Quick Hits

- All nine league teams are in action Saturday, September 10.
- Furman and The Citadel meet for the 91st time in the league's only conference game this weekend. The Paladins and Bulldogs first met on the gridiron in 1913.
- Six SoCon teams host non-conference games.
- Chattanooga hosts #10 Jacksonville State in a matchup of two top-25 teams.
- Wofford visits Clemson in the league's only matchup against an FBS opponent.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference boasts three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List and four on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS.

- Buchanan Award Candidates - Kadarron Anderson (Furman), Ameet Pall (Wofford), Brent Russell (Georgia Southern) and Ryan Steed (Furman).

RANKINGS: Four Southern Conference teams are ranked this week in both major FCS Polls. Georgia Southern is ranked No. 2 in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll, while Appalachian State is tabbed third. Wofford is ranked ninth by the coaches and seventh by TSN. The Chattanooga Mocs are ranked 25 by the FCS Coaches and No. 23 in the Sports Network Poll.

- The Citadel received votes in both polls while Elon and Furman were among the teams receiving votes in the Sports Network Poll.

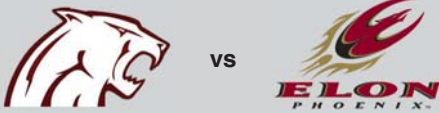

PLAYOFF POWER: Georgia Southern reached the semifinals of the FCS Playoffs in 2010 for the first time since 2002 when the Eagles fell to Western Kentucky 31-28, in Statesboro, Ga. The Southern Conference has had at least one team reach the semifinals 11 times in the last 13 years.

- The SoCon placed three teams in the quarterfinals last year. The league also had three teams in the quarterfinals in 2001, 1995 and 1996.

THREE FOR TEN: Three teams finished the 2010 season with 10 wins. Appalachian State and Wofford concluded the year at 10-3, while Georgia Southern was 10-5. It was the first time in history that the Southern Conference had three league teams win at least ten games in the same season.

- The SoCon has had two teams win at least 10 games on 12 different occasions (1983, 1987, 1988, 1992, 1993, 1995, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2010).

FAMILIAR FACES: Georgia Southern returns a league-high 23 starters for the 2011 season. The Eagles boast all 11 returning starters on offense. Western Carolina and Samford's defense return the fewest amount of starters (4) of any unit in the league.

- The league's nine teams combined to return 68 percent of their starters (153 of 225) from 2010.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 954, ten points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (64 percent) for FCS programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

POLL POSITION: The Southern Conference placed three teams in the final top 25 poll in 2010. Appalachian State (4th), Georgia Southern (5th) and Wofford (6th) were all ranked in the top ten of both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network rankings.

- The last time the league placed three teams in the season-ending polls was in 2005. ASU was slotted first after winning the FCS National Championship, while Furman (3rd) and Georgia Southern (9th) were also ranked in the top ten.

CAUGHT IN THE DRAFT: The Southern Conference had five players taken in the 2011 NFL Draft in April. The five draftees were the most taken in the draft since 1992 when five SoCon student-athletes were also selected.

- Defensive Back Cortez Allen of The Citadel was the first SoCon player taken off the board when he was chosen 128th overall (4th round) by the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- Chattanooga's Buster Skrine (DB) was selected in the fifth round (#137 overall) by the Cleveland Browns.
- Appalachian State had a trio of players taken. Defensive Back Mark LeGree was selected in the fifth round by Seattle (#156) while offensive lineman Daniel Kilgore was taken with pick #163 by San Francisco. Linebacker D.J. Smith was chosen by the Green Bay Packers in the sixth round (#186).

SoCon Sports Network: This summer the conference office announced a three-year partnership with Public Television to carry Southern Conference football games. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon football games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry Southern Conference football games. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced this fall for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3.com, the Southern Conference website, as well as the respective public television websites.
