Quick Hits

- Appalachian State, Elon, Furman and Chattanooga host conference games Saturday while The Citadel is idle.
- Home teams are 11-8 in league games this season after going just 18-18 a year ago.
- Southern Conference teams are 8-2 against FCS nonconference opponents.
- Steven Miller (APP), Jerodis Williams (FUR), Fabian Truss (SAM) and Eric Breitenstein (WOF) all rank in the NCAA FCS top 20 in all-purpose yardage.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference has two candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List, four on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List and three on the Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player. The Jerry Rice Award honors the top freshman in FCS.

- Payton Award Candidates - Eric Breitenstein (Wofford) and Aaron Mellette (Elon).

RANKINGS: Three Southern Conference teams are ranked in both major FCS Polls this week. Georgia Southern is ranked third by both the FCS Coaches and the Sports Network. Wofford is eighth according to the Sports Network and No. 9 in the coaches poll. Appalachian State is ranked No. 11 by the coaches and 13th according to the Sports Network.

THROUGH THE AIR: The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last six seasons.

• Elon's Aaron Mellette leads the league and ranks eighth nationally with 110 receiving yards per game.

ON THE GROUND: A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in eight of the last 11 years.

• The Citadel, Georgia Southern and Wofford all rank in the top five of FCS for rushing yards per game.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: All nine SoCon teams have led the league in total defense at least once since 2003.

• Georgia Southern leads the conference and ranks second nationally in total defense. The Eagles have given up 266 yards per game in 2012.

BROKEN RECORDS: The Southern Conference has produced record-setting performances in 2012, including the following SoCon records:

- Wofford vs. Lincoln (Pa.) - September 8
Wofford's 82 points was the second-highest scoring output in league history
- Wofford vs. Western Carolina - September 15
Wofford's 590 rushing yards was the seventh-highest single-game total in the SoCon
- Eric Breitenstein, Wofford - September 29
Rushed for a SoCon-record 321 yards and two TDs at Elon
- Jerodis Williams, Furman - September 29
Accounted for 370 all-purpose yards against Western Carolina, the second-highest total in league history
- Steven Miller, Appalachian State - September 29
Rushed for a 202 yards against Coastal Carolina, the 122nd time a SoCon player has topped 200 rushing yards
- Georgia Southern at Western Carolina - October 6
GSU's 614 rushing yards was the fourth-highest single-game total in the SoCon
- Georgia Southern vs. Wofford - October 13
The Eagles set an NCAA FCS record by not attempting a pass the entire game

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 958, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Ten Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's indoor track & field, men's outdoor track & field, women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field, women's tennis and volleyball) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (66 percent) for FCS programs.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 333 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 212 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (121) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.

CAREER MILESTONES: Wofford running back Eric Breitenstein has scored 55 career touchdowns, which is the sixth-highest total in league history. He has scored 330 career points and is ranked ninth on the conference's all-time scoring list.

- Georgia Southern's Adrian Peterson (1998-01) holds the league's all-time record for career touchdowns (87) and points (524).
- Elon's Aaron Mellette ranks fourth in the Southern Conference record book for career receiving yards (3,516). Elon's Terrell Hudgins (2006-09) owns the league's all-time mark with 5,250 receiving yards, an NCAA record.
- Georgia Southern's Brent Russell leads all active SoCon players with 23.5 career sacks. He is just 1.5 sacks shy of breaking into the league's top ten career sacks list. Appalachian State's Josh Jeffries (1999-2002) owns the league mark with 36.5 quarterback sacks.
 - Chattanooga's Josh Williams has 22.5 career sacks.
