SOCON News and Notes

Welcome Back, Defense: After the past two seasons in which SoCon offenses lit up the scoreboard, defense is making a comeback across the league in 2009. In conference games, scoring is down approximately 6 points per game from a year ago and an astounding 22.1 points per game from 2007.

While scoring 30 points only resulted in a win 65 percent of the time in 2007, teams are 10-1 (.909) when scoring 30 or more points this season. In addition, after recording a 1-24 record (.040) in 2007-08 when scoring fewer than 20 points, SoCon teams are 4-9 (.308) this season when held under 20.

Hudgins, Roberts Rewriting Record Books: Elon's Terrell Hudgins and The Citadel's Andre Roberts will likely end their careers as the top two receivers in Southern Conference history.

Hudgins holds the career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns, and he is now taking aim at the NCAA marks in each category. On Saturday, Oct. 3, Hudgins became the NCAA Division I (FCS and FBS) career leader in receptions, and he now needs 188 more yards to top Hall of Famer Jerry Rice's career total of 4,693 yards.

Roberts is now in the top three in each category as well, ranking second in receptions, second in receiving touchdowns and third in receiving yards.

Appalachian Builds SoCon Win Streak: After starting SoCon play with a 4-0 mark in 2009, Appalachian State currently boasts a 16-game conference win streak. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak of its kind in school history and is tied for the fifth-longest win streak in league history. One more win would give ASU the longest SoCon win streak in the past 50 seasons.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

Edwards, Riddle Rank as Top SoCon QBs in League History: Appalachian State quarterback Armanti Edwards' 415-yard passing effort against Wofford on Oct. 17 vaulted him to the top of the SoCon's all-time passing list, and he now boasts 8,829 yards.

Edwards passed Elon quarterback Scott Riddle, who broke the previous record of ETSU's Greg Ryan on Sept. 26. Riddle has amassed 8,683 passing yards and holds the league's all-time passing records in completions (771) and passing touchdowns (71). Edwards is one TD behind at 70.

Riddle also set a new SoCon standard earlier this season for pass attempts without an interception, tossing 218 straight passes without a pick prior to a second half interception against Georgia Southern on Sept. 26.

Edwards a Dual Threat: In addition to his exploits as a passer, Armanti Edwards also ranks as one of the greatest rushing quarterbacks of all time. Already the SoCon's career leader in total offense with 12,855 yards, Edwards recently entered the SoCon top 10 list in career rushing as well with 4,026 yards.

The southpaw is currently sixth on the NCAA Division I FCS all-time chart for total offense, needing 241 yards at Furman on Saturday to move into the fourth spot. Former Alcorn State and NFL legend Steve McNair is the all-time leader in total offense with 16,823 yards.

Edwards Vies For Payton Award Double in 2009: Appalachian State quarterback Armanti Edwards was named as the recipient of the 2008 Walter Payton Award, which recognizes the top offensive player in FCS football. Edwards was the second straight SoCon QB to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. In total, five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award. A senior, Edwards is aiming to become the first player in the award's history to win it twice.

Elon's Terrell Hudgins, Samford's Chris Evans and The Citadel's Andre Roberts were also named the preseason watch list for the 2009 Walter Payton Award.

Appalachian Joins SoCon Record Books: Appalachian State completed a perfect 8-0 Southern Conference season in 2008, wrapping up its fourth consecutive league title. Appalachian State joins a short list of four-time champions, and if it wins the league crown again in 2009, Appalachian would become just the second-ever SoCon team to win five league titles in a row.

SoCon Teams Set Winning Standard This Decade: The Southern Conference boasts three of the top 10 winningest teams in FCS football (among playoff-qualifiers) this decade (2000-present). Appalachian State's 95 overall victories during that span trail only Montana (112) while Furman (81) and Georgia Southern (80) sit in the sixth and eighth spots, respectively.

Chattanooga Resurgent Under Huesman: Chattanooga has experienced a quick turnaround under first-year head coach Russ Huesman. The Mocs, who were 3-20 overall and 2-13 in SoCon play over the past two seasons, have darted out to a 4-3 start, including a 2-3 mark in SoCon play.

While Chattanooga's offense has improved from league lows in both scoring of offense (12.8 ppg) and total offense (224.9 ypg) to sixth- and fifth-place rankings in both this season (23.0 ppg, 315.9 ypg), UTC's defense can be credited with a large part of the team's improvement.

The Mocs surrendered a SoCon-worst 37.9 points and 442.5 yards per contest in 2008. However, in 2009, UTC is third in the conference at 22.1 points per game allowed and 301.9 yards per game. The Mocs' defense currently ranks 33rd in the nation in total defense and 50th in scoring defense after ranking 111th and 112th, respectively, in the same categories in 2008.

Rebuilding and Reloading: SoCon teams return 65 percent of their starters from last season (148-of-228), up from just 57 percent returnees in 2008 ... the most experienced group are the specialists (73%) followed by defense (65%) and offense (63%) ... Elon has the most experienced group of returning starters for the second year in a row as 20-of-25 (80%) return from a Phoenix team which finished 8-4 overall and 6-2 in the SoCon last season ... Elon is the only league team to return 9 of its starters on offense while Appalachian State and The Citadel join the Phoenix with nine starting defenders back ... Wofford (46% starters returning) and Furman (52%) have the most holes to fill in the starting 25.

Experienced Coaches: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 274 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 183 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (97) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (60 victories) needs four more victories to enter the top 10.

SoCon Players Make NFL Impact: 16 players with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Pro Bowl DB Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and three Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Facilities Improve Throughout the Conference: Both Kidd Brewer Stadium at Appalachian State and Seibert Stadium at Samford will look different to visitors this season as each stadium received significant upgrades during the offseason.

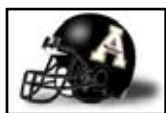
At ASU, a seven story, 120,000-square foot building behind the west stands at Kidd Brewer Stadium was officially opened this month. The facility is a part of ASU's \$50 million facilities enhancement campaign, which also included an indoor practice facility, baseball, softball and soccer stadiums. It provides office space in addition to locker rooms, club seating and a new press box.

Samford's home opener on Sept. 12 showcased the newly-constructed Cooney Family Field House, a \$7.5 million, 39,000 square-foot structure in the south end zone of Seibert Stadium.

Elsewhere around the league, Furman installed a new scoreboard with video replay capabilities and Wofford opened a new building adjacent to Gibbs Stadium that houses a new weight room and coaches offices.

This Date in SOCON History

Oct. 31, 1981

Chattanooga earned its second shutout of the month with a 17-0 win at East Tennessee State.

Furman used a balanced rushing attack and solid defense effort to defeat Marshall, 35-3.

Oct. 31, 1987

No. 2 Appalachian State's defense held its opponent to less than 10 points for the fourth consecutive game in a 28-9 win over East Tennessee State.

Tom Frooman and Tommy Burriss each rushed for two touchdowns and The Citadel bolted out to a 35-3 halftime lead before hanging on to defeat Western Carolina, 35-24.

In his first collegiate appearance, freshman QB Frankie DeBusk threw for three touchdowns and Furman limited Davidson to just 96 yards in total offense in a 58-3 victory.

Oct. 31, 1992

For the second time in three weeks, D.J. Campbell led Appalachian State to a last-second victory. This time, the QB tossed an 8-yard touchdown to Ray Gama with eight seconds remaining to lift ASU over No. 5 Marshall in Huntington, 37-34.

Furman built a 38-0 third quarter lead and cruised to a 45-14 SoCon win at East Tennessee State.

Lonnie Galloway passed for 266 yards and four touchdowns to lead Western Carolina to a 38-30 upset of No. 2 and eventual national champions Marshall in Cullowhee.

Oct. 31, 1998

No. 6 Appalachian State downed Chattanooga, 28-7, to improve to 7-1 on the season, led by Daniel Jeremiah's two touchdowns (one rushing, one passing).

Nick Hass booted a 32-yard field goal with six seconds remaining to send The Citadel past No. 16 Hofstra, 32-30. Hass's game-winning kick was set up by a 37-yard gain on a reverse by WR Carlos Frank.

No. 1 Georgia Southern rolled up 452 yards rushing and clinched at least a share of the SoCon title with a 47-26 win over East Tennessee State.

Brad Hoover was the star of Western Carolina's 39-17 win over VMI, rushing for 251 yards and four touchdowns while also catching three passes for 40 yards and a score.

Oct. 31, 2008

Armanti Edwards accounted for 440 yards of total offense and tied a school record with five touchdown passes as No. 2 Appalachian State routed No. 3 Wofford 70-24 in front of a national television audience on ESPN2. Brian Quick caught three TD passes and Mark LeGree grabbed three interceptions as a school-record crowd of 30,931 watched at Kidd Brewer Stadium.
