SoCon PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Zane Najdawi, Jr., F The Citadel

Najdawi averaged 29.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 blocked shots per game as the Bulldogs dropped a contest to Samford before downing Chattanooga in overtime. He shot 82.8 percent from the floor for the week, connecting on 24 of his 29 field-goal attempts, and was 9-for-12 from the free-throw line (75 percent).

The junior forward from Midlothian, Virginia, scored 21 points and pulled down five rebounds in The Citadel's 107-91 loss to Samford on Thursday. Najdawi dished off three assists and was 9-for-12 from the floor, including a 9-for-10 mark from inside the 3-point arc. He was 3-for-5 from the free-throw line.

Two days later, Najdawi scored a career-high 37 points in the Bulldogs' 110-101, overtime win over Chattanooga. He went 15-for-17 from the floor (88.2 percent), grabbed six rebounds, blocked three shots and had another three assists.

The weekly award is the third of Najdawi's career.



CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

- ETSU's Desonta Bradford hit a floater in the lane with 4.5 seconds left Thursday as the Bucs picked up a big road win at Furman, 62-61, to remain unbeaten in league play. ETSU has won nine straight and 13 of its last 14 games, with the lone loss a 68-66 setback at No. 10 Xavier on Dec. 16.

- Despite Thursday's loss to ETSU, Furman has posted a 19-2 home record versus SoCon foes since the start of the 2015-16 season.

- Four SoCon teams appear in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25, tied with the West Coast Conference for the most schools in the poll. ETSU (5) and Furman (8) are both in the top 10, while Wofford moved up four spots to No. 13 following its win over the Paladins and UNCG dropped two spots to 20th after its road loss to the Bucs.

- Furman's Devin Sibley and Wofford's Fletcher Magee also earned individual recognition from CollegeInsider.com last week. Both were named to the Lou Henson Award midseason watch list, while Magee was also on the Lute Olson Award midseason watch list. The Lou Henson Award honors the top NCAA Division I mid-major player, while the Lute Olson Award recognizes the top DI player who has played for at least two years.

- With 29 league games in the books so far, just 12 have been decided by single digits. The other 17 games were decided by an average of 21.5 points per game.

- All 10 SoCon teams are .500 or better at home for the season, and five teams have just one loss at home: ETSU, Furman, Mercer, UNCG and Wofford. Together, home teams are 16-13 so far in league play.

- The Citadel ranks in the top five in NCAA Division I in five categories. The Bulldogs are second in 3-point attempts (628) and third in steals per game (10.6) and made 3-pointers per game (11.9) and. The Citadel is fourth in both turnovers forced per game (19.33) and total steals (190).

- Mercer coach Bob Hoffman picked up his 500th career win in Thursday's 62-56 win at VMI. Hoffman, who is 189-139 in 10 years at Mercer, is 500-294 overall in 24 seasons.

- ETSU guard Desonta Bradford is the only player in the league to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals, while Chattanooga forward Makinde London is the only player to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding and blocked shots this year. The two are the also only two to rank in the top 10 in just scoring and rebounding.

- Samford guards Justin Coleman and Josh Sharkey are Nos. 1-2 in the SoCon in assists this season. Coleman, who tied the school record with 13 in a win over The Citadel on Jan. 11, currently leads the league in assists (113) and assists per game (5.9), while Sharkey is ranked second in assists (82) and assists per game (4.8).

- Wofford's Fletcher Magee and UNCG's Francis Alonso appear in the SoCon's career free-throw percentage ranking, with Magee leading at 91.9 percent and Alonso sixth at 86.7.

CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

Coaching milestones coming up

Three league coaches are approaching career win milestones. In addition to Mercer coach Bob Hoffman earning his 500th career victory Thursday (see previous page), Western Carolina coach Larry Hunter is also closing in history. Already having moved ahead of legendary NC State coach Everett Case on the SoCon's all-time wins list this season, Hunter needs three more to reach 700 overall for his career. He is 697-444 in 38 years on the sidelines. Finally, UNCG coach Wes Miller needs four wins to reach 100 for his career. He is 96-107 in seven seasons as a head coach.

1,000-point scorers

Three league players have hit the 1,000-point milestone for their careers so far this season. UNCG junior Francis Alonso reached the mark on Nov. 20 against Delaware, and Furman senior Daniel Fowler joined the club on Dec. 30 against VMI. ETSU senior Desonta Bradford reached 1,000 points on Jan. 13, also against VMI. Furman senior Devin Sibley, Samford senior Christen Cunningham and Wofford junior Fletcher Magee entered the season over 1,000 for their careers, giving the SoCon six active players with at least 1,000 points. Mercer senior Stephon Jelks is likely next to join the club, as he currently has 990 points to his credit.

Wofford's Magee among national leaders

Wofford's Fletcher Magee has scored in double figures in 63 consecutive contests, good for the second-longest active streak in NCAA Division I, according to research by STATS. Magee is first in DI in made 3-pointers (83), second in made 3s per game (4.61) and free-throw percentage (96.4) and third in 3-point field-goal percentage (50.6) this season.

One-possession games

This season, eight SoCon games out of 29 have been decided by one possession or gone to overtime (28 percent).

- In 2016, the league had 21 of 90 (23 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2015, the league had 23 of 90 (26 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2014, the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

Sharpshooting Bulldogs

The Citadel finished second in Division I with 397 made 3-pointers last season, a SoCon record. The Bulldogs are on pace for approximately 370 3-pointers this season, which would be second in SoCon history. If it reaches that mark, The Citadel will have accomplished the top three 3-point totals in league history in the last three seasons, as it previously set the SoCon record with 363 in 2015-16.

Ten wins before the New Year

For the second consecutive year, three SoCon teams had 10 wins at the turn of the calendar. This season, ETSU, Furman and UNCG were each 10-4 after games of Dec. 31. In 2016-17, it was ETSU, Samford and Chattanooga each with at least 10 wins before the New Year. Prior to last year, the league hadn't had three teams reach double digits in wins prior to January in at least 20 seasons, according to available research.

The SoCon vs. the ACC

Wofford's 79-75 win over No. 5 North Carolina on Dec. 20 gave the SoCon three wins over Atlantic Coast Conference schools in a season for the first time since 2001-02. Also this year, Wofford has beaten Georgia Tech (63-60 on Dec. 6) and UNCG has beaten NC State (81-76 on Dec. 16). The only leagues to own more wins over the ACC this season are Power 5 conferences the Big 12, Big Ten and SEC, each with six.

Close encounters

Southern Conference teams are 9-6 this season in nonconference games that have been decided by one possession or have gone into overtime. League teams have gone 42-44 in those games since the start of the 2013-14 season.

Postseason experience

Four teams reached postseason play last season. ETSU won the SoCon Championship and the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, where it fell in the first round to Florida. UNCG made its first NIT appearance since 2002, falling to Syracuse, while Furman and Samford participated in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament, with the Paladins reaching the semifinals.

• The Citadel is third in NCAA Division I in made 3-pointers per game at 11.9, while Wofford is the national leader in 3-point percentage at 45.0.

• Wofford junior guard Fletcher Magee is currently first in DI with 83 made 3-pointers and second with 4.61 per game. Citadel junior Matt Frierson is 10th with 64 made 3s and eighth with 3.61 per game, and UNCG junior guard Francis Alonso's 64 3-pointers are good for 13th, while his 3.56 per game are good for 10th.

• Magee's 3-point percentage is 50.6 this season (third in DI), which would be good for fifth in a single season in SoCon history. Mercer senior forward Stephon Jelks – the league's active leader in career rebounds – is just 0.5 3-point makes shy of qualifying for the league lead with a 52.8 percentage this season, a mark that would rank third in league history.

DECEMBER TO REMEMBER

It was a December to remember for the SoCon, which proved it can be a force on the national stage with a few big wins and several more near upsets. A time line of significant performances:

Dec. 2: Mercer takes Memphis to double overtime on the road before succumbing, 83-81. Jordan Strawberry's 3-point attempt at the buzzer goes long for the Bears.

Dec. 5: Samford, decimated by injuries this season, also flirts with knocking off the Tigers, falling 65-64 in Memphis. The Bulldogs hold a 64-60 lead with 18 seconds to go but see Memphis get a layup with 11 seconds left and a three-point play with 2.5 ticks left to steal the win.

Dec. 6: Wofford's Fletcher Magee hits a step-back 3-pointer with 1.9 seconds left to cap a 36-point effort as the Terriers down Georgia Tech, 63-60, for their first signature win in Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium.

Dec. 16: UNCG picks up its first-ever win over NC State and just its third over an ACC opponent as the Spartans get 17 points from Francis Alonso and a double-double from Marvin Smith in an 81-76 win in Raleigh.

Dec. 16: That same day, ETSU has No. 10 Xavier on the ropes, leading by 22 early in the second half before seeing the Musketeers rally for the 68-66 win.

Dec. 19: Mercer nearly pulls off a miraculous comeback against Alabama, rallying from an eight-point deficit with 27 seconds left to put up what would have been a game-winning 3-pointer at the buzzer. Ria'n Holland's attempt is off the mark as the Crimson Tide escape, 80-79.

Dec. 20: Wofford picks up what might be the biggest upset of the season nationally, shocking No. 5 North Carolina, 79-75. The Terriers never trail in the second half and get 27 points from Fletcher Magee.

Dec. 20: At the same time Wofford is dropping UNC, Furman is putting a scare into No. 21 Tennessee, as the squads are tied at 61 in the final minute before the Vols finish the game on a 5-0 run. Devin Sibley has 22 points but is the only Paladin in double digits.
