• For the third time in four weeks, four teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman moved to No. 9 with Appalachian State jumping four spots to No. 22. Western Carolina is ranked No. 18 and Wofford holds the No. 22 spot. Georgia Southern is also receiving votes.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has four SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman has moved up three slots to No. 6 with Western Carolina jumping to No. 17. Appalachian State slid up two spots to No. 22 and Wofford checks in at No. 21. Georgia Southern is also receiving votes.

• Furman set a school record for most plays in a game with its 102 in a 44-41 double overtime win over No. 17 Hofstra.

• Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin moved into third on the SoCon's all-time list for games with 100-plus yards rushing. Austin has 26 in his career, two behind Furman's Louis Ivory. GSU's Adrian Peterson holds the record with 40.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (3-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Appalachian State opened up league play with a 45-13 win at The Citadel...The Mountaineers racked up 423 yards of offense and limited the Bulldogs to 219...QB **Richie Williams** recorded 353 yards of total offense, passing for 259 and running for another 94...Williams also passed for three touchdowns to up his career total to 44, eighth on the SoCon charts...He needs three TD passes to move into second place on the school charts and 213 passing yards to become the third Mountaineer to pass for 6,000 yards in a career...**Marques Murrell** returned a fumble recovery 89 yards for a touchdown, the second longest fumble return in SoCon history...Murrell also added two sacks and three tackles for a loss...DB **Corey Lynch** intercepted his league-leading fifth pass, returning it for 39 yards...It was also his 12th career INT, one shy of moving him into 11th place in league history...ASU is open this week and next plays at Furman on Oct. 8.

The Citadel (1-2, 0-1 SoCon)

The Bulldogs dropped a 45-13 conference-opening game to Appalachian State at home, the 11th loss in the last 12 meetings with the Mountaineers...WR **Ta'Mar Jernigan** caught a career-high six passes for 49 yards and added his second touchdown of the season...QB **Duran Lawson** completed 60 percent of his passes (18-of-30) for 150 yards but was sacked a season-high six times...The Citadel heads to Western Carolina for a conference tilt on Saturday.

Chattanooga (2-2, 0-1 SoCon)

The Mocs dropped their conference opener, 48-10, at Georgia Southern...It marked the ninth straight year that Chattanooga has lost in its conference opener, all at the hands of the Eagles...Sophomore RB **Lironnie Davis** rushed for a career-high 117 yards on 13 carries, his first career 100-yard game...Davis scored his second touchdown of the season on a career-best 45-yard run...WR/KR **Emanuel Hassell** produced 208 all-purpose yards, 133 yards on nine catches and 75 from six kick returns...UTC recorded a season-high 438 yards of offense, including 222 yards in the air...LB **Larry White** had a game-high 12 tackles, the second double digit tackle outing in his last three games, while DT **Cori Stukes** had a career-high nine stops, including 1.5 tackles for a loss...Chattanooga hosts Wofford on Saturday in its Homecoming game.

Elon (3-1, 0-0 SoCon)

The Phoenix completed non-conference play with a 3-1 record following a 12-9 win over North Carolina A&T...RB **Reggie Hall** rushed for a career-high 180 yards and a touchdown on 32 carries...The win over the Aggies was the team's first in five seasons...K **Andrew Wilcox** hit on field goals of 41 and 30 yards, giving him a league-high seven FG on the season...LB **Chad Nkang** led all defenders, amassing a season-high 15 tackles...He also tallied three stops for loss, one pass break-up, one sack and one quarterback hurry...Elon is the last conference team to play a league game...Saturday it hosts Georgia Southern.

Furman (3-1, 0-1 SoCon)

The Paladins needed double overtime to knock off No. 17 Hofstra, 44-41...The win improved the team's overtime record to 2-5...The two teams combined for 869 yards of offense, with Furman holding a 488-381 advantage on a school-record 102 plays...RBs **Jerome Felton** and **Daric Carter** rushed for 109 and 97 yards, respectively, part of a 312-yard output on the ground for the Paladins...QB **Ingle Martin** was 22-for-34 with three TDs and 176 yards...He also punted four times for an average of 48.5 yards a kick and dropped three of them inside the 20 yard line...Eight different receivers caught a ball from Martin, led by six catches from **John Rust** (49 yards and one TD) and **Daric Carter** (33 yds)...LBs **Andrew Jones** and **William Freeman** led the defensive attack with 12 and nine tackles, respectively, with Freeman also adding a pair of pass breakups...Furman steps out of SoCon play for the final time of the regular season, hosting Gardner-Webb on Saturday, Oct. 1.

Georgia Southern (2-2, 1-1 SoCon)

The Eagles rushed for a season-high 493 yards in the 48-10 win over Chattanooga...**Jayson Foster** scored three times and rushed for 134 yards while **Jermaine Austin** added 127 yards and a TD...Three of Darius Smiley's carries went for scores...Foster topped the 100-yard mark for the fourth game this season, while Austin registered his 26th career 100-yard game, the third most in league history...LB **John Mohring** led the GSU defensive unit with five solo tackled and also recorded his second career interception...The Eagles travel to Elon on Saturday, Oct. 1, where they lead the all-time series 5-0.

Western Carolina (2-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Western Carolina had its game at Nicholls State on Saturday canceled because of Hurricane Rita...It marked the third time since 1989 that the Catamounts have had a game affected by a hurricane, leaving WCU with only nine regular season games...QB **Justin Clark** was 19-for-39 for 201 yards and completed passes to 10 different receivers in a 7-3 loss to Cincinnati on Sept. 17...RB **Darius Fudge**, who had 66 yards against Cincinnati, is 185 yards shy of reaching 1,000 yards for his career...WCU hosts The Citadel on Saturday, Oct. 1.

Wofford (2-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Wofford was idle last week and hits the road to face Chattanooga on Saturday...The Terriers piled up 354 rushing yards in their 21-17 win over Georgia Southern on Sept. 17, led by 114 yards from **Michael Hobbs**...Hobbs scored two touchdowns, the first of his career, while six of his 26 carries resulted in first downs...QB **Josh Collier** rushed for a career-high 91 yards and a TD, while **Corey Dunn** and **Brandon Berry** combined for another 86 yards...NT **Katon Bethay** recorded a career-high 11 tackles, six solo and five assisted stops...Wofford returns home on Oct. 8 to host Elon, the first of three straight home games.

Players of the Week

Richie Williams, Appalachian State Sr., QB, 6-3, 190-lb., Camden, SC

A 6-3, 190-lb. quarterback from Camden, SC, Williams led the Mountaineers to a 45-13 win over The Citadel on Saturday. The senior completed 20-of-27 passes for 259 yards with three touchdowns and rushed for 94 yards, all season highs. He spread his 20 completions among six receivers and avoided an interception for the fourth-straight game. His last interception came in the first quarter against Western Carolina in the 2004 season finale. Williams' three-touchdown performance was the seventh of his career, while his 353 yards of total offense marked the eighth time he has topped 300 yards in a game.

Marques Murrell, Appalachian State DE, Jr., 6-2, 230-lb., Fayetteville, NC

Murrell, a 6-2, 230-lb. defensive end from Fayetteville, NC, anchored the defense in the Mountaineers' 45-13 win over The Citadel. The junior racked up three tackles for loss, two sacks, one forced fumble and an 89-yard fumble return for a touchdown in the win. Murrell's forced fumble in the first quarter set up ASU's first touchdown of the game. Murrell leads the SoCon and is nationally ranked this season averaging 5.5 sacks, nine tackles for loss and three forced fumbles.

Joel Bell, Furman Fr., OT, 6-7, 305-lb., Spartanburg, SC

A 6-7, 305-lb. offensive tackle from Spartanburg, SC, Bell made his first career start for the Paladins, filling in at the last minute for starter John Kivett. He registered 90 plays and graded out at 81 percent with 12 knockdowns in helping Furman to a 44-41 double overtime win over No. 17 Hofstra. He assisted Furman in posting a record 102 plays and 448 yards of total offense, including 312 yards rushing. His previous experience included 16 plays over the first three games this season.

Gardner-Webb (2-1) at #7/#6 Furman (3-1), 2:00
Paladin Stadium (16,000) • Greenville, SC



THE GAME: This will be the third meeting between the two schools, with Furman leading the all-time series 2-0. The Paladins won last year's meeting 38-6 in Boiling Springs, NC, behind 319 rushing yards by Furman and three touchdown passes from Ingle Martin...Furman is coming off a 44-41 double overtime win over No. 17 Hofstra, while Gardner-Webb dropped a 31-28 decision to Tennessee-Martin...The win for the Paladins improved their overtime record to 2-5 and lifted the SoCon's mark this year to 3-0...QB Ingle Martin threw three touchdown passes last week to become the fifth Furman quarterback to pass for 30 TDs in his career...Furman has won its last seven regular season games at home and eight of its last nine overall at Paladin Stadium.

THE COACHES: Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 27-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program and is 2-0 vs. GWU...Steve Patton (Furman, '77) is in his ninth season with GWU and has a 58-32 mark...In 14 years as a collegiate coach, Patton is 88-55-1.



Georgia Southern (2-2, 1-1 SoCon) at Elon (3-1, 0-0 SoCon), 2:00
Rhodes Stadium (11,250) • Elon, NC



THE GAME: Georgia Southern is 5-0 all-time against Elon...The Eagles won last year's game 48-14 in Statesboro...The Phoenix are the last SoCon school to play a conference game...Elon is coming off a 12-9 win over North Carolina A&T, while GSU evened its record with a 48-10 win over Chattanooga...GSU's Jermaine Austin has 4,407 career rushing yards and needs three yards to move into fifth place in SoCon history...With his 127 yards against UTC, Austin registered his 26th career 100-yards game, the third most in league annals...Elon RB Reggie Hall rushed for a career-high 180 yards on Saturday against NC A&T, the second most by a SoCon player this year...PK Andrew Wilcox is 7-for-9 in field goal attempts, including a long of 41 yards this past Saturday.

THE COACHES: Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-9 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-50 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 1-7 all-time vs. GSU, 0-1 at Elon...Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 29-12 in four years as head coach of the Georgia Southern program and is 3-0 vs. Elon...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 91-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000.

THE GAME: Chattanooga and Wofford will meet for the 12th time on Saturday, with the Mocs holding a slim 6-5 lead in the all-time series...The Terriers have won the last three meetings, including a 56-21 win in Spartanburg a year ago...Wofford was idle last week and moved back into the national rankings following a 21-17 win over Georgia Southern on Sept. 17...Terrier RB Michael Hobbs had 114 yards in the win over GSU, part of a 354 yard ground attack...Chattanooga dropped a 48-10 decision to Georgia Southern last week in the team's conference opener, giving up 493 yards on the ground...RB Lironnie Davis had his first career 100-yard game, rushing for 117 yards on 13 carries...WR Emanuel Hassell had nine receptions for 133 yards, one of seven different receivers who caught a pass from Antonio Miller (14-of-27 for 176 yards).

THE COACHES: Rodney Allison (Texas Tech '80) is 7-20 in his third season as Mocs head coach...Allison came to Chattanooga from Clemson where he was the defensive ends coach from 1999-2002...Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is in his 18th season at Wofford in 2005...Ayers is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 112-81-1 in his 17 years at the helm...The three-time Southern Conference Coach of the Year (2000, 2002 and 2003) led Wofford to its first ever SoCon football crown in 2003...Allison is 0-2 lifetime against Wofford, while Ayers is 7-4 against the Mocs, 5-3 as Terriers head coach.



The Citadel (1-2, 0-1 SoCon) at #18/#19 Western Carolina (2-1, 1-0 SoCon), 6:00

THE GAME: This is the 29th meeting between the two schools in a series that dates back to 1972...The Citadel leads the all-time series, 15-13-1, and won last year's game in Charleston, 17-0...The Bulldogs, who are coming off a 45-13 loss to Appalachian State, travel to Cullowhee, where they haven't won since 1992 (lost six straight)...The Catamounts were off last week after having its game at Nicholls State canceled due to Hurricane Rita...WCU played two weeks ago against Cincinnati and lost, 7-3...After Saturday's game, WCU is not at home again until Oct. 29 against Elon.

THE COACHES: Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is in his fourth season as coach of his alma mater ...Briggs has tabulated a 16-21 record in his three seasons at the helm of the Cats...Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 1-2... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...He comes to The Citadel from the Detroit Lions, where he was most recently the wide receivers coach.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Oct. 1, 1977: Furman scored a touchdown on a one-yard run by Kent Woerner in the fourth quarter to tie Western Carolina 24-24; the score would remain that way as the teams left Paladin Stadium in a deadlock.

Oct. 1, 1977: The Citadel once again resorted to scoring all of its points in the second quarter for the third time in their first four games of 1977, posting 13 on touchdown runs by Lonnie Ford and Tim Gaines in a 13-7 win over Presbyterian.

Oct. 1, 1977: Chattanooga's Gwain Durden accounted for 118 of the Mocs 318 total net rushing yards in UTC's 38-7 dismantling of the Middle Tennessee State University Blue Raiders.

Oct. 1, 1977: After Marshall's Ray Crisp fumbled the kickoff, Appalachian State took advantage, scoring two plays later to give the Mountaineers an early lead that they would really never relinquish, leaving their home confines of Conrad Stadium with a 28-20 victory and, more importantly, spoiling Marshall's first venture into Southern Conference play.

Oct. 1, 1983: Alonzo Upshur brought in four catches for 142 yards in the Mountaineers' 27-11 win over East Tennessee State as Appalachian State handed the Bucs their second straight SoCon loss.

Oct. 1, 1983: Western Carolina opened the second half with a slim 14-13 edge over Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, Tenn., but exploded out of the gates in the half by scoring three touchdowns in the first six minutes of the second half in their 42-10 win.

Oct. 1, 1983: Playing at the Liberty Bowl in Memphis, TN, the University of Tennessee Volunteers used a 23-point second quarter to defeat The Citadel Bulldogs, 45-6. Greg Davis booted two field goals to account for all the Bulldogs offense in the first meeting between the two institutions since 1939.

Oct. 1, 1994: Western Carolina scored 28 unanswered points in the last 21 minutes of their 35-24 win over Furman to erase a 24-7 Paladin advantage and improve to 2-0 in Southern Conference play to start 1994.

Oct. 1, 1994: Georgia Southern redshirt freshman quarterback Kerry Robinson rushed for a career-best 74 yards and two touchdowns in the Eagles' 49-0 win over VMI.

Oct. 1, 1994: The Citadel rolled up 539 total yards, including 445 on the ground, in their 48-20 win over NCAA Division II Newberry at Johnson Hagood Stadium. John Burton had the individual game-high for The Citadel, rushing for 127 yards and a touchdown in the win over the Indians.

Oct. 1, 1994: Appalachian State won their first road game in 1994 on the back of quarterback Andy Arnold, who rushed for two scores and threw for another in the Mountaineers' 30-13 win over ETSU.
