The Citadel's Porter Johnson Named National Player of the Week

Grambling State quarterback Bruce Eugene Brown running back Nick Hartigan, **The Citadel** linebacker **Porter Johnson** and Holy Cross kick returner Steve Silva have been honored as national I-AA players of the week by The Sports Network, the division's most widely recognized sports information service.

Johnson recorded 11 tackles, 10 of them solo stops, and notched six tackles for a loss and a sack to lead The Citadel to a 17-7 win at Western Carolina...Led a Bulldog defense that held Western Carolina to 14 yards rushing and 166 total yards...Johnson was playing in only his fourth game as a linebacker after three previous years as a fullback

• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll. Furman moved to No. 6 with Appalachian State jumping six spots to No. 16. Georgia Southern returns to the Top 25 at the No. 21 spot. Western Carolina, Wofford and Chattanooga also received votes.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman remains in the top 10 at No. 7 with Appalachian State jumping up one spot to No. 16. Georgia Southern checks in as the No. 23 ranked team. Western Carolina, Wofford, Chattanooga and The Citadel all received votes.

• The Citadel's Porter Johnson was named The Sports Network Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts in the Bulldogs 17-7 win over Western Carolina on October 1. This was the second national player of the week honor for a Southern Conference student-athlete as Kevin Richardson earned the national Offensive Player of the Week accolade on September 19.

• Two schools will play out-of-conference this weekend. The Citadel will travel to Mississippi for its second game against a Division I-A school this season. Chattanooga travels to Liberty for a 7:00 kick.

Around the SoCon This Week

Appalachian State (3-1, 1-0 SoCon)

Appalachian State, which was idle last week, opened up league play with a 45-13 win at The Citadel on Sept. 24...The Mountaineers racked up 423 yards of offense and limited the Bulldogs to 219...QB **Richie Williams** recorded 353 yards of total offense, passing for 259 and running for another 94...Williams also passed for three touchdowns to up his career total to 44, eighth on the SoCon charts...He needs three TD passes to move into second place on the school charts and 213 passing yards to become the third Mountaineer to pass for 6,000 yards in a career...**Marques Murrell** returned a fumble recovery 89 yards for a touchdown, the second longest fumble return in SoCon history...Murrell also added two sacks and three tackles for a loss...DB **Corey Lynch** intercepted his league-leading fifth pass, returning it for 39 yards...It was also his 12th career INT, one shy of moving him into 11th place in league history...ASU travels to Furman for a CSS-TV game on Saturday, then hosts Georgia Southern on Oct. 15 in a game that will be televised on FSN South.

The Citadel (2-2, 1-1 SoCon)

The Bulldogs knocked off No. 18 Western Carolina 17-7 on the road, ending a skid of six consecutive league defeats on the road...The Citadel travels to face Mississippi on the road on Saturday, the team's second game against a Division I-A opponent this year...WR **Kinta Palmer** threw and caught a touchdown against the Catamounts, connecting on a 31-yard pass to **Ta'Mar Jernigan**...Palmer then was on the receiving end of a 23-yard pass from **Duran Dawson**...RB **Montrell Lee** picked up 87 yards on 13 carries, including a run for 49 yards...P **Mark Kaspar** averaged 43.4 yards on 10 punts, with two of his punts going inside the 20 yard line...Kaspar's 10 punts were two shy of the school record...LB **Porter Johnson** recorded 11 tackles, 10 of them solo...The Bulldog defensive unit held WCU to 14 yards rushing and 166 total yards in 70 offensive plays, an average of 2.4 yards a play...The Citadel hosts Furman on Oct. 15.

Chattanooga (3-2, 1-1 SoCon)

The Mocs evened their conference record at 1-1 with a 25-13 win at home over No. 22 Wofford...It marked Chattanooga's second win over a ranked opponent this year — the other was against then-No. 21 Jacksonville State (21-18)...The win for UTC ended a four-game losing streak in Homecoming games, while it also ended a three-game skid against the Terriers...DB **Greg McConico** returned a fumble 24 yards for a touchdown, the Mocs third defensive score of the year — and the first for a fumble recovery since 1999...RB **Levonte Barber** scored the first two touchdowns of his career, one on the ground and the other in the air...QB **Antonio Miller** had 191 yards of total offense, 110 yards passing and another 81 on the ground...The Mocs step out of league play for the final time this season Saturday at Liberty, then head to Elon on Oct. 15.

Elon (3-2, 0-1 SoCon)

The Phoenix opened up league play with a 49-7 loss to Georgia Southern...WR **Michael Mayers** had a team-high six catches for 77 yards...Mayers leads the team with 20 receptions, one more than he had all of last year...RB **Reggie Hall** rushed for 88 yards on 24 carries...QB **Kye Hamilton** was 17-for-27 for 151 yards and completed passes to six different receivers...DB **Anthony Harris** registered a career-high 15 tackles against GSU, with one tackle going for a loss...Elon heads to Wofford on Saturday, before returning home to host Chattanooga on Oct. 15.

Furman (4-1, 0-1 SoCon)

The Paladins piled up 610 yards of offense in a 48-31 win over Gardner-Webb...The two teams combined for 1,065 yards of total offense...QB **Ingle Martin** passed for 247 yards (11-of-24) and three touchdowns and rushed for a fourth on an 80-yard run...The 80-yard run was the longest run by a QB in school history...Martin also connected with **Grant Bingham** on an 87-yard pass play, the longest non-scoring play in Furman history and the second-longest in SoCon history...Bingham finished with 189 yards on five catches, the third most receiving yards ever by a Paladin...RB **Brandon Mays** registered his second career 100-yard rushing game against Gardner-Webb, finishing with exactly 100 yards...Austin Holmes intercepted two passes and added five tackles and a pass breakup from his corner position...Furman hosts Appalachian State in a televised game (CSS) on Saturday, then heads to The Citadel on Oct. 15.

Georgia Southern (3-2, 2-1 SoCon)

The Eagles recorded 503 yards of total offense in their 49-7 win over Elon...QB **Jayson Foster** rushed for a game-high 129 yards and two TDs and also passed for another 49 and a third score...Foster recorded his fifth straight 100-yard game...**Jermaine Austin** added 125 yards on the ground on only 11 carries and crossed the goal line twice...QB **Darius Smiley** connected on an 82-yard pass to **Teddy Craft** for a touchdown, the longest pass play in school history...The Eagle defense limited the Phoenix to 259 yards of offense and registered 12 tackles for a loss, including two sacks.

Western Carolina (2-2, 1-1 SoCon)

After an unexpected week off due to Hurricane Rita, the Catamounts resumed action on Saturday and dropped a 17-7 decision to The Citadel...WCU mustered only 166 yards of offense...QB **Justin Clark** was 14-of-32 for 153 yards and an INT...Clark completed passes to eight different receivers...**Nick Miller** scored the Catamounts' only touchdown of the day on a 92-yard kickoff return, the tenth longest return in school history...It was the team's first return for a touchdown since Xavier Godard had a 100-yard return against Georgia Southern in 2003...WCU heads to Georgia Southern on Saturday, then is open the following week.

Wofford (2-2, 1-1 SoCon)

The Terriers came off an open week and lost at Chattanooga, 25-13...RBs **Michael Hobbs** and **Corey Dunn** ran for 98 and 67 yards, respectively...Both Hobbs and Dunn each added a touchdown on the ground...SS **Dan Tavani** had 10 tackles for the Terriers, eight of them solo...Tavani also forced a fumble...FS **Brian Ford** also had nine stops and intercepted his third pass of the season...Wofford hosts Elon on Saturday, the steps out of SoCon play to host VMI on Oct. 15.

Ingle Martin, Furman
QB, 6-3, Nashville, TN

Martin, a 6-3 quarterback from Nashville, TN, led the Paladins to a 48-31 win over Gardner-Webb, en route to his third career player of the week selection. The senior led the Furman offensive attack by passing for 247 yards and three touchdowns, while rushing for a fourth on an 80-yard scamper. Martin finished the contest with 327 yards of total offense, the sixth-highest total in school history. It was also part of a 610-yard team offensive output, the eighth-highest total in Furman history. He completed touchdown passes of 13, 11 and 65 yards, while also connecting on an 87-yard completion, the longest non-scoring pass in school history -- and the second-longest in SoCon annals.

Porter Johnson, The Citadel

In only his fourth game as a linebacker, after three previous years as a fullback, Johnson helped the Bulldog defense hold Western Carolina to 14 yards rushing and 166 total yards in a 17-7 win over the No. 18 Catamounts. The senior from Loris, SC, had 11 tackles, 10 of them solo, while also recording six tackles for a loss, including one sack.

Western Carolina (2-2, 1-1 SoCon) at #21/23 Georgia Southern (3-2, 2-1 SoCon), Noon
Paulson Stadium (18,000) • Statesboro, GA
TV: Comast/Charter Sports Southeast



THE GAME: This will be the 16th meeting between the two schools, with Georgia Southern holding a 13-2 advantage in the series...The Eagles have won the last 10 meetings in the series and have won all seven previous encounters at Paulson Stadium...The Catamounts are coming off a 17-7 loss at home to The Citadel, while the Eagles won 49-7 on the road against Elon...GSU's Jermaine Austin moved into fifth place on the SoCon career rushing list with 4,532 yards following his 27th career 100-yard rushing game (125 yards on 11 carries)...He needs 29 yards to move past Chris Parker (Marshall, 1991-95) for fourth all-time in league history.

THE COACHES: Western Carolina head coach Kent Briggs (Western Carolina '79) is in his fourth season as coach of his alma mater ...Briggs has tabulated a 16-22 record in his three-plus seasons and is 0-3 vs. GSU...Mike Sewak (Virginia '81) is 30-12 in three-plus years as head coach of Georgia Southern and is 3-0 vs. WCU...Since he joined GSU in 1997, the Eagles have compiled a 92-21 record and won national championships in 1999 and 2000.



Elon (3-2, 0-1 SoCon) at Wofford (2-2, 1-1 SoCon), 1:30
Gibbs Stadium (13,000) • Spartanburg, SC



THE GAME: It will be the 29th all-time meeting between the two schools, with Wofford leading 19-9 in the series...The Terriers, who are coming off a 25-13 loss at Chattanooga, have won eight of the last 10 meetings and are 12-5 all-time at home versus the Phoenix...Last week Elon dropped its conference opener to Georgia Southern, 49-7...QB Kye Hamilton needs 170 passing yards to become the first Elon quarterback to pass for 1,000 in back-to-back seasons since Heath Hewett did it in 1990-91...Wofford's Michael Hobbs rushed for a game-high 98 yards against UTC and scored his fourth TD of the season.

THE COACHES: Paul Hamilton (Appalachian State '81) is 6-10 in his second year as head coach of the Phoenix...Hamilton is 44-51 in nine years as a collegiate head coach and 1-7 all-time vs. Wofford, 0-1 at Elon ...Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 112-82-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 7-2 lifetime against the Phoenix.



The Citadel (2-2, 1-1 SoCon) at Mississippi (1-3), 1:00 (CT)
Vaught-Hemingway Stadium (60,580) • Oxford, MS

THE GAME: This game will mark the first meeting between The Citadel and Ole Miss...The Bulldogs are coming off a 17-7 win at Western Carolina, evening the team's league record at 1-1...The Rebels lost their third in a row last week, a 27-10 decision to Tennessee...It's the second straight year that Ole Miss has started 1-3...This is Ole Miss' Homecoming game, where the Rebels have won eight straight...The Citadel is allowing a conference-low 90.0 ypg on the ground.

THE COACHES: Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 2-2... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...Ed Orgeron (Northwestern State '84) is 1-3 in his first season as Ole Miss head coach...Prior to his first collegiate head coaching position, Orgeron spent the last seven seasons as defensive line coach at Southern California, including his final two years as assistant head coach.

THE GAME: This game will mark the 35th meeting between the two schools, with Furman leading the series 20-11-3...Appalachian State, however, has won four of the last five meetings, including a 30-29 win in Boone a year ago...The Paladins are 12-4-1 in games played in Greenville...This game will pit two of the top three offensive teams in the SoCon, as the two combined are averaging more than 65 points and 900-plus yards of offense...ASU QB Richie Williams has yet to throw an interception this year in 108 attempts...Williams needs 213 yards to become the third player in school history to pass for more than 6,000 yards...Furman QB Ingle Martin has thrown for 3,799 yards in his career and is 195 yards shy of moving into fifth place on the school's career passing list.

THE COACHES: The winningest coach in Southern Conference football history, Jerry Moore (Baylor '61) is in his 17th season at the helm of the Mountaineer program in 2005...Moore has a 131-65 mark at Appalachian over the course of his 16-plus seasons with the school...Moore is 8-8 all-time against Furman... Bobby Lamb (Furman '86) is in his fourth season at the helm of his alma mater in 2005...Lamb has compiled a 28-13 record while at the head of the Paladins program and is 0-3 vs. ASU.



Chattanooga (3-2, 1-1 SoCon) at Liberty (1-4), 7:00
Williams Stadium (12,000) • Lynchburg, VA



THE GAME: This will be the second meeting between Chattanooga and Liberty...The Flames won 43-40 last year in the first meeting...The Mocs are coming off a 25-13 win over Wofford, the team's second win over a nationally-ranked opponent this season, while the Flames dropped a 10-7 game against VMI...Mocs QB Antonio Miller rushed for a team-high 81 yards and also passed for 110...RB Eldra Buckley had 75 yards on nine carries, while RB Levonte Barber scored the first two touchdowns of his career against Wofford, one on the ground and one on a reception.

This Date in Southern Conference History

Oct. 8, 1983: The Citadel celebrated its first appearance on national television by taking the annual "Military Classic of the South" emphatically over the Virginia Military Institute, 27-6. The Citadel's Cliff Walters two touchdowns helped the Bulldogs once again take home the Silver Shako emblematic.

Oct. 8, 1977: Wofford outran Furman on the day, rushing for a net of 306 yards in a 13-7 win over the Paladins. The ground-oriented Paladins were held under 100 yards rushing as a team for the first time in 1977 in the loss to the Terriers.

Oct. 8, 1977: The Mocs used 435 cumulative rushing yards as a team to defeat Western Carolina, 21-10, and win their second SoCon game of 1977.

Oct. 8, 1994: Western Carolina safety Herb Streater picked up his second fumbled of the day and returned it to the Georgia Southern nine with just under three minutes to play to set up fullback Marcus Roberts' game-winning touchdown in the Catamounts 35-31 win over the Eagles. Three-time Super Bowl Champion with the New England Patriots and current Washington Redskins receiver David Patten caught six passes for 63 yards and two touchdowns in come-from-behind win No. 4 on the year for the Catamounts.

Oct. 8, 1994: Western Carolina's Marcus Roberts scored with 2:25 left in the game to give the Catamounts a dramatic 35-31 win against Georgia Southern.

Oct. 8, 1994: Furman could only commandeer two Jim Richter field goals in losing 30-6 to Appalachian State at Kidd Brewer Stadium in Boone, NC. The loss was the first for the Paladins in Boone since 1986 and the second Southern Conference loss of the year for the Paladins in 1994.

Oct. 8, 1983: Despite building a 17-0 lead, the Western Carolina Catamounts ended the day in a deadlock with Furman at 17-17 in a battle of first-place teams in the Southern Conference.

Oct. 8, 1994: Terrence Rivers racked up 151 yards and three touchdowns in The Citadel's 56-34 loss to ETSU.

Oct. 8, 1994: Appalachian State took advantage of a young 1994 Furman squad by defeating the Paladins in every facet of the game in a 30-6 win. The Mountaineers had a balanced attack on the day, passing for 145 yards and running for 196.
