• Three conference series are on the slate this week, while UNCG hosts Longwood in a nonconference series.

• UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches and currently sit atop the league at 16-8 overall.

• Chattanooga infielder Emily Coltharp was named the preseason player of the year, Chattanooga's third-straight preseason POTY selection. Samford pitcher Abby Swaney was selected as the preseason pitcher of the year.

• UNCG is sixth nationally with 1.79 home runs per game & ninth in walks (123), while Samofrd is fifth in doubles per game (0.60).

SOCON 100TH ANNIVERSARY

The SoCon is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2021. The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.
