FAMFORD

Samford

- Carley Kuhns begins her first season as the Bulldogs' leader. Kuhns spent the last 3 years as the head coach at Valdosta State. Mike Morris, who coached Samford for 17 seasons, stepped down after last season.
- The Bulldogs return four starters and their top four scorers from last season and are picked 7th in the preseason poll by both the coaches and media.



Western Carolina

- Kiley Hill takes over the reigns of the Catamount program.
- Western Carolina was picked eighth by both the coaches and media in the preseason poll.

Furman

Head CoachJackie Carson 2018-19 Record19-14 (9-5 SoCon) 2018-19 Regular-Season Finish2nd Starters Returning/Lost4/1

- Head coach Jackie Carson enters her 10th year at the helm of her alma mater.
- The Paladins return four starters from a team that finished 9-5 in conference play, falling to top-seed Mercer 66-63 in the SoCon championship.. Senior Le'Jzae Davidson and junior Celena Taborn were preseason all-conference selections.



UNCG

Head CoachTrina Patterson 2018-19 Record11-19 (5-9 SoCon) 2018-19 Regular-Season Finish ..T-6th Starters Returning/Lost5/0

- Head coach Trina Patterson enters her fourth year at UNCG after leading the Spartans to an 11-19 record in 2018-19.
- Preseason all-conference selection Nadine Soliman returns for the Spartans after averaging a conference-high 19.1 points a year ago. Teammate Te'ja Twitty joins her on the preseason all-conference team.



Chattanooga

Head CoachKatie Burrows 2018-19 Record14-17 (8-6 SoCon) 2018-19 Regular-Season Finish ..T-3rd Starters Returning/Lost2/3

- Katie Burrows, a Chattanooga alum, enters her second season after leading her squad to a 14-17 record and 8-6 mark in SoCon play. The Mocs advanced to the SoCon semifinals.
- The Mocs return two starters, including senior guard Lakelyn Bouldin who led the team with 13 points last seaosn. She was named to the preseason all-conference team alongside teammate Eboni Williams.



Wofford

Head CoachJimmy Garrity 2018-19 Record16-15 (7-7 SoCon) 2018-19 Regular-Season Finish5th Starters Returning/Lost4/1

- Wofford was picked second by the coaches in the preseason poll after posting a 7-7 SoCon mark last season
- Senior guard Chloe Wanink was tabbed the preseason POTY and one of 20 named to the Lieberman Award Watch List. Teammate Da'Ja Green was also a preseason all-conference selection.

NOTES AND PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- ETSU (3-9) has bested its non-conference win total from the 2018-19 season. Last season ETSU went 2-14 against out-of-conference opponents.
- •The Bucs were dealt a serious blow when star quard Erica Haynes-Overton was injured against North Carolina A&T. The injury to Haynes-Overton, a knee impingement, is expected to keep her sidelined with no definite timetable having been given for her return.
- ETSU's 67-60 win over ACC opponent Wake Forest was ETSU's first win over a Power 5 opponent since 2008-09 when the Bucs upset Kentucky 59-50 on the road. • ETSU continues to press opponents defenses, netting 33 more free throws this week in 50 attempts. The Bucs have been on the front foot all year, and have now made 194 free throws this year in 287 attempts, leading the nation in attempts while ranking second in makes.
 • ETSU leads the Southern Conference in blocked shots and ranks 21st nationally, while Tijuana Kimbro remains in the top 20 nationally amongst individuals this
- Friday's game against South Alabama will be head coach Brittney Ezell's 200th as the leader of the Bucs.

- Furman had three players score in double figures on December 15 at Georgia in Le'Jzae Davidson (12), Tierra Hodges (10) and Celena Taborn (10).
 The Paladins close out their season-long four-game road trip this weekend, December 20-21, facing Florida Atlantic and either Harvard or Saint Joseph's at the FAU Holiday Classic in Boca Raton, Fla.

- Mercer has 11 freshmen and sophomores on the roster, tied with Winthrop for the most in the country.

- Sophomore Jaron Dougherty collected her third 20-point performance of the season and second in-a-row with 22 points against the Tigers.
 Mercer remains one of the top teams in the nation in terms of steals, ranking 23rd in total steals (111) and 37th in steals per game (11.1).
 Junior Shannon Titus has been a catalyst for the Bears this season, leading the team in scoring (14.3 ppg), steals (2.7 spg) and rebounding (7.4 rpg) while being tied with Dougherty in blocks (1.3 bpg).
- Susie Gardner has coached 297 games at Mercer and will coach her 300th on Sunday, Dec. 22 against Jacksonville.

- UNCG's win over Wake Forest was the Spartans' first victory over the Demon-Deacons since 2005.
- Te'ja Twitty became the 26th person in program history to surpass 1,000 career points after scoring 14 points against Coastal Carolina.
- Head coach Trina Patterson coached her 100th game as the leader of the Spartans on Sunday, Nov. 17 against Maryland Eastern Shore. The Spartans won 86-48.
- Nadine Soliman is 138 points away from UNCG's all-time scoring mark (1,907).

Samford

- Carley Kuhns got her first win as the Samford leader with an 81-60 win over Montevallo to open the season. On Nov. 17, she coached her 100th career game at No. 12 Florida State.
- Maryland transfer Sarah Myers has had an immediate impact on the team so far. She leads the team in both scoring (13.7 ppg.) and rebounding (6.4 rpg.).
- Charity Brown, the active leader in career assists, has 399 and needs just one to surpass 400.
- Samford played its final home non-conference game of the season against Western Kentucky on Dec. 15. The Bulldogs play at Murray State on Friday, Dec 20, beginning a five-game road swing, before heading to New York to play two games in the Fordham Holiday Classic. Samford begins the conference slate Jan. 9 at Wofford.

Chattanooga

- Lakelyn Bouldin has 1,23 career points and continues to move up on the all-time scoring list, breaking in to the top 20 last week.
 Chattanooga plays at No. 9 NC State on Thursday, the second ranked opponent the Mocs face this season. Louisville was also No. 8/9 when the Mocs came to town on Nov. 21. The Cardinals won the contest 86-37.

Western Carolina

- Jewel Smalls was the SoCon Player of the Month for November after being named the Player of the Week twice in the span.
- Smalls extended her double-digit scoring streak to eight-straight games and 10 out of the 11 games this season.
 After not playing since Dec. 6, Smalls now sits in second in total rebounds for the season (133), four behind Denver's Madison Nelson.
 The Catamounts halted an eight-game losing streak with a win over Charleston Southern.

- Chloe Wanink leads the Terriers, averaging 17.5 points per game, second in the league behind UNCG's Nadine Soliman.
- Terriers' head coach Jimmy Garrity coached his 100th game at Wofford in a 70-57 loss to Georgia Southern on Dec. 1.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UNC Greensboro's Nadine Soliman Senior guard

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – UNC Greensboro's Nadine Soliman has been named the Southern Conference women's basketball player of the week presented by GEICO for games played Dec. 10-16 after nearly averaging a double-double in a pair of contests. The award is selected by the league office.

The guard began the week by scoring a team-high 13 points and pulling down 11 rebounds in a 57-48 loss at crosstown rival North Carolina A&T on Dec. 12. The native of Cairo, Egypt, then scored a game-high 18 points and added eight rebounds in a 69-56 win at College of Charleston on Dec. 16. She shot 50 percent against the Cougars, finishing 7-for-14 from the floor, including 3-for-7 from beyond the 3-point arc. She added four assists and a block in the win that propelled the Spartans to the top of the conference standings (7-4).

Soliman, who earns her second weekly honor of the season, leads the league in scoring, averaging 19.1 points per game, and is third in the league in rebounding, averaging 7.7 boards per contest. The preseason all-conference selection also leads the league in 3-point field-goal percentage (46.4 percent).

UNCG hosts High Point on Saturday, Dec. 21, in the Spartans' lone contest of the week.

Also nominated: Micah Scheetz (ETSU), Le'Jzae Davidson (Furman), Shannon Titus (Mercer) and Sarah Myers (Samford).
