Quick Hits

- Eight league teams are in action Saturday, September 28. Wofford is the lone conference team that is idle.
- Three SoCon games highlight Saturday's slate with Western Carolina visiting Samford, while Georgia Southern hosts Chattanooga. The Citadel will host Furman.
- Home teams are 1-3 in conference play this season and have gone 19-17 in league games each of the last two years.
- Andy Summerlin's (SAM) 478 passing yards last week was the seventh-highest single-game total in league history.

RANKINGS: Two Southern Conference teams are ranked in at least one of the two major FCS Polls. Wofford is ranked 15th by the FCS Coaches and 17th by the Sports Network.

- Georgia Southern is ranked 15th by the Sports Network.
- Appalachian State, Samford and Chattanooga are among the teams receiving votes.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference has three candidates on the Preseason Walter Payton Award Watch List and four on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF HOME: Southern Conference teams are 6-5 at home in nonconference games this season.

- League teams went 13-2 at home in nonconference games in 2012 and were 15-1 in 2011. SoCon teams own a record of 47-11 (.810) in nonconference home games since the start of the 2010 season.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: All nine SoCon teams have led the league in total defense at least once since 2003.

- After three weeks Chattanooga owns the top overall defensive unit in the league. The Mocs have given up 321.3 yards per game through the first three weeks.

GROUND ATTACK: A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in nine of the last 12 years.

- The Citadel ranks fourth in FCS with 311 rushing yards per game.
- Georgia Southern led all of FCS with 399 yards per game on the ground in 2012.

BROKEN RECORDS: Southern Conference teams have turned in record-setting performances during the regular season in 2013:

- Savannah State at Georgia Southern - August 31
GSU's 576 rushing yards was the eighth best single-game total in SoCon history. GSU's 10 rushing TDs was tied for the second best mark in league history.
- The Citadel at Old Dominion - September 21
Ben Dupree accounted for six touchdowns which tied for the fifth-best single-game output in league history.
- Southeastern Louisiana - September 21
Andy Summerlin passed for 478 yards which was the seventh-highest single-game total in league history.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 960, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Eight Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's cross country women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field and women's tennis) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Five of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for FCS programs.

LONGTIME RIVALS: The Citadel and Furman own the longest rivalry in the Southern Conference. The 2013 meeting (Sept. 28) will be the 93rd matchup between the two schools.

- Furman leads the all-time series 57-32-3.
- The two teams have split the last six meetings, 3-3.

CONFERENCE CROWN: Appalachian State, Georgia Southern and Wofford all earned a share of the league championship in 2012 with identical 6-2 records in conference play.

- Georgia Southern won the league with a 7-1 mark in 2011 and has won at least a share of the league championship in each of the last two seasons.
- Appalachian State and Furman have won the most Southern Conference titles as each program has won or shared the league crown on 12 occasions.

CAREER MILESTONES: Appalachian State's Jamal Londry-Jackson is tied for eighth place on the league's all-time list of 300-yard passers. Londry-Jackson has thrown for 300 yards in six games as a Mountaineer.

- Elon's Scott Riddle (2007-10) leads all SoCon QBs with 23 career 300-yard passing performances.
- Samford's Kelsey Pope is tied for eighth place on the league's career list for pass receptions. Pope has 198 career catches.
- Samford's Fabian Truss ranks 8th on the league's career all-purpose yardage list with 5,373 yards. VMI's Thomas Haskins (1993-96) owns the SoCon record with 7,355 all-purpose yards.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Wofford head coach Mike Ayers enters the 2013 season as the dean of SoCon coaches. Ayers has tallied 127 wins at East Tennessee State and Wofford while coaching in the Southern Conference. He ranks third on the league's all-time wins list behind Appalachian State's Jerry Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.
