### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Noah Dahlman Wofford

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Wofford's Noah Dahlman has been named the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for all games February 17-23 the league office announced Tuesday (Feb. 24). Dahlman helped the Terriers pick up victories over Furman (85-82, OT) and Western Carolina (81-66). He averaged 22.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and connected on 62 percent of his field goal attempts (18-29) last week.

Dahlman led the Terriers in scoring both games, posting a career-high 25 points in Wofford's overtime win at Furman Saturday afternoon. He followed that performance with 20 points and seven rebounds against Western Carolina Monday night. Dahlman has led the Terriers in scoring in each of his last six games. He is the third-leading scorer in the conference (17.2 ppg) and leads the league in field goal percentage (.594). Dahlman is 14th in the league in rebounding (6.2 rpg), and leads the conference in offensive boards per game (3.2).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- A.J. Highsmith found the bottom of the net from the corner with under 30 seconds to play last Thursday, as the Mountaineers broke a three-game skid against UNC Greensboro. On Saturday, Winthrop got its first-ever win against Appalachian in a 65-63 BracketBuster matchup.
- Each of ASU's last five games have been decided by five points or less, as have 12 of the team's games on the season. ASU continues to dominate the boards as the team holds a +7.4 rebound margin for the season, good for 10th-best in the nation.
- The Mountaineers host Chattanooga Thursday night. ASU will entertain Samford Saturday afternoon to close out the regular season.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Senior Nicchaeus Doaks passed Lance Fulse (1985-88) for fourth place in career scoring in the Division I era in Saturday's win over Samford. Doaks now has 1,342 points, 107 behind Gerald Wilkins (1983-85) and Brandon Born (1992-95) who are tied for second with 1,449.
- Senior Stephen McDowell is two three pointers shy of Keddrick Mays' (2006-07) school record of 118 three-pointers made in a single season (2007). McDowell is the school's all-time leader in three-pointers made with 224. His 116 this year and 108 last season makes him the only player in school history to make 100 in more than one season. He is 12 points (988) shy of 1,000 in his UTC career.
- The Mocs visit Appalachian State and Western Carolina this week.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 16th in program history with 1,256 points. He ranks third in the conference in blocked shots (1.5 bpg), sixth in steals (1.6 spg) and 20th in rebounding (5.2 rpg).
- The Phoenix are fourth in the conference in assists (13.8 apg) and assist to turnover ratio (1.0). Sophomore Chris Long is second in the league in assists per game (4.3 apg) and leads the conference in assist to turnover ratio (2.3).
- The Phoenix host Georgia Southern Thursday night. Elon will visit UNC Greensboro Saturday.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Mikko Koivisto moved into the Top 20 on the UNCG career scoring list last week. He now has 913 points in his career, which is good for 19th place all-time at UNCG. He is also 17th in assists with 147 and third in three-point field goals with 206.
- Ben Stywall has moved up to sixth on the UNCG career rebounds list, now with 617. Stywall's 230 rebounds thus far this season ranks 11th in school history for a single season.
- UNC Greensboro hosts Elon Saturday afternoon on SportSouth.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford is 13-4 when shooting better than its opponent from the field. The Bulldogs also hold a 12-4 mark when outshooting their opponent from three-point range. In Samford's 13 victories this season, the Bulldogs are shooting at an average of 52.2 percent from the floor and 41.3 percent from beyond the arc.
- The Bulldogs have made at least one three-point field goal in 528 consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a three-point basket was Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.
- Samford visits Western Carolina Thursday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- With 14 wins on the season, Western Carolina has matched the most victories in Larry Hunter's tenure in Cullowhee. Hunter won 13 games in his first season at the helm of the Catamount program (13-17) in 2005-06.
- Western Carolina's nine conference victories is its highest total since winning 10 games during the 1995-96 season, which was WCU's only divisional title and tournament championship.
- The Catamounts host Samford and Chattanooga this weekend in Cullowhee, N.C.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Monday's win at Chattanooga gave the Cougars their 21st win of the season. CofC has won at least 20 games for the 22nd time in the past 30 seasons. The Cougars have averaged 23.3 wins and just 7.2 losses per season during that span.
- Head coach Bobby Cremins and CofC women's coach Nancy Wilson are one of only four active Division I men's and women's coaches at the same school to have reached at least 500 wins.
- College of Charleston hosts Wofford Thursday. The Cougars welcome Furman to Charleston Saturday.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With 2,454 career points, junior Stephen Curry is fourth all-time on the Southern Conference's career scoring list. He needs 30 points to become Davidson's all-time leading scorer.
- Davidson leads the conference and ranks seventh in the nation in turnover margin (+5.4). The Wildcats average just 12.2 turnovers a game and force their opponents into 17.6 miscues per contest.
- Davidson will host Georgia Southern Saturday. The Wildcats close out the regular season Monday night at Elon.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Freshman Bryson Barnes recorded his second double-double of the season with a career-high 20 points and 11 rebounds against Wofford on Saturday. Barnes has averaged 15.8 points and 6.0 rebounds over his last four games.
- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 12th in the conference in scoring. Miller is averaging 14.3 points per game and also ranks seventh in the conference in free throw percentage (.796). He has been Furman's leading scorer in 16 of 26 games this year.
- The Paladins travel to The Citadel Thursday night.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- The Eagles connected on a season-high 25-of-32 from the free throw line against Jacksonville State, surpassing the previous three-game total of 16 made free throw attempts.
- Head coach Jeff Price is just one win shy of 300 for his career. Price, in his 16th season as a head coach, has captured 165 wins at Georgia Southern, the 13th-highest win total among all coaches to coach at a Southern Conference school.
- GSU visits Elon Thursday night. The Eagles will travel to face Davidson Saturday afternoon.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs have won 10 straight games, the longest winning streak for The Citadel since the 1926-27 season when the Bulldogs won 13 games in a row. The Citadel's 12-game improvement in conference play is the biggest turnaround in league history.
- The Bulldogs defeated Davidson last Wednesday for the first time since 2002 and won in Davidson for the first time since 1990. Head coach Ed Conroy had never defeated the Wildcats in Davidson as a player or coach of The Citadel until last week's win.
- The Citadel will host Furman Thursday night. The Bulldogs will host Wofford Saturday before closing out the season at Georgia Southern Monday night.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Wofford has won three straight games for just the second time this season and has scored at least 80 points in all three wins while shooting over 50 percent in each win as well. Wofford is 9-0 on the season when shooting better than 50 percent from the field.
- Wofford's ten conference wins are the most since joining the league in the 1997-98 season. The ten wins also secures a .500 record in the conference play for only the fourth time.
- The Terriers travel to Charleston, S.C., this weekend. Wofford takes on College of Charleston Thursday night before visiting The Citadel Saturday afternoon.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### MOVING FORWARD

The Citadel has won 13 conference games this season after going 1-19 in league play during 2007-08. The Bulldogs' 12-game improvement is the best mark in league history for biggest turnaround in consecutive seasons.

### TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November 2008 to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

### HALL OF FAME

The Southern Conference announced the inaugural Hall of Fame class for 2009. The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

### EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches returned to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

### PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.
