Week 7 (Oct. 17, 2009)



**Welcome Back, Defense:** After the past two seasons in which SoCon offenses lit up the scoreboard, defense is making a comeback across the league in 2009. In conference games, scoring is down 12.5 points per game from a year ago and an astounding 28.8 points per game from 2007.

While scoring 30 points only resulted in a win 65 percent of the time in 2007, teams are a perfect 5-0 when scoring 30 or more points this season. In addition, after recording a 1-24 record (.040) in 2007-08 when scoring fewer than 20 points, SoCon teams are 3-6 (.333) this season when held under 20.

**Chattanooga Resurgent Under Huesman:** Chattanooga has experienced a quick turnaround under first-year head coach Russ Huesman. The Mocs, who were 3-20 overall and 2-13 in SoCon play over the past two seasons, have darted out to a 4-1 start, including a 2-1 mark in SoCon play.

The last time UTC was 4-1 overall and 2-1 in the league was 1997.

While Chattanooga's offense has improved from league lows in both total offense (224.9 ypg) and scoring offense (12.8 ppg) to fourth-place rankings in both this season (26.2 ppg, 341.8 ypg), UTC's defense can be credited with a large part of the team's early success.

The Mocs surrendered a SoCon-worst 37.9 points and 442.5 yards per contest in 2008. However, in 2009, UTC is third in the conference at 16.0 points per game allowed and 281.0 yards per game. The Mocs' defense currently ranks 16th in the nation in scoring defense and 22nd in total defense after ranking 112th and 111th, respectively, in the same categories in 2008.

**Hudgins, Roberts Rewriting Record Books:** Elon's Terrell Hudgins and The Citadel's Andre Roberts will likely end their careers as the top two receivers in Southern Conference history.

Hudgins holds the career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns, and he is now taking aim at the NCAA marks in each category. On Saturday, Oct. 3, Hudgins became the NCAA Division I (FCS and FBS) career leader in receptions, and he needs 262 more yards to top Hall of Famer Jerry Rice's career total of 4,693 yards.

Roberts is now in the top three in each category as well, ranking second in receptions, second in receiving touchdowns and third in receiving yards.

**Appalachian Builds SoCon Win Streak:** After starting with back-to-back wins to open SoCon play in 2009, Appalachian State currently boasts a 14-game conference win streak. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak of its kind in school history and is the seventh-longest win streak all-time in the Southern Conference. One more win would equal Georgia Southern (1997-99) for the longest SoCon win streak in the past 35 seasons.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

**Riddle Unmatched Among SoCon QBs:** Elon quarterback Scott Riddle is without equal among Southern Conference QBs as the junior now owns the career records for passing yards (8,487), completions (758) and touchdowns (68).

Just 26 games into his college career, Riddle passed former ETSU great Greg Ryan in both completions and yardage in the Sept. 26 28-14 win over Georgia Southern.

Riddle also set a new SoCon standard for pass attempts without an interception, tossing 218 straight passes without a pick prior to a second half interception against Georgia Southern.

**Edwards, LeGree Watched for National Awards:** After stellar seasons in 2008, football writers and fans across the nation have taken note of Appalachian State's Armanti Edwards and Mark LeGree. LeGree, a junior defensive back who led the nation and tied a SoCon single-season record with 10 INTs in 2008, was named one of 62 official candidates for the 2009 Bronko Nagurski Trophy, which honors college football's top defensive player. LeGree is the only NCAA Division I FCS representative on the Nagurski Trophy's preseason watch list.

Likewise, Edwards is the sole FCS nominee for both the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award and for the Manning Award. Both awards honor the top quarterback in collegiate football with the Unitas Award being limited to seniors.

**Edwards Vies For Payton Award Double in 2009:** Appalachian State quarterback Armanti Edwards was named as the recipient of the 2008 Walter Payton Award, which recognizes the top offensive player in FCS football. Edwards was the second straight SoCon QB to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. In total, five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award. A senior, Edwards is aiming to become the first player in the award's history to win it twice.

Elon's Terrell Hudgins, Samford's Chris Evans and The Citadel's Andre Roberts were also named the preseason watch list for the 2009 Walter Payton Award.

**Appalachian Joins SoCon Record Books:** Appalachian State completed a perfect 8-0 Southern Conference season in 2008, wrapping up its fourth consecutive league title. Appalachian State joins a short list of four-time champions, and if it wins the league crown again in 2009, Appalachian would become just the second-ever SoCon team to win five league titles in a row.

**SoCon Teams Set Winning Standard This Decade:** The Southern Conference boasts three of the top 10 winningest teams in FCS football (among playoff-qualifiers) this decade (2000-present). Appalachian State's 93 overall victories during that span trail only Montana (110) while Furman (80) and Georgia Southern (79) sit in the seventh and eighth spots, respectively.

**Rebuilding and Reloading:** SoCon teams return 65 percent of their starters from last season (148-of-228), up from just 57 percent returnees in 2008 ... the most experienced group are the specialists (73%) followed by defense (65%) and offense (63%) ... Elon has the most experienced group of returning starters for the second year in a row as 20-of-25 (80%) return from a Phoenix team which finished 8-4 overall and 6-2 in the SoCon last season ... Elon is the only league team to return 9 of its starters on offense while Appalachian State and The Citadel join the Phoenix with nine starting defenders back ... Wofford (46% starters returning) and Furman (52%) have the most holes to fill in the starting 25.

**SoCon Pair Among Nation's Rushing Elite:** Appalachian State senior quarterback Armanti Edwards and Samford junior running back Chris Evans are among the nation's elite when it comes to 100-yard rushing games. Through 2008, both rank in the FCS top 25 in active career 100-yard games; however, a deeper look at the rankings shows the each is tops nationally among his classmates. Edwards' 17 100-yard performances are equaled only by fellow seniors David McCarthy of Albany and Trevyn Smith of Weber State, and Evans' 11 games over the century mark are the most nationally among juniors.

**Experienced Coaches:** Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 274 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 181 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (96) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (59 victories) needs five victories to enter the top 10.

**SoCon Players Make NFL Impact:** 16 players with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Pro Bowl DB Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and three Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State and Chattanooga lead the way with three players each while Furman and Georgia Southern each have two ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Jason Hunter, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington were all in the starting lineup on week one.

**Facilities Improve Throughout the Conference:** Both Kidd Brewer Stadium at Appalachian State and Seibert Stadium at Samford will look different to visitors this season as each stadium received significant upgrades during the offseason.

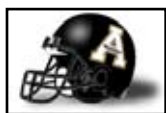
At ASU, a seven story, 120,000-square foot building behind the west stands at Kidd Brewer Stadium was officially opened this month. The facility is a part of ASU's \$50 million facilities enhancement campaign, which also included an indoor practice facility, baseball, softball and soccer stadiums. It provides office space in addition to locker rooms, club seating and a new press box.

Samford's home opener on Sept. 12 showcased the newly-constructed Cooney Family Field House, a \$7.5 million, 39,000 square-foot structure in the south end zone of Seibert Stadium.

Elsewhere around the league, Furman installed a new scoreboard with video replay capabilities and Wofford opened a new building adjacent to Gibbs Stadium that houses a new weight room and coaches offices.

## This Date in SoCon History

### Oct. 17, 1981

VMI scored a late touchdown to forge a 14-14 tie against Appalachian State in Boone.

In a defense struggle, Jack Teichmann's fourth quarter field goal lifted Chattanooga to a 3-2 win over Arkansas State in Jonesboro, Ark.

The Citadel held Davidson to just 9 yards rushing on 35 attempts in the Bulldogs' 23-3 victory in Charleston.

Furman rushed for 315 yards and Tim Sorrells threw a pair of touchdown passes in Furman's 30-14 non-conference win at James Madison.

### Oct. 17, 1987

Bjorn Nitto kicked three field goal from beyond 40 yards and No. 3 Appalachian State held Furman scoreless for three quarters in a 16-8 ASU win in Greenville.

Brad Patterson came off the bench to rally Chattanooga from an early 16-0 deficit with a pair of touchdown passes, leading the Mocs to a 22-19 Homecoming victory over The Citadel.

No. 12 Western Carolina overcame an 11-point first half deficit to improve to 4-2 on the season with a 55-34 win over North Carolina A&T.

### Oct. 17, 1992

D.J. Campbell passed for 274 yards and two touchdowns in Appalachian State's 27-12 win at VMI.

Before a record crowd of 23,025 at Johnson Hagood Stadium, No. 6 Marshall handed No. 5 The Citadel its first loss of the season, 34-13.

Western Carolina's defense forced five turnovers while quarterback Lonnie Galloway tossed three touchdown passes in a 44-13 win over Chattanooga – the Catamount's most lopsided SoCon victory in six seasons.

### Oct. 17, 1998

In a battle of unbeaten, No. 2 Georgia Southern opened up a 20-0 first half lead and held off No. 3 Appalachian State, 37-24, in Statesboro. Adrian Peterson and Greg Hill combined for 366 yards and three touchdowns on the ground.

Chattanooga's offense exploded for a season-high 528 yards in a 45-7 blowout of VMI.

Stanley Meyers was 18-for-19 through the air, including finishing the game with 17 straight completions, as he rallied The Citadel to a 25-24 victory at Furman after the Bulldogs trailed 21-0 in the second quarter.

Wofford accumulated 371 yards rushing and downed Western Carolina, 17-10, despite 203 yards on the ground from the Catamounts' Brad Hoover.
