## NOTES

• Bruno Andrade's goal against Presbyterian remains the only goal scored from a non-freshman this season. Freshman forward Hauk Andreas Fossen leads the team with four goals this year, with fellow freshman Kieran Richards close behind with two goals.

• VMI sophomore goalkeeper Broden Schull added to his league lead in saves, parrying 18 shots total with 11 coming in the narrow loss to Liberty. In total, Schull has 54 saves this season.

• Belmont head coach David Costa registered his first victory as a head coach on Saturday with a 2-0 shutout win over Presbyterian.

• All five Belmont goals this season have come from different players, with Pablo Martin Virgilio, Esteban Lestido, Niccolo Dagnoni, Liam O'Brien and Jordan Dozzi all finding the back of the net this season. The junior duo of Dozzi and Jack Shaw notched a pair of firsts in Saturday's 2-0 win over Presbyterian. Dozzi tallied his first-career goal at Belmont, with Shaw recording his first-career assist as a Bruin.

• Micah Albert and Faisal Almubaslat both scored two goals against UNC Asheville, the first time the Spartans have had two players collect a brace in a single match since 2016.

## MEN'S SOCCER PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – The Southern Conference named its men's soccer players of the week Tuesday for games played Sept. 17-23. ETSU forward Hauk Andreas Fossen and goalkeeper Josh Perryman were honored as the league's offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively.

ETSU was a perfect 2-0-0 last week, with wins over Presbyterian and High Point. The Bucs kicked off the week with a 3-0 defeat of the Blue Hose before taking down High Point 2-0 on Saturday.

Fossen, a freshman from Moely, Norway, netted a brace in the 2-0 win against High Point on Saturday. The two goals were his third and fourth of the season, which tied the school record for goals by a freshman. Fossen's first goal came in the fifth minute after a saved shot rebounded off the forward and into the net. He notched his second goal of the game in the 21st minute as he headed home a free kick from teammate Kieran Richards to seal the victory.

Perryman, a redshirt sophomore from Sheffield, England, did not allow a single goal in two wins last week. The ETSU netminder made two of his four saves in Tuesday's win over Presbyterian with an incredible double save following a penalty kick. His effort maintained a clean sheet and earned a spot on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays from the day. Perryman recorded four more saves in Saturday's shutout win over High Point.

The Bucs return to the pitch on Saturday, Sept. 28, as they host Georgia State at 7 p.m.
