- Mercer shut out Georgia Southern 3-0 in at home Sept. 22. Next up, Mercer will hit the road for its first away game at Georgia State Oct. 6 in Atlanta. Mercer lost the first match up against Georgia State, 2-1, in their season opener on Sept. 18. This game will conclude Sun Belt non-conference competition, as the Bears take on South Carolina Oct 10. The Bears will conclude their fall season on the road against Kentucky Oct. 14.
- Dylan Gaither recorded the first gamewinning goal of his career during the Sept. 22 shut out against Georgia Southern. Gaither was named to TopDrawerSoccer Team of the Week, the organization announced on Sept. 30.
- Junior Trevor Martineau scored his 25th career goal and 67th point, as he continues to lead the conference as the active career leader in goals (25), points (67) and game-winning goals (10).
- Mercer's redshirt senior Leo Toledo Jr. is currently the NCAA Division I and Southern Confernece active career leader in assists (20).
- Mercer won the 2019 Southern Conference Men's Soccer Championship with a 1-0 win over No. 2 seed UNCG in the title game after defeating No. 1 seed Furman in the semifinal round 3-2 in 2OT. It was the Bears' third title since joining the league in 2014.
- Last season, the Bears tied their singleseason program record with 14 wins.
- •The Bears fell in the first round of the 2019 NCAA tournament to Charlotte, 3-1.
- The Southern Conference Council of Presidents announced on Aug. 13 that the league would postpone conference competition for all fall sports to the spring due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, with schools able to participate in nonconference play in the fall at their discretion.
- UNCG and Furman shared the 2019 SoCon regular-season title, but have opted out of participating in fall competition along with Belmont, ETSU, VMI and Wofford.
