### Quick Hits

- The Southern Conference tournament kicks off Friday night. ETSU, Furman and UNCG tied for the regular season title. The Spartans earned the top seed in the group while Furman is the No. 2 seed and ETSU is seeded third.
- The Southern Conference ranks 15th in the latest RPI rankings.
- Home teams went 51-39 during league play this season.
- League teams have combined for 19 non-conference road wins this year the most since the 2007-08 season.
- Southern Conference teams are 44-13 in nonconference home games.
- Western Carolina's Larry Hunter and Wofford's Mike Young both rank among the top 15 winningest coaches in league history.

### Player of the Week

#### Francis Alonso, UNCG, So., G



UNCG's Francis Alonso has been named the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week for all games played Feb. 21-27. Alonso averaged 21.7 points in three games as the Spartans picked up wins over Mercer (72-66), VMI (73-67) and ETSU (72-66) to secure a share of the league's regular season title. UNCG ended the regular season on a seven-game winning streak.

Alonso connected on 55 percent of his field goals (16-of-29), went

11-of-17 from 3-point range (.647) and averaged 2.7 assists on the week. After scoring 25 points on the road at Mercer, he chipped in 17 in the win over VMI. The sophomore finished the regular season with a 23-point performance in the win over ETSU Monday night. UNCG is 12-0 this season when Alonso makes at least three triples.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included The Citadel's Preston Parks, ETSU's Tevin Glass, Mercer's Jordan Strawberry, Samford's Demetrius Denzel-Dyson, Chattanooga's Justin Tuoyo, Western Carolina's Marc Gosselin and Wofford's Cameron Jackson.

## Conference News and Notes

### Close Encounters

Southern Conference teams are 6-13 this season in nonconference games that have been decided by one possession or went into overtime. League teams were 14-7 last year in one-possession games and have gone 33-38 since the start of the 2013-14 season.

### One-Possession Games

Southern Conference teams have played 90 league games during the 2016-17 regular season. Sixteen games (18 percent) were decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- In 2016, the league had 21 of 90 (23 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2015, the league had 23 of 90 (26 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2014, the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2013, the league had 30 of 108 (28 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2012, the league had 32 of 108 (30 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

### Familiar Faces

Southern Conference teams returned 84 lettermen for the 2015-16 season. Eight of 10 schools boast at least eight returnees from last season. League teams averaged 8.4 returners from 2015-16.

- Conference teams return 28 starters from last year, an average of 2.8 per team. Furman, UNCG and Chattanooga each return four starters from last season.
- Six of the 10 members from the 2016 Coaches All-Southern Conference team return for 2016-17.

### Head Coaches

All 10 Southern Conference head coaches return to the bench in the league for 2016-17. The current head coaches have a combined 42 years of experience in the SoCon.

- Wofford head coach Mike Young ranks second on the league's all-time wins list. Young has tallied 247 wins with the Terriers. He was named the 2015 Coach of the Year by both the league's media and head coaches.
- Western Carolina's Larry Hunter has 180 victories at WCU and is 13th on the league's all-time wins list.

### Sudden Impact

Wofford's Fletcher Magee was named the league's Freshman of the Year by the league's coaches in 2016. Magee joined Ian Chadwick (1998) and Karl Cochran (2012) as the only Terriers to win the award.

### Defensive Presence

Chattanooga's Justin Tuoyo was named the league's Defensive Player of the Year for the second consecutive season. He is the only player to earn the award twice since it began in 2009. Z. Mason earned the nod in 2014, giving the Mocs three straight winners.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Nonconference Scheduling

Nine of the 10 SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in exempt tournaments this year. SoCon teams will take part in the Holy City Hoops Classic (The Citadel), Sanford Pentagon Showcase (ETSU), CBE Hall of Fame Classic (Furman), Savannah Invitational (Mercer), High Point Tournament (UNCG), San Diego Classic (Samford), Maui Jim Maui Invitational Mainland (Chattanooga), Global Sports Invitational (Western Carolina) and Gulf Coast Showcase (Wofford).

### Annual Leaders

Furman led the league in scoring defense as the Paladins allowed just 66.7 points per game last season.

- Wofford led the SoCon in fewest points allowed for four straight seasons (2012-15). Furman was the last team other than Wofford to lead the league in scoring defense, back in 2011.

Wofford led the league in 3-point field-goal percentage (.408). It was the highest percentage by a SoCon team since Davidson connected on 41.7 percent of its 3-pointers during the 2002-03 season.

Mercer led the SoCon in rebounding margin (+8.8). It is the highest margin in the league since College of Charleston was +9.0 in 2006.

### Postseason Performance

A Southern Conference-record six teams advanced to the postseason in 2016.

- Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tourney, where the Mocs fell to Indiana in the first round.
- UNCG and WCU both earned bids to the CBI. The Spartans knocked off Houston Baptist at home before dropping a five-point decision (72-67) at Ohio. Western Carolina was eliminated in the first round at Vermont.
- Furman and Mercer were accepted to the CollegelInsider.com Tournament. The Paladins held off Louisiana-Monroe in their first game before falling to Louisiana. Mercer dropped its first game of the tournament at Coastal Carolina.
- ETSU advanced to the semifinals of the inaugural Vegas 16 tournament. After topping Louisiana Tech, the Bucs fell to Oakland University.

### Preseason Honors

Chattanooga was picked to win the 2016-17 Southern Conference championship in pre-season balloting conducted by the league's head coaches. The Mocs return four starters and seven lettermen from last season's team that went 29-6.

- ETSU was picked second and earned two first-place votes, while Wofford was tabbed third.
- Chattanooga's Tre' McLean was named the league's preseason Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-conference team by teammates Casey Jones and Justin Tuoyo. Seven of the league's 10 teams had at least one player on the preseason all-conference team.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA, in May 2016, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 961. It was the eighth consecutive year that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate.

### Conference Tournament

The 2017 Southern Conference Tournament presented by General Shale will be held March 3-6 in Asheville, N.C., at the U.S. Cellular Center. This year's tournament final will be Monday, March 6, at 7:00 p.m. The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the SoCon tournament was first held in 1921, and 2017 marks the 97th year of the postseason classic.
