Appalachian State's Sims Named SoCon Player of the Week

Appalachian State guard **Donald Sims** was named the Southern Conference men's basketball Player of the Week for the week ending January 20.

Sims scored a career-high 28 points in Appalachian State's 92-83 victory over Chattanooga on Jan. 17. He followed the performance with 19 points in an 88-81 triumph over Georgia Southern.

For the week, the freshman averaged 23.5 points while shooting 50.0 percent from the floor. He was 11-of-18 (61.1 percent) from three-point range and made 6-of-8 (75.0 percent) from the free throw line.

The native of Gaffney, S.C. also grabbed seven rebounds, dished out eight assists and had two steals in the two contests.

Other standout performances were turned in by Stephen Curry (Davidson), Alex Opacic (Furman), Nicchaeus Doaks (Chattanooga), Jermaine Johnson (College of Charleston), Brett James (Elon) and Ben Stywall (UNC Greensboro).

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.



NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



- The red-hot Mountaineers have reeled off seven consecutive wins, all in SoCon play, and are undefeated in January. Appalachian State has also won 10 of its last 10 contests.
- The high-octane Appalachian State offense has averaged 88.8 points in the last four contests while shooting 52.7 percent from the floor and 47.6 percent from three-point range.
- Jeremy Clayton matched the school record with eight blocked shots in a 92-83 triumph over Chattanooga on Jan. 17. He needs nine more rejections to become the school's all-time leader in blocked shots.

Elon



- The Phoenix embark on its second five-game road trip of the season this week beginning with a 72-60 loss on Jan. 24 contest at Western Carolina. Elon will play at Appalachian State (Jan. 28), at UNC Greensboro (Feb. 2), at Davidson (Feb. 6) and at Wofford (Feb. 9). Elon was 1-4 during its first five-game road trip this season.
- Junior Brett James averaged 16.5 points per game in contests against Georgia Southern and UNC Greensboro last week. The guard shot 52.4 percent from the field and grabbed 12 rebounds in the two contests.
- A year ago, Elon was 3-8 in its first 10 Southern Conference contests. The Phoenix stand at 5-6 in 2007-08.

UNC Greensboro



- UNC Greensboro has won eight of its last 10 games. Defense has been a key as the Spartans have allowed 61.3 points per game in the eight victories. In the two losses, opponents have averaged 80.0 points per contest.
- Ben Stywall made all six shots from the field in the second half and scored all of his 16 points in the second stanza as the UNC Greensboro rallied from a 13-point deficit to defeat Elon, 61-57, on Jan. 19.
- Mike Dement became UNC Greensboro's winningest coach when the Spartans downed Elon on Jan. 19. Dement won his 93rd game as the Spartans head coach, passing Bob McEvoy. It was also Dement's 298th career win.

Chattanooga



- Junior guard Stephen McDowell has made three or more three-pointers on seven occasions this season.
- The Mocs are 4-4 this season when the game is televised heading into a Jan. 26 contest with Appalachian State on SportSouth. Chattanooga is 3-0 in televised SoCon games.
- Nicchaeus Doaks averaged 17.0 points and 8.5 rebounds for the Mocs in SoCon match-ups against Appalachian State and Davidson last week. He shot 63.6 percent (14-of-22) from the floor during the week.

Western Carolina



- Coach Larry Hunter ranks 13th among the nation's winningest active Division I coaches. With 538 wins, he is currently tied with North Carolina mentor Roy Williams.
- Western Carolina is the only SoCon school to have representation in the Major Leagues, NBA and NFL. Jared Burton is a pitcher for the Cincinnati Reds; Kevin Martin plays for the Sacramento Kings and Brad Hoover is a member of the Carolina Panthers and David Patten is with the New Orleans Saints.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



- It is a busy week for the Cougars with three games in a five-day span. After hosting UNC Greensboro (Jan. 24) and Davidson (Jan. 26), College of Charleston takes to the road for a contest at Wofford on Jan. 28. The Cougars fell to UNC Greensboro, 88-71.
- The Cougars built a 32-9 lead over The Citadel at halftime on Jan. 14 in a 69-46 win over their crosstown rivals. It marked the fewest points allowed by the Cougars in an opening half since posting 34-8 lead over Campbell en route to a 65-39 win on Jan. 29, 1998.
- Jermaine Johnson averaged 11.7 points and 10.7 rebounds in games against The Citadel, Wofford and Furman last week. The junior shot 60.0 percent (15-of-25) from the field and blocked five shots.

The Citadel



- The Citadel has posted a 5-7 record at McAlister Fieldhouse this season but the Bulldogs are 0-6 away from home in 2007-08.
- The Bulldogs began a five-game homestand on Jan. 12. The Citadel lost the first four games and host SoCon foe UNC Greensboro on Jan. 26.

Davidson



- Sophomore Stephen Curry averaged 25.5 points in games against Furman and Chattanooga last week. The guard reached the 30-point plateau for the seventh time in his career and scored double-figures for the 43rd consecutive time with 37 points against the Mocs.
- Senior guard Jason Richards dished out his 500th career assist and finished with eight on Jan. 16 at Furman. Sophomore Stephen Curry moved into third place on Davidson's all-time three-point goal list with 186 after making eight treys against Chattanooga on Jan. 19.
- Winners of eight consecutive games, the Wildcats have allowed 60.4 points the last five outings.

Furman



- Alex Opacic averaged 18.0 points and 9.3 rebounds in Furman's last three SoCon contests. He tallied 20 points with nine boards in Furman's 74-66 victory over College of Charleston on Jan. 19.
- Furman outrebounded Elon, 32-29, on Jan. 12, marking the first time this season the Paladins have outrebounded an opponent. The Paladins outrebounded Davidson and were even with College of Charleston on the boards in last week's games.
- Freshman Noah States notched his first career double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds on Jan. 16 against Davidson.

Georgia Southern



- Matt Feilds recorded his first career double-double and the second of his career with 13 points and 12 rebounds against Elon on Jan. 17.
- Senior Anthony Marshall scored a career-high 17 points in a 67-57 win over Elon on Jan. 17. He came off the bench and made three three-pointers and converted 6-of-8 free throws.
- Freshman Willie Powers has averaged 15.5 points the last four games.

Wofford



- The Terriers ended a five-game league losing streak with an 80-76 win at The Citadel on Jan. 19. The Terriers made it two in a row with an 86-79 win at Georgia Southern on Jan. 24.
- Drew Gibson reached the 400-assist plateau after dishing out eight at The Citadel on Jan. 19. He has 405 career assists, second all-time for the Terriers.
- Shane Nichols has scored in double-figures in 11 of 12 games this season. He has led the team in scoring on nine occasions.

Coach Jimmy Tillette's team was 15-16 in 2006-07 with an RPI of .76. Samford currently competes in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Bulldogs are 8-11 (5-6 in the OVC) as of Jan. 25, 2008. The Bulldogs lost to UT-Martin, 61-43, in their last outing and host Austin Peay on Jan. 26.
