## PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – UNCG's Mani Austmann and Myson Darden have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition from March 2-8.

Sophomore forward Austmann earned player of the week honors after scoring the game-winning goal Thursday against Longwood to help the Spartans to their fourth straight victory, with their 4-1 record good for their best start since 2004. He drove a shot toward the net in the 59th minute, placing UNCG ahead of the Lancers in the team's 2-1 win. Austmann is one of only two players in the conference to register two game-winning goals this season.

Darden, the league's defensive player of the week, played a crucial role on the Spartans' defense by keeping the Lancers scoreless until the 86th minute. The defender from Raleigh, North Carolina, has started in all five games this season with three shots recorded.

UNCG (4-1-0) travels to Mercer on Saturday, March 13, to open conference action at 2 p.m. with hopes to keep its four-game win streak alive. All seven SoCon teams are set to open conference play within the next week.



#### Notes

- Belmont is undefeated in its first four matches of the year, which sets a record for the longest unbeaten streak to start a season in program history. The Bruins deafeted Lipscomb, 2-1, and Trevecca Nazarene, 2-1, last week, and will open conference action against Wofford on Saturday in Spartanburg, S.C. The team leads the conference with seven assists and only two goals allowed on the season.
- ETSU (0-3-1) tied with the VCU Rams on Feb. 27, senior night, and settled for the 0-0 draw. The Bucs had the week off and are set to open SoCon action on Friday against Furman (2-1-0) on ESPN+ at 7 p.m. ET.
- Furman took the last week to prepare for its conference opener against ETSU, scheduled for March 12. Two Paladins are tied for second for points per game. Shaun-Chris Joash and Jake Raine both scored five points on the season, averaging 1.67 points per game.
- Mercer dropped its hard-fought match at UAB on Feb. 28, 1-0. The Bears begin conference play on March 13 against UNCG, who is on a four-game win streak. With 30 saves on the season, Mercer leads the leauge in the category heading into a game against an opponent who leads the SoCon with 11 goals and 5.40 points per game. Goalkeeper JR DeRose made a league-leading 23 of the Bears' 30 saves.
- UNCG, who claimed both player of the week honors this week, extended its win streak to four games after defeating Longwood 2-1. The Spartans lead the conference in points (27), goals (11) and goals per game (2.20). UNCG (4-1) travels to Macon, Georgia, to kickoff conference action against Mercer (2-6), the SoCon preseason favorite.
- VMI (2-2-0) will host Longwood on Wednesday after a 4-1 loss to Radford last Thurday. This marks the Keydets last nonconference game before taking on unbeaten Belmont on March 16.
- Wofford scored the opening goal against Davidson on March 6, but it wasn't enough in the Terriers 3-2 loss to the Wildcats. Goalkeeper Emil Larsen made eight saves on the night and leads the conference with 5.50 saves per game.
