PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Donald Sims - Appalachian St.

Sims averaged 33.0 points and shot better than 61 percent from the field last week.

A junior guard from Gaffney, S.C., Sims scored 22 points in ASU's 62-58 loss to The Citadel last Wednesday. He then scored 44 points in a 78-68 win at Davidson Saturday afternoon. Sims' 44 points was the fourth highest single-game total in Mountaineer history and was the highest point total in Davidson's Belk Arena. It was the third-highest point total for any Division I player this season and the most points scored by a Mountaineer in 35 years. Sims added three assists, two steals and five rebounds over the two games.

Last week's scoring outburst vaulted Sims into the No. 1 position among all SoCon performers with 19.1 points per game. He is averaging a league-best 27.0 points per contest in conference games. After going 16-of-16 from the foul line last week, he now leads the nation in free throw shooting, connecting on 95.9 of his attempts from the charity stripe this season.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims scored a Belk Arena-record 44 points Saturday at Davidson, the fourth-highest single-game total in ASU history. Sims is third in the nation at 94.8 percent shooting from the free throw line. He also now leads the league in scoring at 18.9 points per game (24.8 ppg in league games)
- Isaac Butts pulled in 10 rebounds in both games last week and recorded his fourth double-double of the season on Saturday with 13 points at Davidson.
- The Mountaineers host UNC Greensboro Saturday afternoon.

ELON PHOENIX



- Junior guard Chris Long remains one of the best distributors in the conference. Long is seventh in the league with 3.4 helpers per game. He has recorded at least three assists in seven of his last eight games, including a season-high 11 assists at NC State.
- The Phoenix have been one of the best teams in the conference in steals. Elon averages 6.4 steals per game, the fifth best mark in the league. Long averages 1.3 thefts per game, good for 12th best in the conference, while senior Devan Carter has averaged 1.2 steals per contest, the 14th best mark in the SoCon.
- The Phoenix visit Western Carolina Saturday night.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Mikko Koivisto and Ben Stywall both topped the 1,000 point mark for their careers last week. Koivisto topped it on Saturday against Furman, while Stywall did it Monday night at Chattanooga. They are the 17th and 18th players in school history to achieve the milestone.
- When UNCG had six players in double figures on Saturday against Furman, it was the first time it had happened since December 16, 2004 (against Guilford).
- Following a stretch of five games in 12 days, the Spartans are back on the road this week. After visiting WCU Thursday, the Spartans travel to face Appalachian State Saturday.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Senior forward Bryan Friday led the Bulldogs with 16 points against College of Charleston. In his last four games, Friday is averaging 16.5 points per contest. He averages 10.5 points per game, good 21st in the league.
- Samford is third in the nation in fewest personal fouls per game. The Bulldogs are only committing an average of 13.4 fouls per contest and have only allowed their opponents to shoot a total of 204 free throws this season. Samford is also ranked among the top-15 teams in the nation in scoring defense. The Bulldogs are ranked No. 11 in the nation in the category and are only allowing the opposition to score an average of 58.6 points per game.
- The Bulldogs host The Citadel Saturday afternoon.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- UTC is on a six-game winning streak after pulling out a dramatic 56-54 win over The Citadel Thursday night. The Mocs are now 8-2 at McKenzie Arena.
- Head Coach John Shulman captured his 100th win in his 178th game at Chattanooga. He is the fifth Mocs coach to turn 100. Current East Carolina Coach Mack McCarthy is the all-time wins leader at the school with 243.
- The Mocs host College of Charleston Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised on SportSouth.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina leads the league in scoring with 74.9 points per game after scoring 79 against UNC Greensboro Thursday night. WCU also ranks first in the SoCon in scoring margin at +10.6 points per contest. The Catamounts are also +4.6 in turnover margin.
- Senior Jake Robinson has made 238 three pointers during his career. He trails only former Catamount - and current assistant coach - Anquell McCollum, who made 245 from 1993-96.
- The Catamounts host Elon Saturday evening.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Junior guard Cameron Wells tied his season high with 28 of The Citadel's 54 points Thursday night at Chattanooga. Wells leads the Bulldogs and is fourth in the league with 17.7 points per game. He is averaging 21.0 points per contest over his last three games and has averaged 20.0 points in league games, the second-best mark in the conference.
- The Citadel holds a 298-242 edge in bench scoring in 16 games this season. The Bulldogs held a 15-0 edge in bench scoring in the loss to the College of Charleston.
- The Bulldogs visit Samford Saturday afternoon.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Junior Andrew Goudelock recorded his first career double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds last Saturday at The Citadel. Goudelock scored a game-high 23 points at Samford on Thursday. He has averaged 22.8 points over his last four games.
- The Cougars recorded 10 blocked shots against The Citadel Saturday. It was the second consecutive game, and the third time this season, in which they have tallied at least 10 blocks.
- College of Charleston takes its 5-0 league mark into Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Steve Rossiter needs 18 points and four rebounds to become the 30th Davidson player to tally 500 points and 500 rebounds. Rossiter has started in every game for the Wildcats this season. He is averaging 6.6 points and 6.2 rebounds per contest and is shooting 54 percent from the field.
- Senior Will Archambault is 79 points away from becoming the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.1 points per game, the 19th best mark in the league.
- The Wildcats face Wofford in Spartanburg, S.C., Saturday evening.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman has relied on the tandem of Amu Saaka and Jordan Miller for much of its scoring. Saaka is fifth in the league with 16.8 points per game, while Miller is averaging 15.3 points per contest. Either Miller or Saaka has been Furman's leading scorer in 15 of 16 games this year.
- The Paladins posted a 6-5 record in non-conference play this season to finish above .500 during the non-league slate for the first time since 2006-07. Furman won its last two non-conference games to rise above .500 against non-conference opponents.
- Furman hosts Georgia Southern Saturday afternoon.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Georgia Southern will retire Chester Webb's No. 22 jersey on January 30. A two-time All-American, NBA draft pick and the leading scorer and rebounder in the history of the program, Webb played from 1952-56.
- Georgia Southern is second in the league with 9.2 steals per game. The Eagles recorded 10 thefts Thursday night at Wofford. Junior Johntavious Rucker leads the league with 2.4 steals per game while teammates Ben Drayton III and Willie Powers average 1.4 and 1.3 steals per game, respectively. All three Eagles rank in the top 12 of the league for steals per game.
- Georgia Southern takes on Furman Saturday afternoon then returns home to host Appalachian State Wednesday night.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Ten different players have scored in double figures this season for Wofford. Junior Noah Dahlman leads the team with double-figure scoring performances in all 18 games this season. Dahlman has an active streak of 31 consecutive games in double-figures.
- Head Coach Mike Young reached the 100-win plateau with Saturday's victory over Elon. Young is the fifth coach in Wofford history to reach 100 wins.
- The Terriers will face Davidson Saturday evening at the Ben Johnson Arena. Both teams are 3-2 in the South Division.

CONFERENCE NOTES

ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Wagering led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

ALL-DECADE RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released it's All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
