## Quick Hits

- Six Southern Conference teams will take the field Saturday, October 19. The Citadel, Georgia Southern and Samford are idle this weekend.
- The Southern Conference has played 15 league games this season. Seven of those 15 contests have been decided by one possession.
- Home teams are 9-6 in conference play this season and have gone 19-17 in league games each of the last two years.
- Georgia Southern's Jerick McKinnon needs 507 yards to move into 10th place on the league's career rushing list.

**RANKINGS:** Three Southern Conference teams are ranked in at least one of the two major FCS Polls. Wofford is ranked 12th by the FCS Coaches and 13th by the Sports Network.

- Samford is ranked No. 22 by the Sports Network, while Georgia Southern is slotted at No. 23.
- Chattanooga is among the teams receiving votes.

**AWARD CANDIDATES:** The Southern Conference has three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List, five on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List and two on the Jerry Rice Award Watch List.

- Payton Award Finalists - Jamal Londry-Jackson (Appalachian State), Jerick McKinnon (Georgia Southern) and Fabian Truss (Samford).
- Buchanan Award Candidates - Wes Dothard (Chattanooga), Alvin Scioneaux (Wofford), Justin Shade (Samford), Davis Tull (Chattanooga) and Jaquiski Tarrt (Samford).
- Rice Award Candidates - Marcus Cox (Appalachian State) and John Law (Appalachian State).

**THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF HOME:** Southern Conference teams are 7-7 at home in nonconference games this season.

- League teams went 13-2 at home in nonconference games in 2012 and were 15-1 in 2011. SoCon teams own a record of 47-13 (.783) in nonconference home games since the start of the 2010 season.

**DEFENSIVE ROTATION:** All nine SoCon teams have led the league in total defense at least once since 2003.

- After seven weeks Chattanooga owns the top overall defensive unit in the league. The Mocs have given up 303.0 yards per game this season.

**GROUND ATTACK:** A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in nine of the last 12 years.

- The Citadel ranks sixth in FCS with 267.0 rushing yards per game.
- Georgia Southern led all of FCS with 399 yards per game on the ground in 2012.

**BROKEN RECORDS:** Southern Conference teams have turned in record-setting performances during the regular season in 2013:

- Savannah State at Georgia Southern - August 31  
 GSU's 576 rushing yards was the eighth best single-game total in SoCon history. GSU's 10 rushing TDs was tied for the second best mark in league history.
- The Citadel at Old Dominion - September 21  
 Ben Dupree accounted for six touchdowns which tied for the fifth-best single-game output in league history.
- Georgia Southern at Samford - October 5  
 Andy Summerlin passed for 495 yards which was the fifth-highest single-game total in league history.

**AWARD CANDIDATES:** The Southern Conference has three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List, five on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List and two on the Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS. The Jerry Rice Award is given to the top freshman in FCS.

**MAKING THE GRADE:** In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 960, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Eight Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's cross country women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field and women's tennis) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Five of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for FCS programs.

**CONFERENCE CROWN:** Appalachian State, Georgia Southern and Wofford all earned a share of the league championship in 2012 with identical 6-2 records in conference play.

- Georgia Southern won the league with a 7-1 mark in 2011 and has won at least a share of the league championship in each of the last two seasons.
- Appalachian State and Furman have won the most Southern Conference titles as each program has won or shared the league crown on 12 occasions.

**CAREER MILESTONES:** Appalachian State's Jamal Londry-Jackson is tied for eighth place on the league's all-time list of 300-yard passers. Londry-Jackson has thrown for 300 yards in six games as a Mountaineer.

- Elon's Scott Riddle (2007-10) leads all SoCon QBs with 23 career 300-yard passing performances.
- Samford's Kelsey Pope is tied for fifth place on the league's career list for pass receptions. Pope has 209 career catches.
- Samford's Fabian Truss ranks third on the league's career all-purpose yardage list with 6,019 yards. VMI's Thomas Haskins (1993-96) owns the SoCon record with 7,355 all-purpose yards.
- Georgia Southern's Jerick McKinnon needs 507 yards to move into 10th place on the league's career rushing list.

**EXPERIENCED COACHES:** Wofford head coach Mike Ayers is the dean of SoCon coaches. Ayers has tallied 129 wins at East Tennessee State and Wofford while coaching in the Southern Conference. He ranks third on the league's all-time wins list behind Appalachian State's Jerry Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.

**NEW SCHOOLS:** The Southern Conference announced the addition of East Tennessee State University, Mercer University and Virginia Military Institute to the league on May 30. All three schools will join the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014.

- Mercer and VMI will begin competing in football in the SoCon in 2014 while ETSU joins the league on the gridiron in the fall of 2016.
- Mercer is spending the 2013 season in the Pioneer League while VMI competes in the Big South.
