- The regular season concludes on Saturday evening, highlighted by the matchup between **Samford** and **ETSU** who each sit at 13-1 in league play with two contests to go. If ETSU can finish 15-1, it will be the second-straight season the Bucs have accomplished the feat. ETSU was the regular-season champion and No. 1 seed, but No. 2 Samford won the SoCon Championship.
- WINNING STREAKS & LEADERS: After starting off conference play with their best start since 1991, ETSU fell to Furman, 3-2, on Oct. 25 but has rebounded to win the next four and move to 13-1 in conference play, tied with Samford for the top spot. Samford holds the longest win streak (7), suffering its only conference loss to ETSU on Oct. 18. Samford's 11-1 start to league play is the program's best since starting 16-1 in 2008, the Bulldogs' first year in the league. Western Carolina has won 10 conference games for the first time since 2002.
- ETSU began the season with 16 straight road/neutral games, including the first four games in conference play. They were one of just two DI teams who didn't play at home until Oct. 11. The Bucs are 5-1 at home.
- Samford downed No. 24 Arizona 3-2 on Aug. 31, the Bulldogs' first win over a ranked opponent in program history and the conference's first and only win over a ranked opponent this season.
- OCTOBER PLAYERS OF THE MONTH: Samford right side hitter Lauren Deaton had double-digit kills in 8 of Samford's 9 matches in the month and was named the Offensive Player of the Month. Western Carolina libero Meagan Sanchez averaged 5.45 digs per set in October and repeated as Defensive Player of the Month. ETSU setter Emily Arnold averaged 10.81 assists per set on the month and was honored as the Setter of the Month.
- COACHING MILESTONES: On Oct. 26, Furman head coach Michelle Young coached her 600th career game. All have come as the leader of the Paladins. Mercer head coach Derek Schroeder surpassed 200 career wins earlier this season. UNCG head coach Corey Carlin recorded his 100th win as head coach of the Spartans in with a 3-1 win over Mercer on Oct. 19. Also on Saturday, Oct. 19, Dave Zelenock (The Citadel) coached his 200th career game and earned a 3-2 win over Chattanooga.
- INDIVIDUAL MILESTONES: The Citadel's Sharlissa DeJesus became the fourth active player with 1,000 kills. She also surpassed 100 aces in her career earlier this season. Catie Cronister recorded the first known triple-double in Wofford program history, totaling 22 kills, 12 digs and 11 assists in just four sets against Duke. A day later, she added another with 11 kills, 23 digs and 16 assists against UNCW. Western Carolina's Meagan Sanchez is 14th nationally in total digs (538) and has 150 more than anyone else in the league. She has 1,986 digs and looks to become just the third Catamount to surpass 2,000 career digs. Samford setter Corinne Meglic and Chattanooga setter Maddie Halsey each surpassed 1,000 assists earlier in the year. Samford's Kelsi Hobbs surpassed 100 career aces this season. ETSU's Lauren Hatch tied a program record with 29 kills against Chattanooga on Nov. 2. She's the first conference player to have 25+ for ETSU since Brianna Allmon had 28 at WCU on Oct. 7, 2016 and most by a conference player since Catie Cronister had 31 on Nov. 4, 2017.
- Samford's Lauren Deaton tallied a career-high 32 kills in the 3-2 win at Furman on Saturday. The total was just one shy of the school record, set by Michaela Reesor against Wofford in 2012. Three Furman players had career highs against Chattanooga. Nicole Mack and Neci Harris had career-highs of 25 and 22 kills, respectively, while Katie Murphy dished out a career-best 64 assists.
- TEAM MILESTONES: The Citadel's four conference wins tied the program record. Western Carolina is 11th nationally in total digs (1,706) and 6th in digs per set (18.15). WCU's eight league wins are the most since winning nine conference matches in 2014. Samford's 10-1 start to conference play is the best for the program since starting 10-1 in 2014.
- Samford, the 2018 SoCon Tournament Champions, are the coaches pick to win the league in 2019. The Bulldogs snagged seven first place votes and 63 points to finished 11 points ahead of Mercer, who grabbed one first place vote. Furman was picked third, just one point behind Mercer, and picked up the remaining first place vote.
- The 2018 Coach of the Year and Player of the Year both departed the league. Former ETSU head coach Lindsey Devine is now the head coach at the University of Alabama and the Bucs' outside hitter, Leah Clayton, transferred to Colorado and will redshirt this season. The Bucs, now under first-year head coach Benavia Jenkins' direction, also lost starters Mariah McPartland, Alyssa Kvarta, Braedyn Tutton and AJ Lux from the 2018 team that won the SoCon regular season title and earned the SoCon first at-large bid in NCAA volleyball history, but return two-time Libero of the Year and 2019 Preseason All-SoCon selection Marija Popovic. Jenkins is $the only new coach in the league, with \textbf{Furman's} \ Michelle \ Young, the longest serving coach in the league, entering her 20th season$ as the leader of the Paladins.
- · In addition to Popovic, the remaining members of the preseason all-conference team are an experienced bunch. The Citadel placed junior outside hitter Sharlissa De Jesus on the squad and Furman middle blocker Courtney Hoffman was a selection for the Paladins. Mercer's Brittany Major, a 2018 All-Freshman selection and Roberta Todd, who amassed nearly 300 kills a year ago, were selected to the squad. Samford senior Kelsi Hobbs and the 2018 SoCon Freshman of the Year, Lauren Deaton, were honored and Chattanooga's Dani Szczepanski was a selection from Chattanooga. Catie Cronister, the 2016 Rayna Taylor Freshman of the Year, the 2017 Co-Player of the Year, and a 2018 First Team All-SoCon selection, made the team for Wofford.
