QUICK HITS

Elon is 3-0 for the first time since joining the SoCon (2003) after defeating No. 17 Furman 31-10 on Saturday ... Five SoCon teams are ranked in the top 25 of the FCS Coaches Poll this week, led by Appalachian State in second and Wofford in ninth ... In the Sports Network poll, five are in the top 25 and three in the top 10 ... 16 teams are included in the FCS playoffs following the regular season ... When Samford hosts Appalachian State Saturday, it will mark the first Southern Conference game played in the state of Alabama since Dec. 3, 1932 when Auburn played South Carolina to a 20-20 tie in Birmingham ... Samford earned the first SoCon win in program history Saturday with a 21-6 win at Western Carolina.

SOCON PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Offensive

Armanti Edwards, Appalachian State Jr., 6-0, 175, QB

Edwards rolled up 305 yards of total offense and accounted for six of the Mountaineers' seven touchdowns. The junior rushed for 80 yards and two touchdowns while also passing for 225 yards and four scores.

Defensive

Cortez Gilbert, Appalachian State Jr., 5-11, 175, DB

Gilbert registered a game-high 11 tackles and broke up two passes while helping hold The Citadel's high-powered offense to 14 points and 170 yards below its season averages.

Freshman

Dustin Taliaferro, Samford Fr., 6-3, 215, QB

Taliaferro was 14-for-16 for 154 yards and two touchdowns through the air, including scoring tosses of 22 and 38 yards that put the game away in the third quarter. He also compiled a 209.6 efficiency rating.

Special Teams

Bob Hooper, Samford So., 5-9, 209, P

Hooper punted six times for an average of 44.3 yards per kick in Saturday's win at Western Carolina. The sophomore had a long of 54 yards, and he placed five of his six punts inside the WCU 20-yard line.

Hudgins Rewriting Record Books: Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With his 13-catch, 199-yard, 1-touchdown effort at Georgia Southern on Sept. 20, Hudgins became the league's all-time leader in receptions and receiving touchdowns. Just six games into his junior season, Hudgins also now sits in second place on the SoCon's career receiving yards list, 449 yards out of first place.

Experienced Coaches: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 259 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 170 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (53 victories) needs 11 victories to enter the top 10.

SoCon Players Make NFL Impact: 23 players (21 on active roster, 2 on practice squads) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State leads the way with five players while Chattanooga has three ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington were all in the starting lineup during week one.

SoCon Well-Represented on Payton/Buchanan Watch Lists: Three Southern Conference players were named to the Payton Award watch list while SoCon preseason defensive player of the year Pierre Banks from Appalachian State was chosen for the Buck Buchanan Award watch list ... ASU QB Armanti Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

Non-Conference Schedule Notes: The nine SoCon schools have 32 non-conference games on the schedule this season ... 10 games are against FBS opponents, including five against the SEC and four versus the ACC ... Chattanooga ventures into Big 12 territory to face preseason No. 4 Oklahoma ... among the 17 FCS non-conference games, seven come against the Big South and four are against CAA opponents ... SoCon teams will face six non-Division I teams in 2008 ... the most common SoCon opponent is Presbyterian, which will battle four SoCon teams (Appalachian State, Elon, Western Carolina and Wofford) ... the last team to face at least four SoCon opponents in the same season was Coastal Carolina, which went 2-3 against league teams in 2006 ... two-time opponents include Florida State (WCU, Chattanooga) and Liberty (Elon, WCU).

SoCon to Begin League Hall of Fame: The Southern Conference will induct its first-ever hall of fame class in the spring of 2009 with a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C. ... the 88-year old league is the fifth-oldest Division I conference in the country and has seen such stars as Arnold Palmer (Wake Forest), Jerry West (West Virginia), Terrell Owens (Chattanooga) and "Hot Rod" Hundley (West Virginia) play in the league in addition to legendary coaches such as Adolph Rupp (Kentucky), Everett Case (North Carolina State), Wallace Wade (Alabama, Duke), Bear Bryant (Kentucky), General Robert Neyland (Tennessee) and Lefty Dreisell (Davidson).

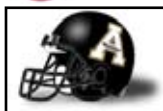

This Date in SoCon History

Oct. 11, 2003: With the help of two Shaun Bennett punt blocks, Wofford defeated Elon 45-7. The Terrier defense held the Phoenix to just 174 total yards of offense.

Oct. 11, 2003: Backup quarterback Trey Hunter accounted for 312 yards of total offense and scored four touchdowns as Georgia Southern defeated Western Carolina 31-25. The Eagles had 204 yards in the final quarter to seal the game.

Oct. 11, 2003: K.T. Stovall recorded three sacks and a fumble recovery to key Appalachian State's defense in a hard-fought 13-10 win at Furman - the Mountaineers first in Paladin Stadium since 1995.

Oct. 11, 1997: Freddie Patrick scored two second-half touchdowns and Chattanooga recovered a late VMI fumble to halt a potential scoring drive and lead the Mocs to a 27-24 victory in Lexington.

Oct. 11, 1997: Georgia Southern rushed for 298 yards and built a 23-0 half-time advantage en route to a 30-7 home win over Western Carolina.

Oct. 11, 1997: Ernest Crosby rushed for 128 yards and two touchdowns and Furman withstood a late Appalachian State rally to earn a 24-22 win over the Mountaineers in Greenville.

Oct. 11, 1997: Western Carolina raced out to a 24-0 second quarter advantage and used 331 rushing yards to defeat The Citadel, 45-25.

Oct. 11, 1986: David Mayfield rushed for 132 yards and a school-record four touchdowns and the special teams blocked two punts as Western Carolina routed East Tennessee State, 43-16.

Oct. 11, 1986: John Settle's five-yard touchdown run with 6:19 remaining in the fourth quarter was the difference in Appalachian State's 20-15 SoCon win at Chattanooga.

Oct. 11, 1980: Chattanooga scored a season-high 55 points en route to a 55-10 SoCon victory at VMI.

Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)
