AA schools...This is the tenth time that Furman has hosted a first round game and are 5-4 when hosting a first round contest.

THE GAME: This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools...NSU shared the Southland Conference's crown with Texas State but earned the league's automatic bid after defeating the Bobcats back in late October, 32-29 in overtime...The Colonels closed out the regular season with a 39-26 win over McNeese State to win their first-ever Southland crown...Furman concluded its regular season with a 56-35 win over Chattanooga...QB Ingle Martin was 15-of-17 and passed for a career-best 332 yards and two touchdowns to become only the second Paladin to throw for 5,000 career yards...With 5,196 yards, Martin is 184 yards from becoming the school's all-time leader in passing...The Paladins racked up 662 yards of total offense, 332 passing and 330 rushing...RB Cedrick Gipson rushed for 137 yards on only 16 carries (8.6 ypc)...RB Jerome Felton scored four touchdowns on the day, three rushing and one receiving...Furman's Jerome Felton, Daric Carter, Gipson and Brandon Mays have each rushed for over 500 yards each and have scored a combined 27 touchdowns on the ground...LB William Freeman is seven tackles shy of reaching 300 for his career...Furman is the top scoring team in the conference, averaging 38.8 points per game.

THE COACHES: Jay Thomas (Southern Miss '88) is in his second year as head coach of the Colonels and has an 11-8 record...Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 33-14 record while at the head of the Paladins program.

PLAYOFF HISTORY: Lafayette makes its second appearance in the playoffs as an at-large selection and second in as many years...The Leopards lost 28-14 at Delaware a year ago in their only postseason game...Appalachian State is making its 13th appearance in the playoffs and has an 8-12 record in 20 playoff games...ASU enters as the No. 2 seed in the playoff seedings...The Mountaineers, the Southern Conference's automatic qualifier, are in the playoffs for the first time since 2002 -- a 14-13 loss to Maine at home...ASU is 4-3 at home in first round games...The SoCon is 2-0 lifetime against teams from the Patriot League in the playoffs.

THE GAME: This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools...Lafayette won a share of its second straight Patriot League crown with a 23-19 come-from-behind win over Lehigh last Saturday...The Leopards won their last two games of the regular season and three of their last four...Lafayette is averaging only 22.7 points per game but leads the Patriot League in scoring defense, surrendering only 15.5 ppg...Appalachian State claimed its first outright SoCon title since 1995 with a 52-14 win at Elon on Saturday...ASU enters the game third in the league in scoring (30.3 ppg)...QB Richie Williams is 137 yards of total offense shy of becoming the league's all-time leader in total offense...Williams, who has 7,054 passing yards and 8,575 yards of total offense, is also 177 passing yards from moving into fourth place on the SoCon career list...Williams also needs 50 yards of offense to become only the sixth player to reach 3,000 yards of total offense in one season...RB Kevin Richardson rushed for 89 yards and two touchdowns vs. Elon and also added another 52 receiving yards and a third score...Richardson eclipsed the 1,000-yard mark for this season on the ground, the fourth back in the league to do so this year and only the 14th ASU player to do so in one season...DB Titus Howard recorded his first career interception vs. Elon and returned it 70 yards for a TD...The ASU defense allowed the Phoenix only 138 yards of offense, their best defensive output of the season.

THE COACHES: In his sixth year as head coach of Lafayette, Frank Tavani (Lebanon Valley '75) has an overall record of 32-35...The winningest coach in SoCon football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 136-66 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school.

PLAYOFF HISTORY: Georgia Southern is making its 16th trip to the NCAA playoffs, second most in championship history...The Eagles are the winningest program in I-AA history with 38 playoff victories and an .809 winning percentage (38-9)...The Eagles are appearing in their second straight playoff and their eighth in nine years...Last year, GSU lost to New Hampshire, 27-21...Texas State is making its first-ever I-AA playoff appearance but did win back-to-back Division II titles in 1981 and 1982...The Bobcats were an at-large selection and were co-champions in the Southland Conference with Nicholls State.

THE GAME: Texas State and Georgia Southern are meeting for the first time...GSU was idle last week and finished the regular season winners of seven of its final eight games...RB Jermaine Austin leads the SoCon and is sixth nationally averaging 127.2 yards per game...Austin enters the game with 5,264 career rushing yards, fourth all-time in conference history and 11th in I-AA annals...Austin needs just 90 yards to move into second place in SoCon history for career rushing yards...QB Jayson Foster has rushed for 1,330 yards, second in league history and fifth-highest for a quarterback in I-AA history...Foster is 93 yards shy of eclipsing former GSU QB Chaz Williams for the single season rushing mark by a SoCon signal caller...Foster has rushed for 19 touchdowns this season, the third most by a quarterback in one season and sixth overall...Texas State QB Barrick Nealy has accounted for nearly 2,900 yards of total offense this season -- 2,043 passing yards and 834 on the ground -- and has been responsible for 25 touchdowns (11 rush, 14 pass).

THE COACHES: Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 35-13 in three-plus years as head coach of Georgia Southern...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 95-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000...David Bailiff (Texas State '81) is 14-8 in two seasons as head coach at his alma mater.

Nov. 26, 1994: Aldwin Lance ran for a 25-yard touchdown in overtime to give Appalachian State a 17-10 win over New Hampshire in the first round of the NCAA I-AA playoffs.
