### QUICK HITS

The SoCon is now one of just three conferences to have six teams ranked in both major polls, along with the Colonial Athletic Association and the Missouri Valley Football Conference ... Due to the difference in each conference's size, however, two-thirds (6 of 9) of all SoCon and Missouri Valley teams are ranked compared to one-half (6 of 12) of teams from the CAA ... Elon won its conference opener for the first time since joining the league in 2003, while Georgia Southern is 0-1 in the SoCon for the fourth consecutive season ... SoCon teams are now 11-4 against FCS non-conference opponents with just two regular season non-conference FCS contests remaining (Presbyterian at Appalachian State, Elon at Liberty) ... Saturday's Samford at Elon matchup will be the Bulldogs' first SoCon game and pits the two newest league members (Elon - 2003).

Hudgins notched season-highs in both receptions (13) and receiving yards (199) while setting the SoCon career record for receptions (226) and receiving touchdowns (29).

Rice tallied 11 tackles, including six solo stops, against Princeton. The sophomore also recorded three quarterback hurries, one tackle for loss and a sack while also returning a blocked punt for a touchdown.

# SoCon News and Notes



**Hudgins Rewriting Record Books:** Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With his 13-catch, 199-yard, 1-touchdown effort at Georgia Southern on Sept. 20, Hudgins became the league's all-time leader in receptions (226) and receiving touchdowns (29). Just four games into his junior season, Hudgins also now sits in fifth place on the SoCon's career receiving yards list, 524 yards out of first place.

**Experienced Coaches:** Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 256 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 168 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (52 victories) needs 12 victories to enter the top 10.

**SoCon Players Make NFL Impact:** 23 players (21 on active roster, 2 on practice squads) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State leads the way with five players while Chattanooga has three ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington were all in the starting lineup during week one.

**SoCon Well-Represented on Payton/Buchanan Watch Lists:** Three Southern Conference players were named to the Payton Award watch list while SoCon preseason defensive player of the year Pierre Banks from Appalachian State was chosen for the Buck Buchanan Award watch list ... ASU QB Armanti Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

**Non-Conference Schedule Notes:** The nine SoCon schools have 32 non-conference games on the schedule this season ... 10 games are against FBS opponents, including five against the SEC and four versus the ACC ... Chattanooga ventures into Big 12 territory to face preseason No. 4 Oklahoma ... among the 17 FCS non-conference games, seven come against the Big South and four are against CAA opponents ... SoCon teams will face six non-Division I teams in 2008 ... the most common SoCon opponent is Presbyterian, which will battle four SoCon teams (Appalachian State, Elon, Western Carolina and Wofford) ... the last team to face at least four SoCon opponents in the same season was Coastal Carolina, which went 2-3 against league teams in 2006 ... two-time opponents include Florida State (WCU, Chattanooga) and Liberty (Elon, WCU).

**Rebuilding and Reloading:** SoCon teams return 57 percent of their starters from last season (133 of 233) ... the most experienced group are the specialists (63%) followed by defense (60%) and offense (53%) ... Elon has the most experienced group of returning starters as 21 of 25 (84 percent) return from a Phoenix team which finished 7-4 overall and 4-3 in the SoCon last season ... Elon boasts the most experience group in all three categories while Samford (seven offense, eight defense, four specialist) has the second-most experience group with 70.4 percent returning ... although Georgia Southern returns nine starters on defense, the Eagles bring back a SoCon-low three starters on "O".

**Samford Begins SoCon Play:** Samford became the Southern Conference's 12th current member and 43rd all-time when it joined the league officially on July 1 ... the school based in Birmingham, Ala. has 4,500 students, and it most recently competed in the Ohio Valley Conference ... the Bulldogs will be under the guidance of 1971 Heisman Trophy winner Pat Sullivan for the second season in 2008, and they play their first SoCon contest at Elon on Sept. 27 ... when Samford hosts Appalachian State on Oct. 11, it will mark the first Southern Conference game played in the state of Alabama since Dec. 3, 1932 when Auburn played South Carolina to a 20-20 tie in Birmingham ... the last time a SoCon team from Alabama won a league game was Nov. 24, 1932 when Alabama shut out Vanderbilt, 20-0, in Birmingham.

**SoCon to Begin League Hall of Fame:** The Southern Conference will induct its first-ever hall of fame class in the spring of 2009 with a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C. ... the 88-year old league is the fifth-oldest Division I conference in the country and has seen such stars as Arnold Palmer (Wake Forest), Jerry West (West Virginia), Terrell Owens (Chattanooga) and "Hot Rod" Hundley (West Virginia) play in the league in addition to legendary coaches such as Adolph Rupp (Kentucky), Everett Case (North Carolina State), Wallace Wade (Alabama, Duke), Bear Bryant (Kentucky), General Robert Neyland (Tennessee) and Lefty Dreisell (Davidson).

**Strength in the Classroom Matches Strength on the Field:** In addition to boasting eight national championships and semifinal appearances in 21 of the past 25 seasons, SoCon teams also excel in the classroom ... five SoCon players earned CoSIDA/ESPN the Magazine Academic All District honors in 2007, trailing the SEC's seven and leading the ACC (4), Conference USA (3), Big South (2), Pioneer (2) and CAA (1) ... Furman's Jerome Felton and Scott Shuford were joined on the list by ASU's Pierre Banks and Wofford's Dan Tavani and Kevin Adleman.

Sophomore Marquel Pittman hauled in an acrobatic four-yard scoring strike with just over three minutes remaining to put WCU ahead for good. Freshman Quan Warley rushed for 202 yards on the day, which was the highest in the SoCon this season.

Sept. 20 - No. 22 The Citadel 37, Princeton 24

The Citadel outscored Princeton 30-7 in a second half rally to lead the Bulldogs to a 37-24 victory. A Mel Capers blocked punt was the turnaround in the game after which The Citadel scored on five consecutive possessions.

### Game Notes

The Citadel has won four straight from Western Carolina, including a 37-31 victory in Cullowhee last season ... prior to 2004, WCU had won 9 of 11 against the Bulldogs ... Quan Warley's 202-yard effort against Presbyterian on Sept. 20 was Western Carolina's first 200-yard rushing game since Fred Boateng totaled 213 against Georgia Southern on Oct. 7, 2000 ... two of The Citadel's 14 touchdowns in 2008 have come front the punt return team (1 return, 1 block).

Dustin Taliaferro completed 16-of-22 passes for 124 yards and wide-out Jonathan Lowery caught four passes for 55 yards. Riley Hawkins returned four kicks for 121 yards, including a 52-yard return and scored on a 13-yard reverse late in the first quarter.

Andrew Wilcox drilled a career-high five field goals – including a game-winner with six seconds left – to move Elon to 1-0 in the SoCon. The Phoenix rolled up 509 yards of total offense – 308 in the air and 201 on the ground – while holding the Eagles to 339 net yards – 232 in the air and 107 on the ground.

### Game Notes

This marks Samford's first official Southern Conference game ... the Bulldogs maintain the league's number-one scoring defense, rushing defense and total defense ... Elon is atop the league charts, and 11th nationally, in passing offense ... after averaging just 20.0 yards rushing in its first two games, Elon has averaged 223.5 on the ground in games three and four.

## This Date in SoCon History

**Sept. 27, 2003:** Backup quarterback Trey Hunter provided relief for injured starter Chaz Williams and helped Georgia Southern to a 34-3 victory over Chattanooga. Hunter threw for two touchdown passes and ran for another as the Eagle offense racked up 525 total yards.

**Sept. 27, 2003:** Furman scored on the ground, on defense and on a punt return as it shutout Gardner-Webb, 45-0. The Paladin defense forced six Bulldog turnovers led by Shelton Riley's 44-yard interception return for a TD.

**Sept. 27, 2003:** Western Carolina receiver Lamont Seward caught 12 passes for 176 yards as the Catamounts racked up 446 yards and held the ball for over 39 minutes in its 28-21 victory over East Tennessee State. Not to be outdone, the Catamount defense held the Bucs to 76 yards of total offense.

**Sept. 27, 2003:** The Citadel scored 10 fourth quarter points to defeat Appalachian State, 24-21. The Citadel faked a punt to set up the tying touchdown and then the defense intercepted a Richie Williams pass to puf the Bulldogs in position to kick the winning the field goal.

**Sept. 27, 1997:** ASU quarterback Bake Baker accounted for four touchdowns (3 passing, 1 rushing) as the Mountaineers opened SoCon play 1-0 with a 40-15 win at The Citadel.

**Sept. 27, 1997:** Quarterback Brent Rickman set a Furman freshman record with 335 yards passing and three touchdowns in the Paladins 35-14 victory over VMI. Furman nearly doubled up the Keydets in total yards 505-274.

**Sept. 27, 1997:** Georgia Southern raced out to a 20-0 first quarter advantage and held on for a 37-10 win over Chattanooga in Statesboro. Fullback Roderick Russell led the Eagles' rushing attack with 160 yards and a score.

**Sept. 27, 1986:** Appalachian State rushed for 307 yards and Bjorn Nittmo booted five field goals in the Mountaineers' 33-10 win over the Citadel in Boone.

**Sept. 27, 1986:** Furman improved to 11-0 all-time against Marshall with a 38-10 win in Huntington. The Paladins outgained the Thundering Herd 481-131 as Keith Moore passed for two TDs and ran for a third.

**Sept. 27, 1980:** Steve Brown passed for 408 yards and three touchdowns while WR Rick Beasley caught nine of those passes for 220 and a TD as Appalachian State routed ETSU, 42-15.

**Sept. 27, 1980:** Stump Mitchell rushed for 170 yards and two touchdown, and The Citadel's defense forced two turnovers as it defeat preseason SoCon favorite Chattanooga, 29-13, in Charleston, ending a two-game slide.

**Sept. 27, 1980:** Tim Sorrells connected with Stanford Jennings on a 34-yard touchdown pass in the final moments to give Furman a 21-16 win over VMI as Greenville. The Paladins had rallied from a 13-0 halftime deficit and a 16-14 VMI lead with just 2:41 remaining.

## Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)
