PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – UNCG's JC Ngando and Niclas Wild have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition Oct. 19-25.

Ngando recorded four assists in two of the Spartans' home contests last week, assisting on one goal in UNCG's 7-1 nonconference win over USC Upstate on Tuesday before adding a career-best three assists in the Spartans' 3-0 conference victory over Wofford on Saturday. In the match against the Spartans, the freshman midfielder connected with UNCG's Jack Birch on a go ahead pass for a goal, extending UNCG's lead to 5-1 in the 67th minute. In the Spartans' conference win over the Terriers, Ngando assisted on all three goals, including goals in the 10th minute, 33rd minute, and 73rd minute to grab the win and improve UNCG's record to 4-1 in SoCon play. The Paris, France, native is currently tied for the team lead in assists with seven, and was also named to the College Soccer News Team of the Week following the Spartans' pair of victories.

Wild secured his eighth shutout of the season in the Spartans' victory over Wofford and ended the week with three total saves and a scoreless goal streak of over 135 minutes. The sophomore goalkeeper from Decatur, Georgia, tallied two saves in the win against USC Upstate, before recording one in UNCG's victory over the Terriers.

The 25th-ranked Spartans (11-3-1, 4-1 SoCon) travel to Farmville, Virginia, for a nonconference match against Longwood on Tuesday, Oct. 26, at 6 p.m., before traveling to Johnson City, Tennessee, on Saturday, Oct. 30, for their final conference match against ETSU (4-6-3, 1-2-2 SoCon) at 7 p.m.



• After a scoreless first overtime period, Mercer's Trevor Martineau ended the game after he was assisted by Kadeem Agard and Kevin Kim just eight minutes into the fourth frame.

• Both senior goalkeeper Drew Romig, the reigning SoCon Defensive Player of the Week, and Mercer starting keeper Trevor McMullen came up with four saves. The Bruins finished with six shots on goal and the Bears seven as both squads recorded 13 total shots.

• Furman received second half goals from Jake Raine and Jacob Garzon on Saturday evening as the Paladins defeated the ETSU, 2-1, during Senior Night at Stone Stadium.

• The Paladins improve to 4-8-1 overall and 3-2 in the SoCon, while East Tennessee State drops to 4-6-3 on the season and 1-2-2 in conference play.

• UNCG took control of the SoCon race after blanking Wofford, 3-0 on Saturday night. Theo Collomb, Daniel Mangarov, and Basile Marc added a goal each in the conference victory, while JC Ngando fueled the Spartans offense with a trio of assists.

• The Spartans have scored 46 goals this season to lead the nation. UNCG has scored at least three goals nine times this season. The 11 victories are the most in a single season since 2016.

• VMI battled to a 3-3 double overtime tie Saturday against visiting UNC-Asheville in a non-conference game on Saturday at Patchin Field.

• Freshman Grant Martin opened the scoring just 48 seconds in on a feed from fellow freshman Cole Mooney. Martin found sophomore Warner Collier at the 5:27 mark and Mooney made the score 3-0 on a pass from freshman Woongchan Oh just 12:35 into the game. Broden Schull finished the match with 11 saves.

• Belmont and UNCG grabbed a pair of non-conference wins over Eastern Illinois and Longwood on Tuesday, while Furman defeated UNC Asheville, 2-1, on Wednesday.
