GSU's Louis Graham Named SoCon Player of the Week

Georgia Southern forward **Louis Graham** was named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for the week ending February 25.

Graham averaged 20.0 points and 5.0 rebounds as Georgia Southern downed The Citadel, 98-68, and fell to Austin Peay in *BracketBusters*, 80-72, last week.

The senior scored 23 points and dished out two assists against the Bulldogs and registered 17 points with seven boards and four blocked shots against the Governors.

The West Palm Beach, Fla. native was 13-of-26 (50.0 percent) from the floor, 2-of-4 (50.0 percent) from three-point range and was a perfect 12-12 from the line. He saw just 45 minutes of action playing 21 minutes against The Citadel and 24 versus Austin Peay.

Other standout performances were turned in by Elon's Montell Watson, Chattanooga's Khalil Hartwell, Wofford's Drew Gibson, College of Charleston's Jermaine Johnson, UNC Greensboro's Kyle Hines, Appalachian State's Jeremy Clayton, Davidson's Jason Richards, The Citadel's Zach Urbanus, Western Carolina's Brandon Giles and Furman's George Brozos.

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



- Appalachian State's big men accounted for 14 of the team's season-high 23 assists in a 90-77 win over Furman on Feb. 21. The 14 assists led to 46 points and eight of the team's 11 three-pointers. Jeremy Clayton dished out six assists and Ike Butts notched four.
- The Mountaineers shot 50 percent from the field on Feb. 27 against Davidson, becoming only the fourth team to do so against the Wildcats this season. But Davidson prevailed, 68-55.
- Appalachian State hosts rival Western Carolina on March 1 in the season finale. The Mountaineers will also celebrate Senior Day.



Elon

- Should the Phoenix defeat Chattanooga on Saturday, March 1, Elon would finish the SoCon season with a 10-10 record. It would mark the second time that the Phoenix had posted a .500 or better record in its five years in the conference.
- Montell Watson continues to climb in Elon's career top 10 lists. The senior is fourth with 155 steals, fifth with 315 assists, fifth with 122 three-pointers and fifth with 335 three-point attempts.
- Elon's double-overtime 87-86 victory over College of Charleston on Feb. 20 was the 100th victory at the Division I level for the Phoenix since Elon moved to Division I status in 1999-00.



UNC Greensboro

- UNC Greensboro had only four players score but three had 20 or more points (Mikko Koivisto-25, Kyle Hines-23, Kevin Oleksiak-22) as the Spartans beat College of Charleston, 75-67, on Feb. 26 and ensure a winning season. The Spartans are currently 16-11, 10-8 in Southern Conference play.
- With 11 rebounds on Feb. 19 at Davidson, Kyle Hines joined the elite 2,000-point/1,000-rebound club. Of the 96 players who have reached the milestone, only five have also blocked 300 shots. Hines has 330 blocked shots in his career. In his last 12 games, the senior has averaged 21.3 points, 9.8 rebounds per game.
- The Spartans close out the regular season by hosting Chattanooga on Feb. 28 and Western Carolina on March 3.



Chattanooga

- Chattanooga honored the McKenzie Arena 25th Anniversary Team with an 82-76 win over Wofford on Feb. 23. The five-member team includes Willie White, Gerald Wilkins, Lance Fulsa, Tim Brooks and Brandon Born.
- When leading with five minutes to play, Chattanooga is 15-0 this season, 1-0 when tied and 1-11 when trailing.
- After connecting on just four of their first 14 free throws (28.6 percent), the Mocs finished the game with Wofford by making 15-of-18 (83.3 percent) over the final 6:54 of play.



Western Carolina

- On Feb. 28, Western Carolina will honor seniors Arnold Gore, Negus McKenna and Eric Wilson.
- Sophomore guard Brandon Giles was a passenger in a vehicle involved in an accident on Feb. 24 and was treated and released from Harris Regional Hospital. His status for Thursday's game will be evaluated prior to game time. Giles leads the Catamounts in scoring.
- Sophomore Brandon Giles extended his double-digit scoring streak to 18. He scored 10 points against UNC Greensboro and had 13 points against The Citadel.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



■ After losing 13 games in 18 years when shooting 50 percent or better from the field, the Cougars lost twice in the past week. They shot 50 percent in an 87-86 double-overtime loss to Elon and 50 percent in a 75-67 loss at UNC Greensboro on Feb. 26, marking the 14th and 15th losses when shooting well. The Cougars are 145-15 when shooting 50 percent or better from the field in the past 18 years.

■ Andrew Goudelock had 18 points and moved into first place on the school's NCAA Division I freshman single-season scoring list with 364 points. He has averaged 16.7 ppg the last three games.

■ The Cougars will play their final game in the F. Mitchell Johnson Center/Kresse Arena in their March 1 match-up with Furman. The arena opened in 1982-83.



The Citadel

■ With 65 treys, freshman Zach Urbanus has moved into 10th on The Citadel's single-season list.

■ The Citadel's 257 treys in 2007-08 are the most in school history as are its 654 attempts.

■ Freshman Zach Urbanus averaged 19.0 points last week with 10 rebounds shooting 46.2 percent (12-of-26) from the field, 46.7 percent on treys (7-of-15) and 77.8 percent (7-of-9) from the line.



Davidson

■ Davidson has won 18 consecutive games and 30 straight SoCon regular-season contests and 43 of its last 44 against SoCon competition. The Wildcats are 19-0 in league play for the second time in coach Bob McKillop's tenure. The 17 wins is the longest winning streak in the nation.

■ Davidson's 76-55 victory over UNC Greensboro on Feb. 19 give the Wildcats 20 victories, marking the fourth straight season the Wildcats have hit the 20-win plateau.

■ Jason Richards scored his 1,000th career point when he tallied 24 points in a 68-55 win over Appalachian State on Feb. 27.



Furman

■ Furman's lone senior, George Brozos, registered a double-double with 18 points and 10 boards in a 67-61 win over Wofford on Senior Night.

■ Furman's victory over Wofford in the home finale marked the Paladins' fourth win in its last five games at Timmons Arena.

■ Furman plays at The Citadel on Feb. 28, marking the 188th meeting between the teams. It is the longest series among current SoCon members.



Georgia Southern

■ Louis Graham averaged 20.0 points last week with 10 boards and four blocks. He scored 23 points against The Citadel and 17 at Austin Peay. He was a perfect 12-of-12 from the line.

■ Matthew Fields has recorded three straight double-doubles and has averaged 13.7 points and 12.0 rebounds over the span. He set a career high with 14 boards at Austin Peay.

■ Fields is shooting 72.4 percent from the field in the last 10 games and hasn't shot less than 50 percent since Jan. 19.



Wofford

■ A victory at Western Carolina or against The Citadel will give the Terriers 15 wins this year, the most since Wofford moved to Division I in 1994-95.

■ The Terriers have used 12 different starting line-ups this season.

■ Drew Gibson scored a career-high 25 points at Chattanooga and needs 26 points to reach 1,000 in his career at Wofford.

Birmingham, Ala.-based Samford University will join the Southern Conference on July 1, 2008. The addition of the Bulldogs will bring league membership to 12 for all sports and nine for football. Coach Jimmy Tillette's team was 15-16 in 2006-07 with an RPI of 76. Samford currently competes in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Bulldogs are 13-14 (10-9 in the OVC) as of Feb. 25, 2008. The Bulldogs beat Louisiana Tech, 73-70, on Feb. 22 and play at Southeast Missouri State on Feb. 28.
