PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stephen McDowell Chattanooga

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Chattanooga's Stephen McDowell has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games December 23-January 5 the league office announced Tuesday (Jan. 6). McDowell helped Chattanooga post a 2-1 mark over the holidays. He averaged 25.7 points and shot over 54 percent from the field in three games. He also connected on 20 of 33 three-point attempts as Chattanooga defeated Tennessee-Wesleyan (102-70) and Niagara (99-84) before falling to Georgia Southern (78-74).

McDowell has made at least one three pointer in each of his last 34 games, the fourth longest streak in the nation. McDowell scored a career-high 38 points in Chattanooga's win over Niagara and added 14 rebounds, six assists and six steals over the three games. He is second in the league in scoring (20.5) and three-point field goal percentage (.472). McDowell leads the conference with 4.6 made three pointers per game and is sixth in free throw percentage (.839).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Against Milligan, ASU set a new Holmes Center scoring mark with 112 points. No player scored more than 17 points or played more than 23 minutes for the Mountaineers, as the team cruised to a school-record 65-point victory.
- ASU has started 2-0 in conference play for the second time in three years. The Mountaineers began the 2006-07 season 4-0 in league play, en route to a 15-3 mark. It is the third time they have started the league schedule 2-0 under Houston Fancher.
- The Mountaineers host Elon (Jan. 8) and UNC Greensboro (Jan. 10) in league play this week.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Stephen McDowell has the fourth longest active streak with 34 of at least one made three pointer. McDowell has moved up to third-place all-time in three pointers made at UTC with 168 for his career. He has made three or more in eight straight games.
- Nicchaeus Doaks (1,108 pts) is just five points shy of moving into tenth place on the Chattanooga scoring list for Division I players behind former SoCon Player of the Year Derrick Kirce (1990-91) at 1,113.
- Chattanooga hosts Wofford (Jan. 8) and Furman (Jan. 10) in league play this week.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 25th in program history with 1,061 points. He is fourth among active scoring leaders in the league and is one of just four current SoCon players to have at least 1,000 points.
- Ola Atoyebi recorded his second double-double of the season with a 14-point, 10-rebound performance against Navy. Atoyebi now has five career double-doubles.
- The Phoenix visit Appalachian State and Western Carolina this week.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Mikko Koivisto's streak of consecutive games with a three-pointer ended at 33 straight against Akron. The native of Vantaa, Finland had the third-longest active streak in the nation at the time. It was also the second longest in school history behind Scott Hartzell's 42 straight.
- UNCG finishes a stretch where it plays six of seven games away from home this weekend. The Spartans play at home just one time – New Year's Eve – in a six-week span.
- The Spartans visit North Division foes Western Carolina and Appalachian State this week.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- In their four games at home this season, the Bulldogs have compiled an impressive 51.4 shooting percentage from the field and a 43.2 mark from beyond the arc. Conversely, Samford is only shooting 38.1 percent from the field in road games, including just 30.9 percent from three-point range.
- Samford is the fifth-ranked team in the nation in fewest personal fouls per game. The Bulldogs are only averaging 13.9 fouls per contest and have only allowed opponents to shoot a total of 146 free throws.
- Samford welcomes Furman (Jan. 8) and Wofford (Jan. 10) to Birmingham this week.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina is third in the conference in rebounding with 39.4 boards per game. The Catamounts lead the league with 15.5 offensive rebounds per contest.
- WCU leads the league with 10.5 steals per game. Harouna Mutombo is second in the league with 2.5 steals per game, while Brigham Waginger is third (2.4 spg).
- Western Carolina hosts UNC Greensboro (Jan. 8) and Elon (Jan. 10) this week.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- College of Charleston is off to a 10-2 start this season, including a 5-0 mark on the road. It is the first time the Cougars have won their first five games away from home since the 2001-02 season when CofC won its first six games on the road.
- College of Charleston has utilized a dynamic offense through the early portion of the season. CofC leads the conference in field goal percentage (.488) and three-point percentage (.373). The Cougars are second in the league with a +8.4 scoring margin.
- The Cougars return to the court on January 7 when they visit top-ranked North Carolina.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With 21 points against Samford Saturday, Stephen Curry became the third player in Davidson history to score 2,000 career points. He is the only active SoCon player to top the 2,000-point plateau.
- Davidson coach Bob McKillop got his 350th career win when Davidson defeated Samford last Saturday. McKillop has won 313 games while coaching in the Southern Conference
- Davidson visits Duke Wednesday night before visiting The Citadel Saturday (Jan. 10).

FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Justin Dehm scored a team-high 13 points against Western Carolina on January 3. Dehm has scored in double figures in four of Furman's last six games. He is third on the team with 9.0 points per game.
- Guard Noah States came off the bench and finished with 14 points in Furman's 68-64 win over Berry College Monday night. It was the third time this season he scored in double figures and nearly equalled his career high of 16 points set last season against UNC Greensboro.
- Furman visits Samford Thursday before travelling to face Chattanooga Saturday evening.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Senior Julian Allen leads the team and is 12th in the conference with 6.7 rebounds per game. Allen tallied a career-high 12 rebounds in GSU's victory over Chattanooga on January 3.
- Junior Antonio Hanson is fourth in the league in made three pointers per game (2.8 3fg). Hanson has made at least five triples in four of GSU's 10 games this season. The Eagles average 7.1 triples per game.
- Georgia Southern hits the road to face The Citadel (Jan. 8) and College of Charleston (Jan. 10) this week.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs earned their sixth victory of the season on January 3 with a 58-57 win over Bethune-Cookman. The victory tied The Citadel's win total from last season.
- Sophomore Cameron Wells has distinguished himself as a multi-dimensional player for the Bulldogs. Wells is eighth in the SoCon in scoring (14.5 ppg) and also ranks 10th in assists (2.8 apg). Wells also ranks second in the conference in minutes played (33.6 mpg).
- The Citadel hosts Georgia Southern and Davidson this week.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman scored 18 points at South Carolina January 5. Dahlman has now scored in double figures in each of his last nine games. He posted a season-high 22 points against Appalachian State and at Navy.
- The Terriers have connected on over 73 percent of their free throw attempts, the highest mark in the conference. Wofford also ranks third in three point field goal percentage, as the Terriers have connected on 36 percent of their attempts from beyond the arc.
- Wofford travels to Chattanooga Thursday night before visiting Samford on Saturday.

CONFERENCE NOTES

RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks tenth in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released January 4. The league has garnered the second toughest strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Three of the league's teams (Davidson, 24; College of Charleston, 110; Wofford, 115) rank in the top 125.

STREAKING

Davidson owns a 33-game conference winning streak after defeating Samford, 76-55, on January 3. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams are scheduled to take on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams will participate in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

BRACKETBUSTERS 2009

Four Southern Conference teams will take part in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters event February 20-21. The event will feature 13 nationally televised games - on either ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - selected from a pool of 102 teams.

- Davidson and Georgia Southern have been designated as home teams during the event, while Appalachian State and Elon will take to the road. The matchups for the 13 nationally televised games will be announced Feb. 2.

CONFERENCE NOTES

TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

HALL OF FAME

Southern Conference Commissioner John Iamarino announced the formation of the SoCon Hall of Fame for 2009. The league will induct its inaugural class during a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 9. The Southern Conference is in its 88th season of intercollegiate competition and will begin recognizing many prominent student-athletes, coaches and administrators from the 43 current and former institutions that have been a part of the league's distinguished history.

- Among the nominees for consideration from Southern Conference men's basketball are Dick Groat (Duke), "Hot" Rod Hundley (West Virginia), Frank Selvy (Furman) and Jerry West (West Virginia).

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 league schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
