### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Cameron Wells - The Citadel

Wells averaged 23.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and dished out eight assists last week.

A junior guard from Houston, Wells scored a game-high 28 points in The Citadel's 56-54 loss at Chattanooga Thursday. He added six rebounds, three assists and three steals against the Mocs. Wells then scored 19 points, including 11 of the team's final 13, against Samford as The Citadel pulled out a 51-50 win in Birmingham Saturday afternoon. He added seven rebounds and five assists in the victory.

Wells moved past Demetrius Nelson into ninth place on the school's all-time scoring list (1,266 pts). He is currently third in the conference with 17.8 points per game and is fourth in the SoCon with 4.1 assists per contest. Wells also ranks fourth in the league in free throw percentage (.831) and steals per game (1.7 spg).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Through 18 games, Appalachian leads the SoCon in field goal and three-point field goal percentage and ranks second in free throw shooting and rebounding. Isaac Butts leads the league with a 61.7 shooting percentage and ranks second in rebounding with 8.4 per game.
- The Mountaineers matched their longest winning

streak of the season at three games with SoCon wins against division foes Elon and UNC Greensboro last week. ASU saw the streak end with a 68-65 loss at Georgia Southern Wednesday.

- Appalachian State hosts rival Western Carolina Saturday.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Junior guard Chris Long remains one of the best distributors in the conference. Long is seventh in the league with 3.4 helpers per game. He has recorded at least three assists in eight of his last 10 games, including a season-high 11 assists at NC State.
- The Phoenix have been one of the best teams in the

conference in steals. Elon averages 6.4 steals per game, the fifth best mark in the league. Long averages 1.3 thefts per game, good for 11th best in the conference, while senior Devan Carter has averaged 1.1 steals per contest, the 15th best mark in the SoCon.

- The Phoenix host Chattanooga Saturday night.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- The Spartans are in the midst of a three-game home-stand this week, but not all three games will be played at the Coliseum. Saturday's game against Samford will be back on-campus at Fleming Gym due to a George Strait concert at the Coliseum on Saturday night.
- Ben Stywall had another double-doubles Thursday

to give him nine on the season and 21 for his career. Six of his nine double-doubles have come in UNCG's seven SoCon games this season. In eight conference games this season, Stywall is averaging 15.9 points and 11.9 rebounds per contest.

- The Spartans host Samford Saturday afternoon.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford snapped its four-game losing streak with a 50-49 win on the road at Elon Thursday. The Bulldogs' four-game slide was their longest losing streak since dropping four league game last season (Jan. 31 - Feb. 9).

- Bryan Friday, Trey Montgomery and Josh Davis have been Samford's most consistent players as of late. In the Bulldogs' last seven games, Friday is averaging 12.4 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.6 assists while Davis follows with an average of 13.4 points, 3.6 rebounds and 2.4 three-point field goals per contest. Montgomery is averaging of 9.7 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game since Christmas.
- The Bulldogs visit UNC Greensboro Saturday afternoon.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- After winning six consecutive games, the Mocs have now lost two straight with losses at home to CofC and at UNC Greensboro. The last time the Mocs had a six-game winning streak was during the 2001-02 season.
- A defensive streak was also snapped on Saturday.

Prior to the Charleston game, the Mocs held six straight opponents under 40 percent shooting. CofC hit an even 50 percent against the Mocs.

- Chattanooga visits Elon Saturday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- With wins over UNC Greensboro and Elon last week, Western Carolina improved to 10-0 at home this season while extending its home court winning streak to 13-straight games. WCU has won 23 of its last 25 home games in the Ramsey Center and 14 of its last 15 SoCon matchups in Cullowhee.

- WCU led at the half against Davidson and held on to win the game. The Catamounts improved 14-0 this season when leading at intermission.
- Western Carolina visits rival Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel lost at home 44-42, to Wofford Thursday night. It was the second time in the last three games that the Bulldogs lost on a shot in the game's final second. The Citadel is 0-3 this season in games decided by less than three points.

• Junior guard Cameron Wells tallied 17 of The Citadel's 42 points Thursday night and moved into eighth place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,283 career points. Wells passed Travis Cantrell (1,273) during Thursday's loss to Wofford.

- The Bulldogs host Furman Saturday night in Charleston, S.C.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- After knocking off Furman Thursday night, the Cougars are 7-0 in league play for the first time since the 2003-04 season. The last time the College of Charleston started 7-0 in conference play was 1998-99 when CofC finished 16-0 and 28-3 overall.
- Junior Andrew Goudelock averaged 22.5 points over two

games last week. Goudelock leads the league lead with 19.6 points per game and has averaged 21.0 points per contest in CofC's six seven games.

- The Cougars take on Wofford Friday night on ESPN2. CofC then visits North Division leader Western Carolina Monday night.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Steve Rossiter needs just seven points and become the 30th Davidson player to tally 500 points and 500 rebounds. Rossiter topped the 500-rebound mark with 10 boards against Western Carolina. He has started in every game for the Wildcats this season. He is averaging 6.5 points and 6.1

rebounds per contest and is shooting 52 percent from the field.

- Senior Will Archambault is 58 points away from becoming the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.1 points per game, the 18th best mark in the league.
- The Wildcats visit Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Junior Justin Dehm has dished out 54 assists and committed just 21 turnovers to lead the Southern Conference with a 2.6 assist-to-turnover ratio. He has totaled 26 assists and been guilty of only seven turnovers over the last eight games.
- Coming off of back-to-back seasons of 7-23 and 6-24,

Furman has shown significant improvement through the first half of the 2009-10 season while posting a 9-9 record. After averaging just 61 points per game last season, the Paladins have scored 71.1 per contest this season and topped 80 points on six outings.

- Furman visits College of Charleston Thursday.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Georgia Southern will retire Chester Webb's No. 22 jersey on January 30. A two-time All-American, NBA draft pick and the leading scorer and rebounder in the history of the program, Webb played from 1952-56.
- The Eagles have started eight different starting line-ups during the course of this season. Antonio Hanson has started all 20 games for GSU, while Willie Powers has started in 19 of 20 contests. Johntavious Rucker has made 15 starts this season, including each of the last 12 contests.

- Georgia Southern hosts Davidson Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised on SportSouth.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Eleven different players have scored in double figures this season for Wofford. Junior Noah Dahlman leads the team with double-figure scoring performances in all 20 games this season. Dahlman has an active streak of 33 consecutive games in double-figures.
- The Terriers have used only three different starting

line-ups this season with a total of seven different players getting starts. Brad Loesing, Noah Dahlman and Junior Salters have started all 20 games, while Cameron Rundles, Jamar Diggs, Corey Godzinski and Tim Johnson have also earned starts.

- Wofford visits College of Charleston Friday night.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

### ALL-DECADE RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released it's All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

### 40-POINT CLUB

Appalachian State's Donald Sims scored 44 points January 9 at Davidson. It was the highest scoring output for a SoCon performer since Davidson's Stephen Curry tallied 44 points at Oklahoma on November 18, 2008. It was the 10th 40-point performance in a league game dating back to 1999.

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

### HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
