## CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW

### 2023 OUTDOOR TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS KICK OFF MONDAY

The Southern Conference Men's and Women's Outdoor Track and Field Championships will take place at Western Carolina's Catamount Athletic Complex in Cullowhee, North Carolina, on Monday and Tuesday. This year marks the 98th championship for the men and 36th for the women.

Monday's schedule gets under way with the start of the decathlon at 12 p.m., followed by the start of the pentathlon at 12:15. The women's hammer throw final gets the field events started at 12:30 p.m., with the first track event, the preliminaries of the women's 1,500-meter run, slated to begin at 4 p.m. In all, 12 champions will be crowned on the first day of competition – four on the track and eight in field events.

Tuesday's schedule opens with resumption of the decathlon at 12 p.m., with the heptathlon resuming at 12:15. Field events begin with the women's shot put and men's discus finals at 2:15 p.m. and the women's 4x100-meter relay gets the track events started at 4 p.m. The day concludes with the women's and men's 4x400-meter relays at 7:25 and 7:35, respectively, followed by the awards ceremony. Thirty events will crown champions on the final day of the meet.

Samford is the defending champion on both the men's and women's sides. The Bulldog men claimed their fourth title overall and second straight last year, turning a 50-point day-one lead into a 77-point win over runner-up Western Carolina. Samford's women claimed their third straight title and fifth overall last season, jumping out to a 52-point day-one lead and expanding that to an 86-point margin of victory over runner-up ETSU.

Samford, which swept the men's and women's titles at the SoCon Indoor Track and Field Championships for the fourth season in a row, holds healthy leads in this season's outdoor power rankings, determined by the top eight times or scores that are reported by the schools for each event that will be conducted at this week's championships.

The Bulldog men have totaled 234 points in the power rankings, scoring in 20 of 21 events, including 28 points in the pole vault, to easily outdistance second-place Western Carolina (126.5 points). VMI is third in the power rankings with 120.5 points.

Samford's women have totaled 211.5 points in the power rankings, scoring in 19 of 21 events, highlighted by 23.5 points in the high jump. Wofford is second in the power rankings with 156 points, with ETSU in third with 111.

#### Storylines:

- The event returns to Cullowhee for the seventh time. Previous championships hosted by Western Carolina occurred in 2005, 2008, 2012, 2016, 2018 and 2021.

- Samford's women are seeking to become the first team to win four straight titles since App State won five straight from 2002-06.

- Aside from Samford's Rod Tiffin, who was the men's and women's SoCon Coach of the Year last year, just two of the individual superlative winners from 2022 are back in the field this season. Samford thrower Hannah Daffin is the reigning Most Outstanding Field Performer, while Furman's Madelynne Cadeau was the 2022 Freshman of the Year.

- The 2022 winners of eight of the 19 men's individual events are back in the field this season. Samford has a pair of defending champions in Ty Kimberlin, who has won the last two decathlon titles and last year's long jump title, and Jed Sisco, who has claimed the last two pole vault crowns. Kimberlin's 6,769 points in the decathlon last season were the second-most ever scored in the event at the SoCon championship meet.

- Western Carolina also has a pair of defending individual champs in Michael Harris and Javon Brown. Harris won the 200-meter run, while Brown took the triple jump. Harris was also on WCU's winning 4x100-meter relay, as was David Miles, who returns this season.

- The Citadel graduate student Solomon Ghosh is the defending champion in the discus throw, an event he won competing for VMI last year. Ghosh leads the SoCon in the event this season by more than eight meters. Bulldog teammate Stephen Kraeling is the defending champion in the high jump.

- UNCG's Dylan Christopher is the defending champion in the 10,000-meter run. In 2022, he won the Spartans' first outdoor SoCon title since Paul Chelimo, who would go on to become a two-time Olympic medalist, won the 1,500-meter run at the 2012 SoCon meet.

- Furman's Cameron Ponder, who did not compete in the 2022 SoCon Championships, is the meet record-holder in the 3,000-meter steeplechase, with his time of 8:49.66 from 2021.

- The winners of seven of the 19 individual event winners from 2022 are entered in this year's meet. Samford's Daffin is the defending champion in a pair of events, the hammer throw and the shot put. The Bulldogs' Erin Long is the two-time defending champion in the javelin, an event in which she set a meet record last year with a throw of 51.02 meters. Her sister, Emorie Long, is the 2019 champion and is also back in the field. Samford's Brittany Bishop, the defending champion in the pole vault, cleared a meet-record 4.01 meters last year.

- Furman boasts a pair of returning champions, as Emily Little claimed the Paladins' third straight title in the 10,000-meter run last year and Nicole Matysik won the 3,000-meter steeplechase.

- Wofford's Kerrington Johnson is the two-time defending champion in the 100-meter hurdles and was the 2021 champion in the 400-meter hurdles.
