NOTES

•10 games have gone into overtime so far this season with eight of them going into double overtime.

•ETSU's head coach David Casper, returns to Lexington for the first time since he left to join the Bucs coaching staff. He spent five years with the Wildcats on their coaching staff.

•ETSU's match against No. 7 Kentucky will mark their third top-ten opponent of the season, putting them among the NCAA leaders in strength of schedule.

•According to NCAA rankings, only one SoCon team is ranked in the top-100 in RPI. ETSU is currently ranked 29th, 40 spots up from where they were ranked last week at 69.

•Player of the week, UNCG's Leeroy Maguraushe's double overtime goal against Elon on Tuesday, made Sports Centers Top 10 plays as well as received national attention from outlets such as ESPN, NBC Sports and Yahoo!, as well as receiving more than two million combined views on social media.

•In UNCG's game against Appalachian State on Saturday night, the Spartans held their fifth opponent of the season scoreless in the first half.

•UNCG's senior Cameron Woodfin tied the all-time-record for assists at ETSU with is 20th career assist on Saturday at Georgia Southern. He's currently tied with David Geno (2010-13) for the all-time career assists records.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK- LEEROY MAGURAUSHE SR., M, UNCG

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – UNCG midfielder Leeroy Maguraushe has been named the Southern Conference men's soccer player of the week for all competition Sept. 17-23.

The Spartans went 1-1 on the week, picking up a 1-0 double overtime win against Elon, and dropping a 0-1 game to Appalachian State. In the game against Elon, Maguraushe took possession of the ball in the 104th minute and launched the ball into the corner of the net to end the game. The senior from Milton Keynes, England, has received national attention for his game-winning goal from outlets such as ESPN, NBC Sports and Yahoo!, and receiving more than two million combined views on social media.

UNCG is back in action on Sept. 25 at Campbell University.
