Playoff Notes

Wofford advanced to the quarterfinals of the FCS playoffs with a 17-3 win at The Citadel on Saturday. The Terriers will visit Youngstown State on December 10.

The Terriers have advanced to the national quarterfinals for the first time since 2012.

The last SoCon team to make the quarterfinals was Chattanooga in 2014.

The Citadel finished the season with a 10-2 record. The Bulldogs won the league's regular season championship and advanced to the playoffs for the second consecutive season.

Chattanooga dropped a 41-36 decision at Sam Houston State on Saturday. The Mocs were in the playoffs for the third consecutive year.

SoCon teams are 29-19 overall in the quarterfinals of the FCS playoffs.

Quick Hits

- The Southern Conference has the most wins (106) and highest winning percentage (.606) in the playoffs of all FCS leagues.
- Seven of the league's nine teams have appeared in the playoffs at least once.
- SoCon teams are 13-9 against opponents from the Missouri Valley Conference in the playoffs.
- SoCon teams are 12-3 against FCS non-conference opponents in 2016.

RANKINGS: The Citadel Bulldogs, Chattanooga Mocs, Samford Bulldogs and Wofford Terriers are ranked in both weekly FCS polls. The Citadel is ranked sixth in both polls, while Chattanooga is ranked ninth by the coaches and 11th in the STATS poll. Wofford is slotted 18th in the STATS poll and 19th by the coaches. Samford is ranked 23rd in the STATS poll and 24th in the coaches poll.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference has three players on the STATS Offensive Player of the Year Watch List, two on the Defensive Player of the Year Watch List and one on the Freshman of the Year Watch List.

- Offensive Player of the Year - Derrick Craine (Chattanooga), Karel Hamilton (Samford) and Devlin Hodges (Samford).
- Defensive Player of the Year - Keionta Davis (Chattanooga) and Dee Delaney (The Citadel).

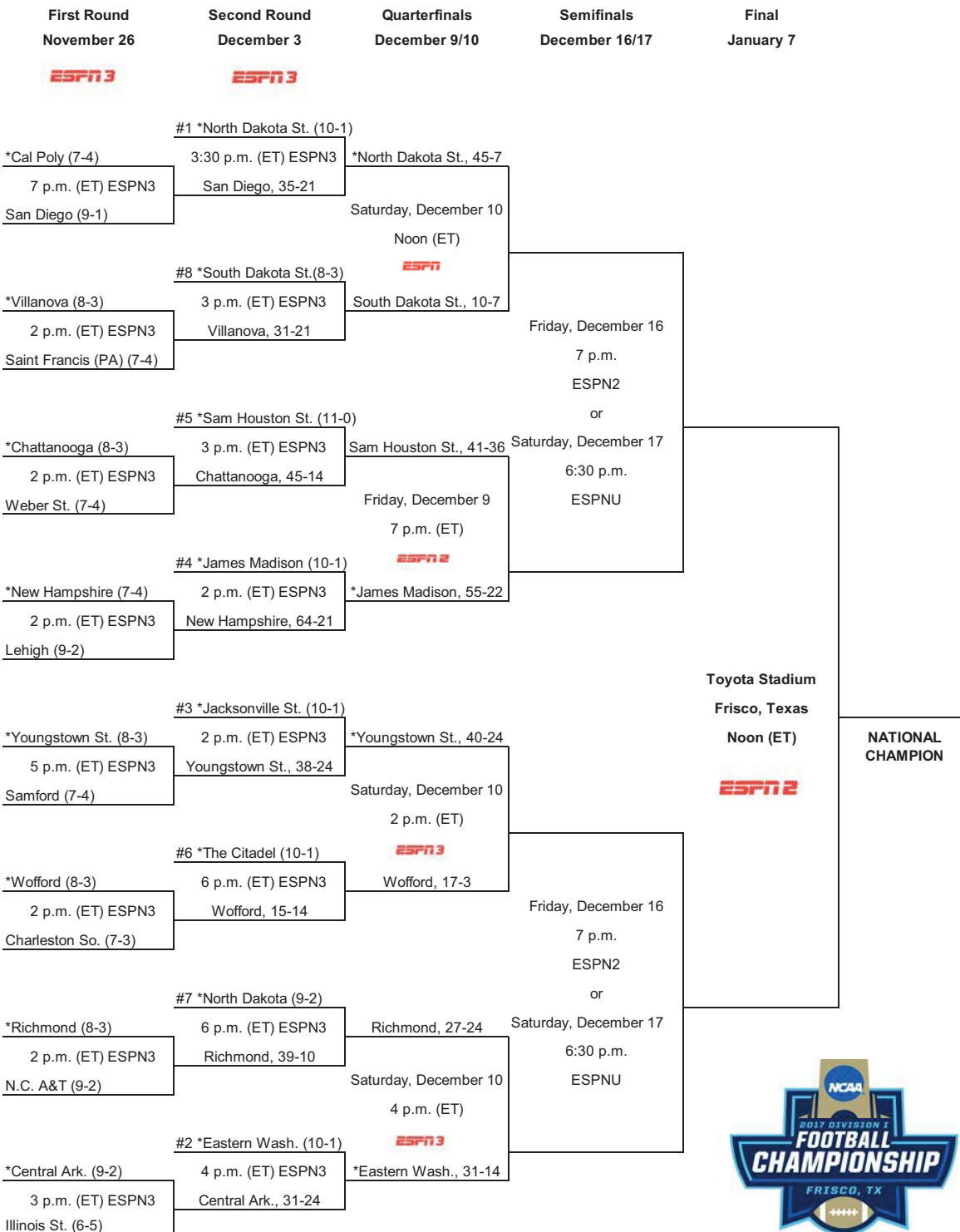

CONFERENCE CROWN: With a win over VMI on November 19, The Citadel finished the conference season with a perfect 8-0 record. It is the second year in a row the Bulldogs have earned a conference championship as The Citadel also won a share of the league title in 2015.

ONE POSSESSION GAMES: Sixteen of the league's 36 conference games this season were decided by one possession. Since the start of the 2013 season, 54 of 124 (.435) league games have been decided by one possession.

NONCONFERENCE GAMES: Southern Conference teams are 12-3 against FCS nonconference opponents in 2016.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF HOME: Southern Conference teams are 8-1 at home in nonconference games this season.

- SoCon teams are 84-22 (.789) at home in nonconference games since the start of the 2010 season.
- Home teams went 22-14 in conference play this year and are 71-54 since the start of 2013.

GROUND ATTACK: A Southern Conference team has ranked either first or second nationally in rushing in 13 of the last 14 seasons.

- The Citadel ranks second in the FCS in rushing this season with 348.2 yards per game.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Seven schools in the Southern Conference have reached the postseason at least once.
