### PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – Furman's Shaun-Chris Joash and Belmont's Cameron Petty have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition from Feb. 23-March 1.

Sophomore forward Joash earned player of the week honors after having a hand in both goals against USC Upstate in a 2-0 win on Wednesday. The sophomore from Hampton Hill, England, scored the Paladins' first goal in the 41st minute and assisted on Jake Raine's goal in the 51st minute as Furman remained unbeaten on the young season.

Furman (2-0-0) travels to Gardner-Webb on Wednesday for a 6 p.m. kick in Boiling Springs, North Carolina, before conference action begins on March 13 against ETSU.

Belmont goalkeeper Petty logged his fourth shutout of his career with five saves on 17 shots faced in a scoreless draw against Central Arkansas on Thursday. Petty, who has logged clean sheets in four of his last five outings dating back to the 2019 season, is tied for first in the conference with a 0.00 goals against average and 1.000 save percentage.

The Bruins (1-0-1) are set to host Lipscomb at 7 p.m. on Tuesday at E.S Rose Park in Nashville, Tenn.



#### Notes

- Belmont tied with Central Arkansas Thursday, marking Belmont's first time in the NCAA Era with consecutive shutouts to begin a season. The Bruins streak ended Tuesday on March 2 p.m. when the team defeated Lipscomb 2-1 (2OT). Liam O'Brien ties for the conference lead with seven points and is the SoCon leader with 2.33 points per game. Dating back to last season, junior goalkeeper Cameron Petty has tabbed four clean sheets in his last five appearances between the pipes for the Bruins.
- ETSU tied with the VCU Rams on Feb. 27, senior night, and settled for the 0-0 draw. For the first time this season, the Bucs put double-digit shots up on the night. ETSU outshot the Rams 13-9 on the evening. The Bucs will open conference action on March 12 at 3 p.m. with a home match against Furman. Goalkeeper Josh Perryman is third in the SoCon with 14 saves and second with a 4.67 save average.
- The Furman Paladins shutout USC Upstate, 2-0, on Feb. 24 with their second clean sheet of the season. On March 3, the Paladins lost their first game of the season againat Gardner-Webb 3-0. Furman's Ben Hale leads all SoCon goalkeepers with two shutouts on the season.
- Mercer dropped its hard-fought match at UAB on Feb. 28, 1-0. Dawson Gideon and Dylan Gaither recorded a team-high two shots. Goalkeepers JR DeRose made at least four saves for the fourth time this season. Gaither is tied for third in the conference with three goals and seven points. DeRose leads the league with 23 saves on the season.
- VMI is 2-1 overall this season, which is the best start for the VMI men's soccer program since 2004. Goalkeeper Broden Schull leads the SoCon with 5.67 saves per game. The Keydets travel to Radford for a 2:30 p.m. kick on March 4.
- UNCG defeated both Gardner-Webb, 3-0, and Elon, 2-0 in its pair of games last week. The Spartans haven't allowed a goal in 254 minutes and hold the longest winning streak (3) heading into their match against Longwood on March 4 at 3 p.m. ET.
- Wofford travels to Davidson, former SoCon member, on March 6 for its third game of the 2021 spring season. The game will be streamed on ESPN+.
- The 2020-21 SoCon Men's Soccer Championship is set to be contested on consecutive weekends in April. The top two seeds will host semifinal matches on either April 9 or 10, with the top remaining seed hosting the final on April 16 or 17.
