POLL POSITION: Appalachian State is ranked No. 1 in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll. The Mountaineers hold the No. 1 ranking in the coaches poll for the seventh consecutive week.

- Wofford is ranked No. 10 by the FCS coaches and No. 9 according to the Sports Network.
- Chattanooga is ranked No. 20 in the Sports Network poll. The Mocs are ranked 23rd according to the FCS Coaches Poll. It is the first time the Mocs have been ranked since November 3, 1997 (#23).

ELITE COMPANY: Elon quarterback Scott Riddle has led the conference in passing yards each of the past three seasons. If Riddle leads the SoCon again in 2010, he will become the first player in league history to lead the conference in passing yards for four consecutive seasons. Marshall's Michael Payton (1990-92) is the only other player to lead the conference in passing three straight years.

- Samford's Chris Evans has led the league in rushing the past two years. He has a chance to join Furman's Stanford Jennings (1981-83) and VMI's Thomas Haskins (1994-96) as the only players in SoCon history to lead the league in rushing three straight seasons.

PASSING FANCY: Elon's Scott Riddle became the Southern Conference's all-time leading passer with 244 yards through the air against Shaw University on September 11. Riddle now has 12,241 career passing yards, surpassing Armanti Edwards' (Appalachian State 2006-2009) career mark of 10,392. It is one of five major career passing marks the senior signal caller owns.

HELMET DECAL: Throughout the 2010 season, Southern Conference football teams will show their support for those being negatively impacted along the Gulf Coast by wearing helmet decals with the initials GC.



More than 160 SoCon football players come from states that share a coastline being affected by the oil spill. The nine institutions that play SoCon football agreed to display the decals to express their support and encouragement for the people living in the region.

Use of the decal was approved by the NCAA's rules committee and supervisory officiating organization upon request by the conference.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 952, eight points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the second consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

ATHLETES OF THE MONTH: The Southern Conference announced its September athletes of the month, highlighting excellence among student-athletes throughout the league. The athletes of the month are nominated by each member institution and selected by the conference office.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: Elon led the conference in total defense last season, yielding just 248.3 yards per game. It was the eighth straight season that a different school led the conference in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense at least once, dating back to 2002.

- Wofford and Georgia Southern currently boast the top defensive units in the league as the Terriers and Eagles rank No. 16 in the nation in total defense. They have held their opponents to 294 total yards per game.
- Georgia Southern boasts the top scoring defense as the Eagles have held their opponents to just 18.7 points per game.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 300 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 196 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (104) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (66 victories) has moved into a tie for eighth place.

FAMILIAR FACES: Wofford returned a league-high 20 starters for the 2010 season. The Terriers boast nine returning starters on both offense and defense. The Citadel's offense and Western Carolina's defense returned the fewest amount of starters (5) of any offensive or defensive unit in the league.

- The league's nine teams combined to return 66 percent of their starters (148 of 225) from 2009.

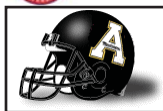
