### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Noah Dahlman - Wofford

Dahlman averaged 26.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and made 64.5 percent of his field goals as the Terriers earned conference victories over UNCG (92-70) and Elon (75-69) last week.

Dahlman scored 16 points against UNCG in the SoCon opener for both teams. The senior forward posted a career-high 37 points in Wofford's victory at Elon Saturday night. Dahlman was 13-of-19 from the field and added eight rebounds, two assists and one steal against the Phoenix.

He ranks third in the Southern Conference in scoring (19.8 ppg) and fifth in field goal percentage (.568). He is third in the league in offensive rebounds (3.0 rpg).

Other top performers in the SoCon included Appalachian State's Donald Sims, College of Charleston's Donovan Monroe, The Citadel's Austin Dahn, Davidson's Jake Cohen, Furman's Noah States, Georgia Southern's Tre Bussey, Samford's Jeffrey Merritt, Chattanooga's Keegan Bell and Western Carolina's Mike Williams.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims continues his hot streak for the Mountaineers with 27.0 points per game. He tallied 28 points in each of this week's games to accompany 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game against SoCon North competition. Sims has five-straight 20-point outings after scoring 18 in the season opener.
- Appalachian split its first two league games on the road last week. Four of the team's next five are also away from the Holmes Center, where the Mountaineers won 14 games last season.
- The Mountaineers visit Georgetown December 12.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Elon has been one of the top teams at sharing the basketball during the early part of the season. The Phoenix rank third in the conference with 14.8 assists per game. Elon ranks second in the league with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.1.
- Elon has seen an increase in its scoring through the first seven games this season. The Phoenix average 75.6 points per contest, eight points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game.
- The Phoenix host Lynchburg College at Alumni Gym on December 12.

## UNCG SPARTANS



- Junior transfer Aloysius Henry has made an immediate impact for the Spartans this season. He leads UNCG and ranks in the top 20 in the league in both scoring (11.8 ppg) and rebounding (5.9 rpg).
- UNCG has been one of the best teams on the offensive glass in the conference through the first three weeks of the season. The Spartans rank third in the SoCon with 13.1 offensive rebounds per game. UNCG is third in offensive rebound percent (.348).
- UNCG visits Wake Forest December 15.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford head coach Jimmy Tillette owns a stellar 94-44 all-time record against conference opponents at home. In his 14th year at the helm of the Bulldogs' basketball program, Tillette has also accumulated an impressive 137-101 mark versus conference rivals. The Bulldogs split two games against league foes last week.
- Since incorporating the Princeton offense in 1997, the Bulldogs have reeled off an 81-56 record in games played against teams that have less than three days to prepare.
- Samford will host UT-Arlington on December 11.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Junior point guard Keegan Bell is No. 7 nationally in assists (6.9 apg) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.95). He recorded a career-high 13 assists in last week's win over Appalachian State. Bell became the first SoCon player to record 13 or more assists in a game since Stephen Curry (11/21/08 - 13 vs. Winthrop) and the first player to do it in a conference game since Byron Fields' 13 for Wofford against The Citadel on Feb. 25, 2006.
- Chattanooga entertains Murray State at McKenzie Arena on December 11.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- WCU wrapped up a stretch of six games in nine days - an average of a game every 36 hours - last week. The Catamounts will have their longest sizeable break of the young season before returning to action this Friday in non-conference play at Campbell. WCU downed CU 66-59 in Cullowhee a year ago, winning for the 14th time in the last 16 meetings, and improving to 21-3 all-time against the Camels.
- Western Carolina is third in the league in scoring margin through its first ten games. The Catamounts are +2.8 in scoring this season.
- The Catamounts travel to Campbell (Friday) and Ohio State (Sunday) this weekend.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars have averaged 85.0 points in their three wins over Davidson, Georgia Southern and East Tennessee State. CofC is second in the league in scoring as the Cougars average 78.0 points per game. They lead the league in scoring margin at +7.2.
- Senior Andrew Goudelock made four three-pointers against East Tennessee State on Tuesday. He has 302 career triples which ranks third all-time in the Southern Conference. Goudelock has made 3.7 shots from beyond the arc per game this season.
- The Cougars visit Charleston Southern December 15. CofC will host Clemson December 22.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior guard Cameron Wells is now 38 points shy of Regan Truesdale's all-time school scoring record of 1,661 points. It has taken Wells six less games to move within the scoring record, as Truesdale played in 109 games over the duration of his career.
- The Citadel heads into its exam break by after five players reached double figures in scoring in the victory against St. Mary's College (Md.) Monday night. Zach Urbanus (15), Cameron Wells (14), Austin Dahn (11), Bryan Streeter (11) and Mike Groselle (10) all scored in double figures for the Bulldogs in the 72-64 victory.
- The Citadel visit Colorado December 17.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Jake Cohen posted his first career double-double at Charleston Saturday with 23 points and 10 rebounds, and the sophomore backed it up with another double-double at The Citadel, posting 21 points and a career-high 12 boards.
- Head coach Bob McKillop is 13 wins away from his 400th career victory. A total of 350 of his 387 wins have come while Davidson has been a member of the Southern Conference, making him the all-time wins leader in league history.
- The Wildcats will play host to the University of Charlotte at Belk Arena Saturday night.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman's 2-0 start in Southern Conference play is its first since former head coach Butch Estes' 1990-91 Paladins squad defeated VMI and Marshall in their opening league games on the way to a 20-9 record and SoCon regular season title.
- Senior Noah States scored a career-high 18 points in a win over Elon last Wednesday before posting a new career-best with 20 points at UNCG Monday night.
- The Paladins visit Middle Tennessee State December 12.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Tré Bussey led the Eagles with a career-high 21 points, including five treys for the top performance from behind the arc this season, against College of Charleston. Bussey has knocked down 38 percent of his three-point attempts, the best mark on the team.
- Ben Drayton's 14 points against The Citadel and College of Charleston continues his streak of scoring in double figures every game this season. Drayton is second on the team in scoring with 15.9 points per game. He ranks third in the conference with 2.2 steals per contest.
- The Eagles welcome Brewton Parker to Statesboro on December 11.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman set a new career high with 37 points against Elon on Saturday night. The senior forward ranks third in the SoCon in scoring with 19.8 points per game. His 37 points were the second-highest scoring output in the league this season.
- After opening the SoCon slate last season at 0-2, this season the Terriers are 2-0 this year with wins over UNCG and Elon last week.
- The Terriers travel to face South Carolina December 11 before hosting High Point December 18.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team return for 2010-11.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Ten of the 12 SoCon teams are scheduled to participate in an exempt tournament this winter, from Puerto Rico (Davidson) to Cancun, Mexico (Appalachian State).

- SoCon teams will take part in the 2K Sports Classic, Charleston Classic, Puerto Rico Tip-Off, Global Sports Showcase, Legends Classic, South Padre Island Invitational, Cancun Govern's Cup, MSG Holiday Festival and Las Vegas Classic.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in Southern Conference history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the league in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2011 marks the 90th year of the post-season classic.
