PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jeremy Simmons - CofC

College of Charleston senior forward Jeremy Simmons recorded a double-double as the Cougars topped Charleston Southern 77-69 last week.

The Lithonia, Ga., native poured in a career-high 26 points for the Cougars and added a season-high 12 rebounds in the win over the Buccaneers. He made 12-of-20 shots from the floor and added a team-high three steals, two blocked shots and an assist in 34 minutes of action. Simmons scored 14 points and pulled down nine rebounds in the first half. It was his seventh career double-double and his fourth 20-point game as a Cougar. The senior pulled down his 600th career rebound in the win and now has 606 boards which ranks fifth all-time at College of Charleston.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Donald Sims, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Samford's Josh Davis, Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, Western Carolina's Grey Sumler and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State returned home for the first time in over a month when it downed Robert Morris on Saturday. The Mountaineers moved to a perfect 4-0 against the Colonials, knocking off the defending NEC champions, 71-66.
- Donald Sims led ASU with 23 points and moved

within two points of third place on the program's career scoring list, at 1,732. Omar Carter chipped in 14 points in the game, while Jeremi Booth reached double figures for the third game in a row, with 10.

- The Mountaineers will take part in the Cancun Govern's Cup December 22-24.

ELON PHOENIX



- Elon has been one of the top teams at sharing the basketball during the first month of the season. The Phoenix rank second in the conference with 15.3 assists per game. Elon also ranks second in the league with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.1.
- Elon has seen an increase in its scoring through the

first eleven games this season. The Phoenix are third in the league with an average of 76.7 points per contest, ten points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game.

- The Phoenix visit Navy Wednesday night.

UNCG SPARTANS



- Sophomore guard Kyle Randall has proven to be a threat for the Spartans in the backcourt. Randall leads the Spartans in both scoring (11.9 ppg) and assists (3.7 apg). He also owns a 1.3 assist-to-turnover ratio which ranks in the top 10 of the conference.
- UNCG has been one of the best teams on the offensive

glass in the conference through the first month of the season. The Spartans rank second in the SoCon with 13.1 offensive rebounds per game. The Spartans are fourth in offensive rebound percent (.344).

- The Spartans host Richmond December 22 and will entertain Duke on December 29.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford is off to its best start to a season since the Bulldogs opened the 2005-06 campaign with a 10-4 record. That team went on to finish with a 20-11 overall mark and advanced to the championship game of the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament.

- Samford head coach Jimmy Tillette will be coaching in his 400th game at the helm of the Bulldog basketball program Wednesday at Creighton. Tillette enters the non-conference showdown as Samford's all-time winningest coach with a career record of 214-185.
- Samford visits Creighton Wednesday night.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- The Mocs earned a 71-65 win at Elon last week to move to 3-0 in league play. The last time the Mocs started 3-0 in conference play was the 2007-08 season which was a 7-0 start.
- The Mocs have won three games when trailing at the half this season. The biggest comebacks have come from

10 points down during the first half at Marshall and at Elon. Chattanooga has come back from second half deficits of seven at Kennesaw State, eight at Marshall, five at home against Appalachian State and five at Elon.

- The Mocs host the Dr. Pepper Classic December 29-30.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Senior guard Mike Williams has been tabbed one of 66 initial candidates for the Bob Cousy Award given to the top point guard in the nation. Williams leads the Catamounts in points (15.3 ppg) and assists (3.9 apg).
- Western Carolina has lost five straight games, marking

the longest winless drought for the Catamounts since the 2006-07 season. WCU had not dropped more than three consecutive games since 2006-07 when the Catamounts endured a pair of five-game skids.

- The Catamounts visit UNC Asheville December 28.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- CofC has outscored its last four opponents by an average margin of 11.3 points per game against Davidson, Georgia Southern, East Tennessee State and Charleston Southern and is 7-0 when scoring 77-or-more points in a contest.
- The Cougars are ranked among the top 50 NCAA leaders in scoring offense (46th, 77.9), field-goal percentage (44th, 47.5), three-point field goals per game (32nd, 8.2) and free-throw percentage (37th, 74.1).

- CofC will host Clemson December 22. The Cougars will visit Tennessee December 31.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior point guard, and recent Bob Cousy Award nominee Cameron Wells has moved within 19 points of tying Regan Truesdale for the Bulldogs all-time mark in points. Truesdale (1981-85) completed his career with 1,661 points and has now held the record for 25 years heading into the Dec. 22 meeting with South Carolina State.
- Senior combo guard Austin Dahn has a nine-game streak in which he has knocked down at least one 3-pointer. It is two shy of Dahn's personal-long streak of 11 games, which he set from Jan. 14, 2008-Feb. 20, 2008.

- The Citadel will take part in the Las Vegas Classic December 22-23.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs 25 three-pointers to move into the top five on the career list. McKillop has knocked down 162 career triples. He ranks second in the SoCon this season with 3.1 made three-pointers per game.
- Head coach Bob McKillop is 12 wins away from his 400th career victory. A total of 351 of his 388 wins have come while Davidson has been a member of the Southern Conference, making him the all-time wins leader in league history.

- The Wildcats travel to take part in the MSG Holiday Festival in New York City December 20-21.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman held North Florida to just 49 points in the Paladins' win over the Ospreys Sunday afternoon. It was the fewest points given up by Furman this season. The Paladins lead the league in scoring defense as Furman has allowed just 63.0 points per game this season.
- Sunday's victory at North Florida marked Furman's

fourth straight win and fourth road victory of the 2010-11 season. Furman, 4-2 on the road this season, posted just a 5-11 record away from Timmons Arena last season.

- The Paladins host South Carolina December 22.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Rory Spencer missed a double-double by just one rebound during his first start back from injury against Cincinnati. Spencer scored 16 points and grabbed nine rebounds which tied a career high. His seven made field goals in the game also tied a career high.

- Three Eagles rank in the top 15 of the SoCon in scoring average. Ben Drayton III ranks eighth (14.7 ppg) while Rory Spencer and Eric Ferguson rank 11th (14.4 ppg) and 13th (13.8 ppg), respectively.
- The Eagles welcome Georgia State to Statesboro December 22.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- The Terriers shot 65.9 percent from the floor in their 79-65 victory over High Point. It was the first time Wofford has shot better than 60 percent from the field since February 19, 2005 against Furman.
- Seven Terriers have played in all eleven games this

year and each one has scored in double figures at least twice. Senior Noah Dahlman leads the team with 19.1 points per game while guards Cameron Rundles and Jamar Diggs both average 13.1 points per contest for the Terriers.

- Wofford travels to Richmond, Va., to take part in the VCU Tournament December 29-30.

CONFERENCE NOTES

COUSY CANDIDATES

The Southern Conference boasts four candidates for the 2011 Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard. The Award is presented through the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The Southern Conference Candidates Include:

- Brendan McKillop, Sr., Davidson
- Cameron Wells, Sr., The Citadel
- Mike Williams, Sr., Western Carolina

RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- Elon grabbed 54 rebounds against Hampden-Sydney (Nov. 22). It was the tenth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.

MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2010-11.

CONFERENCE NOTES

FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2011 marks the 90th year of the post-season classic.

CONFERENCE NOTES

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.

BRACKETBUSTERS 2011

Five Southern Conference teams are scheduled to take part in the 2011 Bracket-Busters event on February 19. The SoCon has had at least two teams participate in the event every year since 2004. League teams went 3-1 in 2010
