QUICK HITS

Appalachian State vaulted itself into sole possession of first place with its 70-24 win over Wofford Friday on ESPN2 ... ASU's final three SoCon opponents boast a combined 6-11 league record ... Georgia Southern played its fourth overtime game this season Saturday at The Citadel ... The last five SoCon games to go into overtime have all involved the Eagles ... ASU's Mark LeGree collected three interceptions against Wofford, becoming the first SoCon player to pick off three passes in the same game since Josh Cooper of Furman grabbed three against The Citadel in 2000 ... LeGree's seven picks on the season currently leads all of FCS ... Western Carolina snapped its 20-game conference losing streak with its 27-7 win over Chattanooga on Saturday ... The distinction for the longest losing streak in league history remains with VMI, which lost 32 straight SoCon games from 1996-2000.

SOCON PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Offensive

Armanti Edwards, Appalachian State Jr., 6-0, 175, QB

Edwards became the SoCon's all-time leader in total offense with 440 total yards and six total touchdowns in ASU's 70-24 win over No. 3 Wofford. The junior signal-caller passed for 367 yards and a career-best five touchdowns while also adding 73 yards and a score on the ground.

Defensive

Mark LeGree, Appalachian State So., 6-0, 185, DB

LeGree tied a school record with three interceptions and added a forced fumble and eight tackles (including one for loss) to lead the Mountaineers defensively.

Freshman

Brian Quick, Appalachian State R-Fr., 6-5, 200, WR

Quick set an ASU freshman record with 172 receiving yards and hauled in three touchdowns. Quick's 172 yards came on just four catches (43 ypr), including touchdowns of 58, 50 and 31 yards.

Special Teams

Blake Cain, Western Carolina Fr., 6-0, 190, P

Cain punted seven times for an average of 40.7 yards, which included a 51-yard boot that was three yards shy of his career-long, with five-of-seven landing inside the 20.

Edwards Becomes SoCon's Career Total Offense Leader: With 440 yards of total offense Friday (Oct. 31) against Wofford, ASU's Armanti Edwards became the SoCon's all-time leader in total offense, surpassing the mark of former Mountaineer quarterback Richie Williams (9,370, 2002-05). Edwards now boasts 9,397 total yards in 35 games (268.5

Hudgins Rewriting Record Books: Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With his 13-catch, 199-yard, 1-touchdown effort at Georgia Southern on Sept. 20, Hudgins became the league's all-time leader in receptions and receiving touchdowns. Hudgins also now sits in second place on the SoCon's career receiving yards list, 96 yards out of first place.

Moore's 174 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (56 victories) needs eight victories to enter the top 10.

SoCon Players Make NFL Impact: 23 players (21 on active roster, 2 on practice squads) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington were all in the starting lineup during week one.

SoCon Well-Represented on Payton/Buchanan Watch Lists: Three Southern Conference players were named to the Payton Award watch list while SoCon preseason defensive player of the year Pierre Banks from Appalachian State was chosen for the Buck Buchanan Award watch list ... ASU QB Armanti Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

SoCon to Begin League Hall of Fame: The Southern Conference will induct its first-ever hall of fame class in the spring of 2009 with a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C. ... the 88-year old league is the fifth-oldest Division I conference in the country and has seen such stars as Arnold Palmer (Wake Forest), Jerry West (West Virginia), Terrell Owens (Chattanooga) and "Hot Rod" Hundley (West Virginia) play in the league in addition to legendary coaches such as Adolph Rupp (Kentucky), Everett Case (North Carolina State), Wallace Wade (Alabama, Duke), Bear Bryant (Kentucky), General Robert Neyland (Tennessee) and Lefty Dreisell (Davidson).

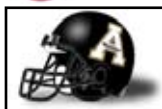

Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)

Southern Conference Tiebreaker Procedure

NCAA Automatic Bid: The Conference champion shall be awarded an automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs, provided it is eligible to compete in the post-season under NCAA guidelines. In the event that co-champions are declared, the automatic bid will be awarded as follows:

- A. In the case of a two-way tie, the automatic bid will be awarded to the winner of the game between the tied teams during the regular season;

 1. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss records of the tied teams against each other is first considered (i.e., head to head concept).
 2. If the teams are still tied, then each team's record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered.
 3. If the tie is still not broken, the teams' won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken.
 4. If the tie is still not broken, the team with the fewest points allowed among the tied teams shall be considered.
 5. If this does not resolve the tie, then the automatic bid will be determined by a random draw conducted by the Commissioner;
- C. In the event of multiple ties after a three-way tie, the same procedure as used to break a three-way tie will be applied until the tie is broken.
