### Two-Minute Drill

- The Southern Conference has three teams ranked in the ESPN/USA Today Top 25 poll this week. Furman is ranked 10th with Georgia Southern at 14 and Western Carolina breaking into the poll at #21. Wofford, Appalachian State and Chattanooga also received votes.

- The Sports Network Top 25 has two SoCon teams listed with Furman at #10 and Georgia Southern ranked 14th. Wofford, Appalachian State and Chattanooga also received votes.

- Five teams will play non-conference games this week, including two against I-A opponents. Western Carolina will take on Cincinnati with Chattanooga traveling to Memphis. Furman hosts Samford, Coastal Carolina visits Appalachian State and Elon hosts Presbyterian in the other non-conference match-ups.

- Two of the top 10 rushing leaders in the country are from the SoCon: Jermaine Austin leads the country averaging 164 yards per game, followed by teammate Jayson Foster in ninth with 125 yards.

- Georgia Southern travels to Wofford this weekend for a 7:00 kick-off on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast. Randy Smith will be calling the plays with Walt Nadzak doing color commentary.

# Around the SoCon This Week

## Appalachian State (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

Appalachian State opens the home portion of its schedule, hosting Coastal Carolina Saturday ... QB **Richie Williams** connected on 72 percent of his passes (18-of-25) in a loss to Kansas ... Williams has averaged nearly 200 yards over his first two games (196.5) and is 308 yards from moving into sole possession of third place on the school's career passing chart ... Freshman **T.J. Courman** caught three passes for a team-high 58 yards, including a 44-yard reception from Williams on his first collegiate play.

## The Citadel (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Bulldogs are idle this week after dropping a 62-10 decision to No. 11 Florida State ... The Citadel played in front of 79,152 fans at FSU, the third largest crowd to watch the school play...CB **Vince Hill** registered his first career interception and also returned a fumble 70 yards for the team's lone touchdown...Offensively, the team mustered only 91 yards of offense and five first downs...The Citadel returns to action on Sept. 24 when it hosts Appalachian State in the team's conference opener.

## Chattanooga (2-0, 0-0 SoCon)

Chattanooga improved to 2-0 on the season with a 21-18 win at No. 21 Jacksonville State...It was the SoCon's second victory over JSU this season...The Mocs are 2-0 for the first time since 1997 and are attempting to win their first three games since 1991...Quarterback **Antonio Miller** completed 78 percent of his passes Saturday (21-for-27), setting career highs for completions, attempts and yards (218). Miller's two-yard touchdown run with 10 seconds to play, his first of the season, was the game-winner...Receiver **Emanuel Hassell** set career highs with 12 catches for 141 yards, the fourth 100-yard game of his career...He also totaled 82 yards on kickoff returns...Defensively, **Larry White** set a career high with 14 total tackles, 12 of them solo...It was White's third double digit tackle output in his career.

## Elon (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Phoenix rebounded from a 17-10 loss to Coastal Carolina by defeating Savannah State on the road, 48-14...Sophomore QB **Kye Hamilton** passed for a career-high 293 yards in the win, connecting on 69 percent of his passes...WR **Michael Mayers** was the recipient of 139 of those yards, a career high...RB **Reggie Hall** scored a pair of TDs in the win, including a 53 yard carry...Hall, who also caught three passes for 26 yards, rushed for a game-high 73 yards...Hall is fifth in the league in rushing yards per game (73.5). Elon plays the first of three straight home games on Saturday, entertaining Presbyterian in its homecoming game. It wraps up non-conference play on Sept. 24 against North Carolina A&T.

## Furman (1-1, 0-1 SoCon)

The Paladins dropped their first conference opener since 1994 — and only the second setback in conference openers in the last 18 seasons — on Saturday with a 41-21 setback to Western Carolina, snapping a seven-game win streak in the series...The last time Furman lost in a conference opener was also to WCU, 35-24...QB **John Rust** caught a school tight end record nine catches for 109 yards...QB **Ingle Martin** passed for 249 yards and two TDs but was intercepted five times...Martin pushed his career passing total to 3,241 yards, moving him into ninth place in school history...After two games on the road to start the season, Furman hosts Samford in its home opener...The Paladins are 22-2 in home openers at Paladin Stadium and have won their last five openers.

## Georgia Southern (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

Senior **Jermaine Austin** picked up his 25th career 100-yard game on Saturday in a loss to McNeese State, finishing with a game-high 129 yards...Austin, who surpassed 4,000 career rushing yards in the season opener at Northeastern, moved into sixth place on the Southern Conference's career rushing list with 4,193...Austin also leads I-AA with an average of 164 yards per game...The Eagles drew 20,607 fans to their season-opener, the ninth-largest attended game at Paulson Stadium. Georgia Southern also set a student-attendance record of 11,816...The Eagles loss to McNeese State snapped an eight-game streak of home-opening victories...It is also GSU's first non-conference regular season loss at home since 1997 (William & Mary, 29-28)...In addition, it is also only the third time since the Georgia Southern moved to the I-AA level in 1984 that the team has lost two home games in a row (1994 and 1996).

## Western Carolina (2-0, 1-0 SoCon)

The Catamounts opened league play with a 41-21 win at home over second-ranked Furman...With the win, Western Carolina moved into The Sports Network Top-25 poll at No. 22...WCU moved to 2-0 on the year for the second straight season and for only the fourth time in the past 20 years...Western Carolina picked off five Furman passes by five different players, one shy of the school record...In two games, the Catamounts have recorded a national-leading nine interceptions...Junior RB **Darius Fudge** rushed for 133 yards in the win over the Paladins, one yard shy of matching his career best...It was Fudge's second career 100-yard game.

## Wofford (1-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Terriers dropped out of the TSN Top-25 poll for the first time in 38 weeks, a streak that started Oct. 21, 2002, after a 35-7 decision to West Virginia...It was the team's first game against an opponent from the Big East and the ninth I-A foe in the past seven seasons...Wofford was held to 154 yards of total offense...Freshman punter **Chris Tommie** averaged 44.3 yards on six punts, including four of 50 yards or better...Wofford hosts Georgia Southern in the conference opener for both teams...It marks the fourth straight season that the two have started conference action against one another.

## Players of the Week

**Darius Fudge, Western Carolina  
Jr., 6-0, 200lb.  
Riverdale, GA**

A 6-0, 200-lb junior from Riverdale, GA, Fudge led the Catamounts to a 41-21 win over second-ranked Furman on Saturday. The tailback averaged 10.2 yards per carry, tallying 133 yards on 13 attempts, and added a touchdown. It was his second career 100-yard game, with his first coming in the win over Appalachian State last season. Fudge accounted for all but 56 rushing yards for the Catamounts. With WCU facing a fourth-and-two situation, Fudge took a fake punt and rushed for 38 yards to set up a Catamount touchdown two plays later.

Other top offensive performances from September 10 include Appalachian State running back Kevin Richardson (113 total yards, six receptions, 67 rushing yards), Chattanooga quarterback Antonio Miller (21-of-27, 218 yards, 1 TD), Elon's Kye Hamilton (19-of-28, 293 yards) and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin (129 yards, 1 TD, 6.4 yards per carry).

**Larry White, Chattanooga  
So., 6-0, 215lb  
Atlanta, GA**

White, a 6-0, 215-lb sophomore from Atlanta, GA, led Chattanooga with a career-high 14 tackles, 12 solo tackles, in a 21-18 win over No. 21 Jacksonville State on Saturday. He anchored the defense that held JSU on a fourth-and-one play in Chattanooga territory with 2:51 to play, giving the Mocs the ball on the game-winning possession. White missed the 2004 season after playing as a true freshman in 2003.

Other top defensive performances include Appalachian State defensive back Jeremy Wiggins (15 tackles, nine solo), The Citadel's cornerback Vince Hill (one interception, one fumble recovery), Georgia Southern linebacker John Mohring (11 tackles, eight solo) and Western Carolina defensive end Rico Reese (five tackles, one interception, one sack).

Greenwood, SC**

A 6-0, 175-lb punter from Greenwood, SC, Tommie led the freshmen core this past weekend. Tommie punted six times, averaging 44.3 yards per punt against West Virginia. He had four punts of 50 yards or more, including punts of 50, 52, 56 and 60 yards. Tommie is averaging 40.7 yards per punt this season.

**Presbyterian (3-0) at Elon (1-1)**

**2:00**

**Rhodes Stadium (11,250)**

**Elon, NC**

**THE GAME:** This will be the first meeting between the two schools since 1998 and only the third time the institutions have met since Elon join the NCAA I-AA ranks ... Elon has picked up wins in both of the teams meetings, winning 24-3 in 1997 and 33-32 in 1998 ... Overall, Elon holds a slight series edge, 20-18-2.

**THE COACHES:** Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) begins 2005 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix ... The 18th coach in Elon's history, Hamilton came to the program from East Tennessee State program where he was 38-41 in seven seasons ... Hamilton was 3-8 last year at Elon to move his all-time coaching record to 42-50 in eight seasons ... Tommy Spangler (Georgia '83) is entering his fifth year at the helm of the Blue Hose where he has picked up an overall record of 28-18 in his four years with the program.

**Coastal Carolina (2-0) at Appalachian State (1-1)**

**3:30**

**Kidd Brewer Stadium (16,650)**

**Boone, NC**

**THE GAME:** This will be the first meeting between the two institutions ... Coastal Carolina is entering just its third season of football in 2005 after a 2005 campaign that saw them claim the Big South football championship in their second year...The Chanticleers are coming off a 31-27 win over top-ranked James Madison last Saturday...Appalachian State fell to I-A opponent Kansas 36-8.

**THE COACHES:** The winningest coach in Southern Conference football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) enters his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005 ... Moore has a 129-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16 seasons... David Bennett (Presbyterian '84) enters his third season as head coach of the Chanticleers as the program's only coach in its short history ... Bennett's team finished last year as Big South Champions with a 10-1 record ... In his two years as coach of Coastal Carolina, the Chanticleers have compiled an 18-6 record ... Overall, in nine years as a head coach, Bennett is 81-23.

**Samford (1-1) at Furman (1-1)**

**7:00**

**Paladin Stadium (16,000)**

**Greenville, SC**

**THE GAME:** This will mark the second year in a row that Samford and Furman have hit the gridiron against one another ... The Paladins won last years game, 45-10, in Birmingham ... The Bulldogs hold a 5-4 advantage against the Paladins all-time ... Furman does carry a three-game winning streak against the Bulldogs...Furman is looking to bounce back after a 41-21 loss to Western Carolina last weekend...Samford is coming off a 48-14 loss to Baylor.

**THE COACHES:** Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) enters his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005 ... Lamb has compiled a 25-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program ... Lamb also led the Paladins as a player as their quarterback from 1982-85 ... Bill Gray (Mississippi College '83) is entering his fourth season as Bulldogs coach, owning a squared overall record of 20-20.

**Georgia Southern (1-1) at Wofford (1-1)**

**7:00**

**Gibbs Stadium (13,000)**

**Spartanburg, SC**

**TV: CSS - Talent: Randy Smith, Walt Nadzak**

**THE GAME:** The tangle between Wofford and Georgia Southern will be the first conference game of the year for the schools ... Georgia Southern owns a 7-3 record all-time against the Terriers, but have fallen victim to Wofford in two of the last three years ... Last year the Eagles came out on top, 58-14 in Statesboro...Both teams will try and rebound from losses last week, with GSU falling to McNeese State 23-20 and Wofford dropping a 35-7 decision to I-A opponent West Virginia.

**THE COACHES:** Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is in his fourth year as head coach ... Sewak is 28-11 as a head coach, but since he joined the program in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 90-21 record and two national championships: 1999 and 2000 ... Sewak's ground attack at Georgia Southern has been prolific, with the Eagles ending each of the last three seasons leading the nation in ground yardage ... Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) enters his 18th season at Wofford in 2005 ... Ayers is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 111-81-1 in his 17 years at the helm ... The three-time Southern Conference Coach of the Year (2000, 2002 and 2003) led the Wofford football team to its first ever SoCon football crown in 2003 ... The title was the only SoCon title of any sort that Wofford has picked up in its eight years in the conference.

**Western Carolina (2-0) at Cincinnati (1-1)**

**7:00**

**Nippert Stadium, (35,000)**

**Cincinnati, OH**

**THE GAME:** This will be the first time that the two schools have ever tangled on the gridiron ... Western Carolina is coming off a 41-21 upset win over #2 Furman, which put the Catamounts in the Sports Network top 25 this week...Cincinnati is looking to recover from a 42-24 loss to Penn State.

**THE COACHES:** Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is entering his fourth season as coach of his alma mater ... Briggs has tabulated a 16-20 record in his three seasons at the helm of the Cats ... Mark Dantonio (South Carolina '79) is in his second season at the helm of the Bearcats program with an 8-6 overall record ... ## This Date in Southern Conference History

**Sept. 17, 1977:** Furman's Mark Stowers rushed for 149 yards and a touchdown on only nine carries in the Paladins' 42-12 win over East Tennessee in their home opener.

**Sept. 17, 1977:** UTC freshman running back Gwain Durden scored on a one-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter to give the Mocs a 14-7 win over Appalachian State.

**Sept. 17, 1983:** Appalachian State's Randy Joyce passed for 200 yards and a touchdown in the Mountaineers 31-0 win over VMI in Boone, N.C. The shutout was the first of the year for Appalachian State.

**Sept. 17, 1994:** Harold Hines scored on a 15-yard run with 38 ticks remaining on the game clock to give Western Carolina a dramatic 42-38 win over The Citadel. The Bulldogs had taken a 38-35 lead with a little under a minute left on the game clock, but on the ensuing kickoff, Craig Aiken returned the ball 69 yard yards to the Bulldogs' 15 to set up the eventual game-winner for the Catamounts, who had not triumphed in Charleston, S.C. for 11 years.

**Sept. 17, 1977:** The Citadel scored for the first time in 1977 in a quarter besides the second in its Southern Conference opening win over Western Carolina, shutting out the Catamounts, 20-0. Paul Tanquay booted two field goals in the win – a 42-yarder and a 43-yarder.

**Sept. 17, 1983:** The game is known in the annuals of Western Carolina football history as the "Immaculate Reception II" contest. Down 16-6 to ETSU with 4:31 left to play, the Catamounts drove 91 yards, scoring on a 37-yard pass from Willie Perkins to Eric Rasheed. The ball was tipped twice by an ETSU defender before Rasheed grabbed it, thus "Immaculate Reception II" was formulated. The Cats cut the game to two at 16-14 after a two-point conversion to put them in striking distance for the win with little time. Everything worked to plan though for the Catamounts at the end, as their on-side kick attempt was recovered and Dean Biassucci kicked a 43-yard field goal six plays later with 32 ticks remaining to give Western Carolina a game-for-the-ages win of 17-16

**Sept. 17, 1994:** Buddy Green picked up his first win ever and UTC rushed for 297 yards in the Mocs' 47-23 win over Gardner-Webb. Stan Sullivan led the ground attack, picking up 96 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries.

**Sept. 17, 1994:** Appalachian State used 467 yards of total offense to shutout North Carolina A&T 45-0 and pick up their first win of 1994.
