Davidson's Stephen Curry Named SoCon Player of the Week

Davidson guard **Stephen Curry** was named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for the week ending February 18.

He continued his torrid play and has won or shared Player of the Week honors each of the last four weeks and total of five times this season.

Curry, who ranks fourth nationally in scoring (25.6 ppg), averaged 33.5 points in two games last week. In addition, the sophomore shot 52.4 percent (22-of-42) from the field, 9-of-20 (45.0 percent) from three-point range and was a perfect 14-of-14 from the free throw line.

The Charlotte, N.C., native helped lead Davidson to victories over UNC Greensboro (83-78 on Feb. 13) and Furman (86-51 on Feb. 16). The Wildcats have won 15 consecutive games and 27 straight league contests dating back to last season.

Other standout performances were turned in by Georgia Southern's Louis Graham, The Citadel's Austin Dahn, College of Charleston's Andrew Goudeloc, Appalachian State's Donte Minter, Western Carolina's Brandon Giles, Elon's Montell Watson, Chattanooga's Nichaeus Doaks, Wofford's Noah Dahlman and UNC Greensboro's Kyle Hines.

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



- Losing games at Elon and UNC Greensboro last week marked the first time the Mountaineers have lost back-to-back conference contests since Feb 2 and 7, 2006.
- Coach Houston Fancher's team needs four more victories to reach the 20-win plateau. It would mark the first time Appalachian State had registered back-to-back 20+ win seasons since 1998-99, 1999-00.
- Appalachian State will host Niagara in Bracketbusters on Feb. 23 in Boone, N.C. at 1:00 p.m.

Elon



- In a 76-70 win over Appalachian State, Elon tied a season-high with 45 second-half points. The Phoenix also set season highs for free throws made (25) and free throw attempts (35).
- Elon's three-game winning streak was snapped, 59-44, by Georgia Southern on Feb. 16. The winning skein was the longest for Elon since an eight-game streak in 2005-06.
- Elon will host UT-Martin in Bracketbusters on Saturday, Feb. 23 at 7:00 p.m.

UNC Greensboro



- With a late 83-78 loss to Davidson on Feb. 13, UNC Greensboro has suffered five of its seven conference losses in the final 38 seconds of play. Three of the defeats came in a span of 12 days.
- Kyle Hines needs just seven rebounds to join the elite 2,000-point/1,000-rebound club. Of the 95 players who have reached the mile stone, only five have also blocked 300 shots. Hines has 326 rejections in his career. In his last 10 games, Hines is averaging 22.4 ppg, 10.0 rpg and is shooting 63.2 percent from the floor.
- Dwayne Johnson has 397 assists in his career. Only four Spartans have recorded more than 400 career assists. He matched his season-high with eight in a 79-55 win over Appalachian State on Feb. 16. It marked the 11th time this season and the 34th time in his career he has had five or more assists.

Chattanooga



- Junior forward Nicchaeus Doaks posted a career-high 16 rebounds in a 79-73 loss at College of Charleston on Feb. 14. He is averaging 15.1 points and 7.2 rebounds while shooting 58.1 percent from the field in SoCon games this season.
- The Chattanooga bench outscored College of Charleston (Feb. 14) and The Citadel (Feb., 16) by a margin of 65-24 last week. The bench was buoyed at The Citadel by a line-up shake-up when usual starters Khalil Hartwell, Stephen McDowell and Marcus Watts came off the bench.
- On Feb. 14 at College of Charleston, the Mocs took 82 shots and shot 34.2 percent from the floor. Two days later in a win at The Citadel, Chattanooga took 33 fewer shots (49) but made 51 percent from the floor.

Western Carolina



- Sophomore guard Brandon Giles averaged 17.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in two games last week. He has scored double figures in 16 consecutive games, scoring 20 or more points eight times.
- Western Carolina's 65-57 victory at College of Charleston snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Cougars. It also marked Western Carolina's first road victory of the season and the first-ever Catamount victory over College of Charleston in the Lowcountry.
- Coach Larry Hunter's team begins a three-game homestand facing UNC Greensboro on Feb. 21, The Citadel on Feb. 23 and Wofford on Feb. 28.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



- Andrew Goudelock averaged 16.0 points, 4.0 rebounds while shooting 61.2 percent (11-of-18) from the field, 66.7 (6-of-9) percent from three-point range and was 4-for-4 from the line last week.
- College of Charleston has shot 78.3 percent from the line the last two games. The Cougars hit 21-of-29 free throws against Chattanooga on Feb. 14 and 15-of-17 against Western Carolina on Feb. 16.
- Tony White Jr. made all eight of his free throw attempts against Chattanooga. Jermaine Johnson had a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds against the Mocs.



The Citadel

- Behind the play of Austin Dahn, who had two late three-pointers, The Citadel registered its first Southern Conference victory of the season, a 57-51 win over Western Carolina on Feb. 14. Dahn averaged 19.0 points in two games last week.
- The win over Western Carolina snapped a 21-game conference losing streak for the Bulldogs.
- The Bulldogs broke the school-record for three-pointers in a season. The previous record of 210 fell on Feb. 11 when the Bulldogs played Elon. The Citadel had 17 treys against Chattanooga and currently have 241 three-pointers this season.



Davidson

- Davidson has won 15 consecutive games and 27 straight SoCon regular-season contests and 40 of its last 41 against SoCon competition. The Wildcats are 17-0 in league play for the second time in coach Bob McKillop's tenure.
- Stephen Curry continued his torrid play. The sophomore averaged 33.5 points in two contests last week while shooting 52.4 percent (22-of-42) from the floor and 45.0 percent (9-of-20) from three-point range. He also converted all 14 free throw attempts.
- Winthrop will host Davidson in a televised Bracketbusters game in on Friday, Feb. 22 on ESPN2.



Furman

- Senior George Brozos scored 14 points in Furman's loss to Davidson on Feb. 16. The lone senior on the Furman roster, Brozos is averaging 15.7 points and six rebounds over the last three contests.
- Furman has won four of its last five home games including a 67-61 win over Wofford on Feb. 18.
- George Brozos scored 18 points in the victory over Wofford and Alex Opacic had a double-double with 14 points and 11 boards. Furman held the Terriers to 31.3 percent shooting from the field.



Georgia Southern

- The Eagles limited Elon to 44 points in a 59-44 win over Feb. 16, the fewest points allowed since The Citadel scored 41 points on March 5, 1993.
- Louis Graham had a career-high 29 points at Wofford, making all four of his three-point attempts.
- The Eagles had just three turnovers at Wofford, the fewest by Georgia Southern in the Jeff Price era which dates back to 1999.



Wofford

- Wofford is the lone SoCon team to defeat a team currently ranked in the Top 25. The Terriers downed Purdue, 69-66, on Dec. 19. The Boilermakers are currently ranked No. 23 in the nation.
- Shane Nichols moved into third place on Wofford's all-time three-pointer's list. He has a total of 304 career treys including games at St. Peter's and Wofford.
- Following a 67-61 loss at Furman on Feb. 18, the Terriers play the next two games on the road before closing out the regular season on March 1 at home against The Citadel.
