### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Chris Long - Elon

Long recorded his third career double-double with a career-best 30 points and 10 assists as Elon defeated UNCG, 99-90 Saturday night.

Playing in his final game at Alumni Gym, Long was 10-of-14 from the field, including 5-of-8 from three-point range. His ten assists tied his season high that was set on January 17 against Appalachian State.

The Charleston, W. Va., native moved into sixth place on Elon's single-season assists ledger (163) and moved past the 500-assist plateau for his career (504). He currently ranks 10th in the Southern Conference with 14.3 points per game and leads the league with 6.0 assists per contest.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Donald Sims, College of Charleston's Willis Hall, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Davidson's Nik Cochran, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, UNCG's Brandon Evans, Chattanooga's Chris Early, Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Jamar Diggs.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



• Donald Sims continued his solid senior campaign last week with 30 points against the Catamounts and 28 more in ASU's win over High Point. The guard sank 64 percent of his field goal attempts, including 10-of-15 from downtown. He added to his list of program records when he sank all eight free throws at HPU to give him

525 for his career. The record of 522 foul shots had stood since 1965, when Wayne Duncan set the mark.

- The Mountaineers close out the regular season at home this week with visits from College of Charleston and The Citadel. ASU has a 7-3 home record this season.

## ELON PHOENIX



• Chris Long scored a career-high 30 points as Elon held off UNCG, 99-90 Saturday night. Long also recorded a game-high 10 assists in the win. He is second in the Southern Conference with 163 assists this season and ranks tenth in the league with 14.3 points per game.

• Elon leads the Southern Conference and ranks 11th nationally with 9.4 made three-pointers per game. Freshman guard Jack Isenbarger leads the team and is sixth in the league with 2.0 made triples per contest.

- The Phoenix visit Davidson Thursday.

## UNCG SPARTANS



• UNCG has increased its scoring output in league games during the season. The Spartans are averaging 72.0 points per game this year, but have tallied 77.1 points per contest in Southern Conference games.

• The Spartans pulled down 15 offensive rebounds Monday against Western Carolina. UNCG is third in the league with 11.7 offensive rebounds per game this season. The Spartans rank sixth in the SoCon in offensive rebounding percentage (.321).

- UNCG travels to Georgia Southern Thursday. The Spartans will close the regular season at Davidson.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



• The Bulldogs ran into a buzz saw Monday as they were defeated by the first-place College of Charleston Cougars 75-49 in their final road game of the season held at Carolina First Arena in Charleston, S.C.

• Jeffrey Merriitt enters the regular-season finale against Chattanooga with a total of 186 rebounds throughout the 2010-11 campaign. He is averaging 6.4 rebounds per contest and has already surpassed Samford's single-season totals in the category dating all the way back to the 1999-2000 campaign when former Bulldog great Marc Salyers pulled down a total of 232 rebounds (7.2 rpg).

- The Bulldogs host Chattanooga Saturday.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



• Junior Ricky Taylor passed the 800-point mark for his career with 11 points against Furman Monday night. He now has 801. Fellow junior Keegan Bell scored his 500th point (505) against Furman as well.

• Chattanooga is 8-0 against league competition in McKenzie Arena. The Mocs are 11-5 in league play entering the final two games of the regular season. The Mocs are 7-2 against the North Division and 4-3 against South Division teams.

- The Mocs host Wofford Wednesday night. Chattanooga will close the regular season Saturday at Samford.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



• WCU is perfect at home this season, with a 10-0 mark in the Ramsey Center. The Catamounts have won 37 of their last 42 home games including 26 of the last 29 Southern Conference games in Cullowhee.

• WCU matched a school record for SoCon wins in a season with 11 league victories. It is the fourth time since joining the SoCon that the Catamounts have won 11 conference games in a single season.

- The Catamounts host The Citadel Thursday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



• CofC has won 10 of its last 11 games and seven straight with a 3-0 week with wins over The Citadel, Vermont and Samford in its regular-season home finale on Feb. 21. The Cougars clinched the Southern Conference South Division regular-season title for the first time since going a perfect 16-0 in 1999 and secured the league's automatic NIT bid.

- Andrew Goudelock is currently on a season-best 15-game double-digit scoring streak. He has 2,372 career points which ranks first all-time in the CofC record books and sixth all-time in the SoCon.
- The Cougars travel to face Appalachian State Thursday. CofC will close out the regular season at Western Carolina Saturday afternoon.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



• Sophomore Mike Groselle recorded double-doubles in back-to-back games this week beginning with a 10-point, 10-rebound outing against College of Charleston. He followed that performance on Saturday with a 17-point, 10-rebound effort against Georgia Southern. It is his sixth double-double of the season, as he becomes the seventh Bulldog to reach that milestone since the 1974-75 season.

- Senior guard Cameron Wells has moved within 12 points of becoming the first Citadel basketball player to eclipse the 2,000-point mark.
- The Citadel travels to Western Carolina Thursday night.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



• Davidson has 10 underclassmen (four sophomores, six freshman) on its roster. The Wildcats have 11 total years of Division I experience in the rotation. Only 25 teams in the country have less experience than Davidson.

• Bob McKillop needs two victories to reach 400 for his career. He coached his 1,000th career game at Wofford (Feb. 9) (657 at Davidson, 344 as a high school head coach). He

is the Southern Conference's all-time wins leader with 363 wins as a league member.

- The Wildcats host Elon Thursday night. Davidson will play host to UNCG Saturday afternoon.

## FURMAN PALADINS



• Furman has limited its opponents to 65 points or less in seven of its last 11 games. The Paladins lead the Southern Conference in scoring defense as they have allowed just 64.5 points per contest this year.

• Furman earned a 70-63 win on the road at Samford Saturday. The Paladins' 20 wins are the most by a Furman team since posting a 20-9 record during the 1990-91 campaign. It is the ninth time in school history that the Paladins have reached the 20-win mark.

- Furman hosts Wofford Saturday afternoon.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



• Georgia Southern tied its season-high with eight blocks against The Citadel Saturday. The Eagles committed a season-low seven turnovers in the game, including just two in the second half.

• Ben Drayton III leads the Eagles in scoring with 16.0 points per game which ranks seventh in the Southern Conference. Eric Ferguson leads all SoCon Freshmen with 12.2 points per game. He is also averaging 5.8 rebounds per contest.

- Georgia Southern hosts UNCG Thursday night. Elon visits Georgia Southern February 26.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



• Tim Johnson recorded his third double-double of the season against Ball State Saturday night. Johnson is Wofford's Division I-era career rebounding leader with 958. He leads the SoCon in rebounding with 8.7 per game, 2.1 rebounds per game better than second place.

• With a 16-12 mark, the Terriers have secured a winning record for the third-straight season. The current senior class has been over .500 all four seasons at Wofford.

- The Terriers visit Chattanooga Wednesday night.

### RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- UNCG made 17 triples at Chattanooga January 27. The Spartans' 43 attempts from three-point range was the sixth highest single-game mark in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.
- The Mocs attempted 53 free throws against UNCG on January 27 which ranked as the tenth-highest total in the SoCon.
- Wofford's Noah Dahlman became just the ninth player in SoCon history to be perfect from the floor with at least 10 field goal attempts. Dahlman was 10-for-10 from the field against Georgia Southern on January 12.
- College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock has scored 2,372 points and is sixth on the league's all-time scoring list.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2011 marks the 91st year of the post-season classic.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
