Wofford travels to Furman for a 12:30 kick on CSTV, followed by Western Carolina at Appalachian State at 3:30 on CSS.



Two-Minute Drill

• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman is in the No. 6 spot in the poll with Appalachian State checking in at No. 8. Georgia Southern jumps four spots to No. 10 this week. Chattanooga and Western Carolina also received votes. It marks the seventh time in the past two seasons that three SoCon teams have been ranked in the top 10 in the same week.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains in the top 10 at the No. 6 spot with Appalachian State at the No. 7 spot. Georgia Southern checks in at No. 11. Western Carolina also received votes.

• Six student-athletes were named to the national award watch lists. Appalachian State's Richie Williams, Furman's Ingle Martin and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin are among the players on the Payton Award watch list. Appalachian State's Marques Murrell, Elon's Chad Nkang and Furman's William Freeman and are all on the Buchanan Award watch list.

• Chattanooga's Eldra Buckley has rushed for a combined 397 yards in the last two games. That ranks him ninth in league history for most yards in two consecutive games. He was the first UTC player to rush for 1,000 yards in a season since Tyrone Coleman rushed for a school-record 1,191 yards in 1998.

• One week after rushing for a career-best 178 yards vs. South Dakota State, Georgia Southern QB Jayson Foster rushed for a career-high 191 yards. Foster has rushed for 1,282 yards this season, the second most by a quarterback in league history.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (6-3, 4-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State had its three-game win streak snapped at the hands of I-A LSU, 24-0...It was the Mountaineers second loss of the season to a I-A school...ASU outgained the Tigers on the ground, 176-163, and ran four more plays than LSU (58 to 54)...ASU QB **Richie Williams** rushed for a team-best 80 yards on 10 carries, while RB **Kevin Richardson** added 59...Williams was 9-of-21 in the air for 70 yards...WRs **Zach Johnson** and **Jermame Little** led the team with two catches apiece...LB **Pierre Banks** led the defensive attack with 11 tackles, 10 of which were solo tackles...Three of LB **Monte Smith's** five tackles went for a loss...ASU hosts Western Carolina on Saturday in the annual battle for the Old Mountain Jug...The game will be televised on CSS.

The Citadel (2-7, 1-5 SoCon)

The Citadel dropped its fifth in a row with a 31-21 setback at Chattanooga...The Bulldogs outgained the Mocs 359-329 in total offense...QB **Ben Carnell** was 18-for-31 for 197 yards and threw two interceptions...RB **Nuru Goodrum** had a team-high 98 yards on the ground and scored a pair of touchdowns on one-yard runs...WR **Kinta Palmer** caught four passes for 73 yards while four other Bulldogs had three receptions each...LB **Andrew Rowell** had a team-high nine tackles, including two for a loss...Rowell also had the game's only sack...The Citadel hosts Elon in its Homecoming game on Saturday...It is also the team's final home game of the year.

Chattanooga (6-4, 3-3 SoCon)

Chattanooga ended a two-game losing streak with a 31-21 win at home over The Citadel, giving the Mocs their first winning season since 1997...RB **Eldra Buckley** had a game-high 187 yards on the ground, his fifth 100-yard game of the year - and fourth in the past five weeks...Buckley also rushed for three touchdowns, all coming in the first half...Buckley moved past 1,000 yards rushing on the season, becoming the first Moc to surpass 1,000 yards since Tyrone Coleman rushed for a school-record 1,191 yards in 1998...In his last two games, Buckley has rushed for 397 yards, the ninth-highest two-game total in league history...QB **Antonio Miller**, who was 6-of-13 for 73 yards, also carried the ball nine times for 54 yards and a TD...WR **Emanuel Hassell** had three receptions for 43 yards...LB **Jeff Phillips** and DB **Lonnie McCowan** tied for team honors with nine tackles apiece...Chattanooga is idle this week and will close out its season on Nov. 19 at home against Furman.

Elon (3-6, 0-5 SoCon)

The Phoenix return to action this week against The Citadel after dropping its fifth game in a row, 31-26, to Western Carolina on Oct. 29...Elon scored 16 fourth quarter points to fall short...Three of Elon's losses in league play have been by five points or less...QB **Kye Hamilton** was 15-of-32 for 156 yards and two touchdowns...WR **Michael Mayers** and RB **Reggie Hall** each led the team with five catches each, with Mayers netting 78 yards on his catches...Hall added 91 yards on the ground, while RB **Jarrett Meadors** chipped in 59 yards rushing...LB **Chad Nkang** tied for game-high honors with 12 tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss...Following its games this week at The Citadel, Elon hosts Appalachian State in its season finale on Nov. 19.

Furman (7-2, 3-2 SoCon)

Furman had its six-game win streak end with a 27-24 loss at No. 12 Georgia Southern...QB **Ingle Martin** was 16-for-21 for 240 yards and one touchdown...RB **Daric Carter** had a game-high five catches for 78 yards...Martin also averaged 43.8 yards on four punts...RB **Jerome Felton** rushed for 81 yards on 10 carries and scored on a 26-yard scamper...LB **William Freeman** had a career-high 17 tackles in the game, including one for loss...Also posting double digit tackles were LB **Andrew Jones** (15 tackles), FS/SS **Andrew Thacker** (14) and LB **Brandon Williams** (13)...The Paladins close out their home regular season schedule on Saturday against Wofford, in a game that will be aired on CSTV.

Georgia Southern (7-3, 5-2 SoCon)

Georgia Southern won for the third time in a row on Saturday as the Eagles knocked off No. 1 Furman 27-24 in the final conference game of the year for GSU...QB **Jayson Foster** rushed for a career-high 191 yards and a touchdown while passing for another 80 yards...RB **Jermame Austin** added 142 yards on the ground and scored three times, including the game-winning 4-yard touchdown with 1:02 left in the game...The Eagles picked up 510 yards of offense and limited the Furman offense to 384 yards, nearly 100 yards below the team's average heading into the game...LB **John Mohring** had a team-high 13 tackles, five of them solo stops...GSU concludes its regular season schedule by hosting Morehead State on Saturday.

Western Carolina (5-3, 4-2 SoCon)

The Catamounts secured their first winning season since 2001 with a 24-0 win over Wofford...RB **Lamont Reid** scored all three of WCU's touchdowns, the last coming on a fumble recovery in the end zone...WCU outgained the Terriers 336 to 182...RB **Darius Fudge** had a game-high 97 yards on the ground...QB **Justin Clark** was 16-for-23 for 162 yards...WR **Michael Hines** led the Catamounts with five catches for 51 yards, while WR **J.C. Brown** added four receptions for 79 yards...DE **Rico Reese** had seven solo tackles, including two for loss...Reese and DB **Mitchell Dukes** also registered a sack...WCU ends its regular season schedule on Saturday at Appalachian State in a battle for the Old Mountain Jug.

Wofford (5-4, 3-3 SoCon)

Wofford was shut out for the first time since 2003 this past Saturday to Western Carolina, 24-0...It also marked the first time that the Terriers have not scored in a SoCon game...The Terriers mustered only 182 yards of total offense, with 163 of them coming on the ground...QB **Josh Collier** led the way with 69 yards rushing, followed by 64 from **Adrian Young**...Three different Wofford players attempted field goals, two of which missed while the other was blocked...LB **Justin Franklin** had a game-high 11 tackles...Wofford travels to face Furman on Saturday in a game that will be nationally televised on CSTV.

Wofford (5-4, 3-3 SoCon) at #6/#6 Furman (7-2, 3-2 SoCon), 12:00
Paladin Stadium (16,000) • Greenville, SC

THE GAME: This is the 79th meeting between the two schools and the ninth since Wofford joined the SoCon...The Paladins lead the all-time series, 47-24-7...Furman won last year's game 31-24 in Spartanburg and has won five of the last six meetings...Wofford is coming off a 24-0 loss at Western Carolina, while Furman fell at Georgia Southern, 27-24...For the Terriers, it marked the first time that they were shut out in conference play...P Chris Tommie averaged 46.5 yards on six punts, including a long of 54 yards...Tommie averaged nearly 11 yards longer per kick than his average heading into last Saturday's contest...Wofford had four sacks on the day vs. WCU, the second most by the Terriers in a game this year...Furman LB William Freeman notched a career-best 17 tackles vs. GSU, the second most by a SoCon player this season...QB Ingle Martin needs 64 yards to move into third place in Furman history in career passing yards...He is also 99 yards shy of becoming the first Paladin to pass for 2,000 yards in a season on more than one occasion...Martin, who has 5,100 career total yards, became only the fifth player in school annals to record 5,000 yards of total offense.

THE COACHES: Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 115-84-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 3-11-1 vs. Furman, 2-9-1 while at Wofford...Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 31-14 record while at the head of the Paladins program and is 2-1 vs. Wofford.



Morehead State (8-2, 3-0 Pioneer) at #10/#11 Georgia Southern (7-3, 5-2 SoCon), 1:00
Paulson Stadium (18,000) • Statesboro, GA



THE GAME: This is the first meeting between the two schools...Morehead State is coming off a 56-55 win over Missouri-Rolla, while Georgia Southern defeated No. 1 Furman, 27-24...This is the final regular season game for both schools...MSU will play at San Diego next Saturday (Nov. 19) for the Pioneer League Championship...QB Jayson Foster and RB Jermaine Austin each have eight 100-yard games on the season, tied for the 14th most in one year in league history...Foster's 1,282 rushing yards are the second most by a QB in conference history and needs 140 yards to break the SoCon single season mark for a signal caller...In his last three games Austin has 425 yards and seven TDs...Austin and Foster's combined rushing total of 2,563 yards this season is the fourth-highest single season total in league annals...Foster has rushed for 17 TDs this season, tied for sixth in SoCon records and third among quarterbacks...Foster has scored at least one TD in all 10 games -- one game shy of tying the league's single season mark...

THE COACHES: Matt Ballard is in his 18th season at Morehead State and is 107-80-1...Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 34-13 in three-plus years as head coach of Georgia Southern...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 94-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000.



Elon (3-6, 0-5 SoCon) at The Citadel (2-7, 1-5 SoCon), 2:00
Johnson Hagood Stadium (21,000) • Charleston, SC



THE GAME: The fifth meeting all-time between the two schools...The Citadel leads the series 3-1...The Phoenix won last year's meeting 24-7 in Elon...Elon returns to action after being idle last week...Elon will try and snap a five-game losing streak, the team's longest since dropping nine in a row back in 2003 and 2004 -- the last eight of '03 and the first of '04...RB Reggie Hall leads Elon with 673 yards on the ground and is fifth in the league averaging 84.1 ypg...LB Chad Nkang, who leads the conference with 124 tackles, needs 16 tackles to move into the top-10 in the league's single season tackle totals...RB Nuru Goodrum is ninth in the league with 528 rushing yards and is also ninth in yards per game (66.0).

THE COACHES: Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-14 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-55 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 4-3 vs. The Citadel, 0-1 while at Elon...Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is in his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-7 overall... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position.

THE GAME: The battle of the Old Mountain Jug that has taken place annually since 1978...The Mountaineers lead the all-time series 50-18-1 and are 21-6 since the battle for the jug began in 1978...This is the final game of the regular season for Western Carolina...WCU picked up a win last week over Wofford (24-0), while Appalachian State fell to LSU 24-0...The Catamounts have won four league games for the first time since 2001, which was also the last time the program had an overall record of .500 or better...Western Carolina won last year's meeting in Cullowhee, 30-27...Each of the past five meetings between the two schools has been decided by 10 points or less...RB Darius Fudge is seventh in the league averaging 74.9 ypg...The Catamounts must win to have a shot of securing at least a share of the league title...QB Justin Clark needs 126 passing yards to reach 2,500 for his career...ASU QB Richie Williams is 205 passing yards from becoming the fifth player in SoCon history to pass for 7,000 yards in a career...RB Kevin Richardson is tied for third in the league with 10 rushing touchdowns...Richardson is 184 yards from reaching 1,000 for the year...Defensive linemen Jason Hunter and Marques Murrell rank first and second in the league in sacks with 8.0 and 7.5, respectively...With a win, the Mountaineers would win at least seven games in a season for the 11th time in the past 12 seasons.

THE COACHES: Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is in his fourth season as coach of his alma mater...Briggs has tabulated an 19-23 record in his three-plus seasons and is 1-2 vs. ASU...The winningest coach in SoCon football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 134-66 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school...Moore is 14-2 vs. WCU.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Nov. 12, 1977: Furman's Tommy Southard caught just one pass in the Paladins 31-28 loss to VMI, albeit an influential one, as it accounted for the Paladins final touchdown of the day. The touchdown was the Paladins fourth of the second half, but was still not enough to defeat the Keydets, who came into the second half with a 21-0 lead.

Nov. 12, 1977: Chattanooga's Allen Johnson was the show. Johnson rushed 18 times for 173 yards, scoring all 14 of the Mocs points in their 14-14 tie with Tennessee State.

Nov. 12, 1983: Appalachian State's Alvin Parker pounded out 222 yards on 37 carries in the Mountaineers 28-19 win over Marshall. Parker also garnered two touchdowns on the day, including a 20-yard touchdown scamper with 4:38 left in the fourth quarter that seemingly put the game out of reach for the Thundering Herd.

Nov. 12, 1994: The only highlight of the day for Furman in its 35-14 loss to Marshall was the team recording one of the shortest, most time consuming scoring drives in school history when they marched all of 45 yards in 13 plays, taking 7:15 minutes off the clock in the second quarter.

Nov. 12, 1994: The Citadel made sure that a third straight heartbreaking defeat did not come to pass in a 28-20 win over Appalachian State in Charleston, S.C. Lyvonina Mitchell solidified the game for the Bulldogs late in the fourth when he ran 43 yards for a touchdown with just 1:01 left on the clock. The win snapped a five-game skid for the Bulldogs.

Nov. 12, 1983: Ranked a season-high No. 18 heading into their game with Gardner-Webb, Western Carolina scored on their first three possessions of the game to easily beat the Bulldogs 43-7 to garner their seventh straight win.

Nov. 12, 1994: UTC senior quarterback Kenyon Earl had a good day in his final home game at Chamberlain Field, completing 17 of 26 passes for 207 yards in the Mocs' 30-13 loss to in-state rival East Tennessee State.

Nov. 12, 1994: It only took a week, but The Citadel's Travis Jervey bested his previous week's career-high by rushing for 224 yards in the Bulldogs' 58-14 win over VMI in the 48th annual Oyster Bowl.

Nov. 12, 1994: Damon Scott ran for a one-yard touchdown with 14:22 left in the fourth quarter that would turn into the eventual game-winner in Appalachian State's 12-7 win over archrival Western Carolina.
